Notes from the INFORMATIONAL HOA meeting with ELS April 20,2021

e had our informational meeting on April 20, and I was pleased at the turnout. Our ELS manager (Penny) attended and answered



questions. A top concern is inspections aka 360's of homes. It is the property and outside of your mobile home inspection and it was explained how it can be enforced when residents do not comply. We do not know what is going on with our neighbors or the homes that are a mess. Everything is behind in the courts due to COVID but if you go to court, you will end up paying upwards of \$600 to \$800 in legal fees. It is easiest to keep your property clean and follow the rules. If you are up north and you left an address with ELS they can send your notice, there. Read your prospectus and rules and if you have questions contact the office for clarification. ELS has opened our amenities except the kitchen. We are still required by ELS to wear a mask inside and social distance. Things may be different as you read this. If you question your rent and or billings, please contact the management. There are many variables. Remember the opening of amenities including the kitchen come from upper management.

The gym has a new floor, new pavers will replace path by East pool, electrical will be fixed where needed, trees will be trimmed in two phases. The air conditioning will be addressed in the East clubhouse and I hope it is fixed when this media is delivered. Penny asked if you have an issue to call for an appointment to discuss. Please leave a message so the office can return your call or leave a message in the drop box by the office. I prefer to email my concerns to Penny or Sofia to have a record of this contact.



Fruit trees already established were approved to stay if they keep all fruit picked up. If you see fruit laying on the ground, please report it to the office.

Alteration requests are looked at weekly for any repairs and changes you request. Hopefully the first phase of tree trimming has been done.

Clubhouses will always close at 10:00 PM per rules of ELS. We can request that they are open later for an event with notice to the office. All amenities close at 10:00 PM. ELS will not entertain later hours.

The Homeowners Association represents all residents. Everyone is a member when they move into Serendipity. This is for owners and renters cannot be heard in decision making. Dues are collected by the HOA and this gives you as a resident the right to vote on any elections and changes the HOA might address. More importantly dues collected go towards insurance that we are required to have, training, lawyers' fees if needed and supplies that are the responsibilities for the HOA to provide. I am not sure what residents think a fair price is, but I think \$10.00 is reasonable and last year the majority of the HOA who could vote approved this amount.

The Homeowners Association put an emergency stay into effect during COVID so we could legally skip the annual meeting, elections and usual meetings or activities. It would be impossible while the clubhouses were closed, and residents were not gathering, and many residents did not come this year. I sure hope we are back to normal soon. We are getting closer. We cannot accept dues from new residents and not collect from all previous members. We are on hold till Fall. Not sure what would be the need for monthly meetings, but this can be addressed in November and voted on for bylaw changes. The HOA bylaws say we meet from November through April. Most parks and the FMO do not meet in the summer. If this is important to residents, they need to let the board know. By laws will be on the agenda for Nov meeting. There are 4 different rate increase dates for rent increases. All residents will receive these mailings three months prior to any increases or changes that pertains to the residents The HOA will meet with management to try to negotiate on behalf of the members and we will update Facebook and get notices delivered on progress. Any questions you have that the board can answer can be addressed by directors. The HOA is looking into some signage that we can place near mailboxes to share information with residents. We understand that not everyone has Facebook or internet mail, and they do not go to the clubhouses to read updates and announcements.

The bylaws are being rewritten and will be proposed at the November meeting. Any thoughts you may have can be given to any director who will share with the committee.

A question came up at the meeting about terms as directors and officers. A director who runs and is elected has a three-year term. The nine directors meet within 10 days of the election to elect the officers. The president has been in office since 2017 and this can change with a vote from directors after the January elections. All directors will go to training to help them understand the duties and responsibilities they are expected to uphold. For years we had to beg people to run. We have new residents and hope new faces will run. What everyone needs to know is we



must abide by the Florida statue 723 and our bylaws in addition to the prospectus and rules. There is always a closed ballot vote at our annual meeting in January. Not sure why you think directors and officers need to be full time residents, but this can be addressed at the November meeting and we will try to post duties etc. in the next monthly media. Also, the President gets board approval for anything going on in these Covid-19 times. Residents normally get to vote at our meetings. There have not been any big changes, or we would call a special meeting.

Social was a separate corporation when ELS bought the park. ELS will only recognize the HOA and will only give monies to the HOA. The Social Director has a committee, and they plan events, but it must be approved by the board and ELS. We need to remember we have restrictions from ELS and what our insurance will cover. Events were limited this past year, but plans are made for the upcoming months. All events are posted in the clubhouses and on Facebook.

We did create a Facebook page and I try to keep postings being approved. I generally check it a few times a day. I ask residents who want to join if they are residents of Serendipity, so we don't have so many members. I will check the members against any list I have and clean up our members lists. There is a lot of movement in the park, so my lists are not always the most up to date. Do we a have volunteer who wants to also help administer the page?



The parking pass should have been delivered and gets us a few days when we have company, and the office is closed. Any visitor cars that fit in your driveway are safe there. Your guests should be registered at the office if they are visiting and staying.

Speeding is always an issue. I would hope you would notify the company that sends speeding delivery vehicles to our park and resident speeders to the office.

Flags have been discussed many times and they are flown as rules state. The Canadian flag has always been flown as they are a big part of our community. They are very active when we can have activities and they pay year-round as do the snowbirds. They are great neighbors. We are hoping the border opens for them and they get vaccinated and can be back for the Fall.

There are many opinions about our lawn care. Some like some do not. If you are home and you see something, ask them to correct their mistakes. If not contact the lawn service directly.

We requested lights on trees out front of the park but ELS has a different vision, so they win. They own the park and make the decisions.

Family gatherings cannot be accommodated at the clubhouses because HOA would not sponsor this. They would not have insurance to cover this.

The directory should be in your hands. Please help keep it up to date. As you have changes let us know.

Have a great safe summer. I will be back for the month of June, a week an August and again November to May. Contact me with any questions I can answer. -Pat

AMERICAN FLAG ETIQUETTE

EDITORS NOTE: With Flag Day, Monday, June 14, 2021 and Independence Day, July 4, 2021 quickly approaching and residents asking questions about our American Flag and its positioning, etc. I thought it would be nice to pass on this information. I have edited this article to fit into our space allowance. - Nanci Dorau

When displaying the flag, DO the following:

- Display the U.S. flag from sunrise to sunset on buildings and stationary flagstaffs in the open. When a patriotic effect is desired, the flag may be displayed 24-hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness.
- When placed on a single staff or lanyard, place the U.S. Flag above all other flags.
- When flags are displayed in a row, the U.S. flag goes to the observer's left. Flags of other nations are flown at same height. State and local flags are traditionally flown lower.
- When used during a marching ceremony or parade with other flags, the U.S. Flag will be to the observer's left.
- On special days, the flag may be flown at half-staff. On Memorial Day it is flown at half-staff until noon and then raised.
- When flown at half-staff, should be first hoisted to the peak for an instant and then lowered to the half-staff position. The flag should be again raised to the peak before it is lowered for the day. By "half-staff" is meant lowering the flag to one-half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff.

When stowing or disposing of the flag, DO the following:

- Fold in the traditional triangle for stowage, never wadded up.
- It is important that the fire be fairly large and of sufficient intensity to ensure complete burning of the flag.
- Place the flag on the fire.
- The individual(s) can come to attention, salute the flag, recite the Pledge of Allegiance, and have a brief period of silent reflection.
- After the flag is completely consumed, the fire should then be safely extinguished, and the ashes buried.
- Please make sure you are conforming to local/state fire codes or ordinances.

Quick list of Flag Étiquette Don'ts:

- Don't dip the U.S. Flag for any person, flag, or vessel.
- Don't let the flag touch the ground.
- Don't fly flag upside down unless there is an emergency.
- Don't carry the flag flat or carry things in it.
- Don't use the flag as clothing.
- Don't store the flag where it can get dirty.
- Don't use it as a cover.
- Don't fasten it or tie it back. Always allow it to fall free.
- Don't draw on, or otherwise mark the flag.
- Don't use the flag for decoration. Use bunting with the blue on top, then white, then red.



POTATOES DELUXE – HASH BROWN CASSEROLE

Ingredients:

- 2 lb. (900 gram) pkg frozen hash brown potatoes, thawed
- ¹/₂ cup melted butter
- 1 can (10.75 oz) cream of chicken or mushroom soup
- 1 cup sour cream
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chopped onions
- 2 cups shredded cheese
- Salt and pepper
- 2 cups crushed corn flakes or breadcrumbs
- ¹/₄ cup melted butter

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- Combine hash brown potatoes, melted butter, soup, sour cream, chopped onion, cheese, salt & pepper in large mixing bowl
- Toss mixture so potatoes are coated and place in 3-quart casserole dish
- Crush corn flakes or breadcrumbs, mix with ¹/₄ cup melted butter and sprinkle over top of casserole
- Bake covered for 40 minutes

NOTE: For 2-4 people, half the above recipe

THE CURIOSITY CORNER

Balloons and Dirigibles

an has desired to fly for thousands of years. Man has attempted to fly, with makeshift wings, by running down hills, jumping off cliffs and towers. I, on the other hand, used a tree or the slide on our swing set in the back yard. My attempts using sheets and cardboard wings were naturally resounding failures. Fortunately, my experiences were not too painful, and my friends and I eventually turned our energies towards other interests with admittedly mixed results. However, my interest in flight remained quite strong.

One wonders how many adventurous individuals, in the distant past, met their deaths attempting to fly. One famous Greek myth that comes to mind is Icurous. Defying warnings, he flew too close to sun only to have his

exhilarating experience cut short as his finely crafted wings melted off his arms.

There have occasionally been movie scenes depicting someone's disastrous attempt to fly.

The Silver Chalice, a rather odd, not particularly good, religious movie had an ambitious magician, played by Jack Palance. He believed that he could start his own religion. Convinced that he had become so good at his craft, he considered himself a god. To demonstrate his power, and gather disciples, he would fly around a tall tower without the aid of the cable that had held him up so many times before. Stepping out onto the platform he addressed the crowd that had gathered below. Upon completing his speech, and with great confidence, he stepped out into space, and with the cloak wings flapping in the breeze, fell to his death. Many individuals had to have met a similar harrowing fate trying to find a method to defy gravity.



The Chinese are credited with using small hot air balloons, lanterns, sometime in the 3rd century as military signaling devices. However, the claim for the first use of hot air balloons

is hotly contested. The Nazca Indians of Peru are thought to have used hot air balloons, around 700 B.C. to 200 A.D., as an aid to create the famous Nazca Line Drawings. Although I am not aware of documentation supporting that position other than one can only recognize the drawings from an immense height.


Some inventive individuals proposed powered flying machines to travel through the sky, while others thought that balloons provided the logical approach. Around 1400, Roger Bacon, a philosopher and Franciscan friar, proposed a large, thin, hollow copper sphere filled with liquid fire to keep it aloft. Later in 1670, Italian Jesuit priest Francesco Lana de Terzi proposed a plan for flotation. The vessel would have four, thin wall copper balls, 20 feet in diameter and entirely exhausted of air. Thereby being lighter than an equal bulk of atmosphere it would float, supposedly.

In 1709 a Portuguese Jesuit priest, Bartolomeu Lourenco de Gusmao in the presence of John V of Portugal and queen Maria Anna of Austria, and having as witnesses the Italian cardinal Michelangelo Conti, two members of the Portuguese Royal Academy of History, one Portuguese diplomat and one chronicler, demonstrated his theory by propelling a ball to the roof by combustion. He was given funds to build his machine, but it never flew.


The latter half of the 18th century saw a flurry of activity. Experiments using hot air or hydrogen filled balloons to lift loads. Animals were sent aloft to determine safety, distance and time aloft records were attempted. Then on the 21st of November 1783, in a balloon made by the Montgolfier Brothers, Pilatre de Rozier and François Laurent rose to about 500 feet above the Paris rooftops, and after drifting with the wind for approx. 25 minutes, successfully landed in vineyards a few miles away. Benjamin Franklin attended the launch and signed a witness report that was later submitted to the Academy of Science. Now many individuals the world over, realized that it was possible to travel above the trees and wanted to explore the possibilities.

How high could one go? Was it possible to steer a balloon or propel it through the air? Was one shape more efficient than another? Even the concept of parachutes was being explored during the last twenty years of 1700s or 18th century. By the Civil War, tethered balloons had been used for field observation in a couple wars. In the Civil War both sides tried using balloons, though primarily by the Union forces. The implementation of the new technology presented unforeseen problems in logistics, methods of communication between observer in the balloon and those on the ground, and its effective use. The Union determined that the advantages did not outweigh its limitations and discontinued the Balloon Corps in 1863.

Ironically, a young Prussian army officer, Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin, had attached himself to the Union Balloon Corps, in the Army of the Potomac, as an observer. During the time spent in the US he traveled to St. Paul, Minnesota where he took his first ascent in a balloon. He would later state that this experience was the beginning of his thinking about



dirigibles. His airships would bomb London during World War I and later give ocean passenger







ship lines a run for their money during the 1930s. However, the disasters of several US airships and the Hindenburg disaster in 1937 spelled the end for large airships.

There are two kinds of floating "lighter than air" crafts: the balloon and the airship. The balloon is unpowered, its direction determined by the whims of the wind, filled with heated air or a lighter than air gas, and can only lift. The airship is self-propelled and can lift as well as maneuverer in any direction against the wind. The fact that it is capable of steering itself classifies the craft as a dirigible. There are three types: rigid (like the Hindenburg), semi-rigid (like the Zeppelin NT), and blimps (like the Goodyear blimp) have no rigid structure. Goodyear and Zeppelin are currently working together to slowly replace Goodyear's blimp fleet with Zeppelin NT type airships. While the hot air balloon may not elicit the same excitement as a blimp or the giant Zeppelins of the past, the hot air balloon has set records. In 1991 the fastest ground speed of 245 mph in a balloon, designed to travel in the trans-oceanic jet stream, was recorded. In 1999 a two-man team broke distance, endurance, and time records by traveling around the world 19 days, 21 hours, and 55 minutes. In 2002 a man flying solo traveled around the world under 14 days. A manned altitude record of 68,986 ft. was set in 2005, and in 2016 a hybrid hot air/helium balloon went around the world under 12 days.

There are few modes of transportation that draws the attention and childlike awe, from the public, as a hot air balloon. The roar of the gas burners and the sight of a balloon will always draw spectators, each envious of the individual or individuals that ascend into the sky, to gently drift above the trees. They experience what many people may only dream. Then after their pilot has given them a couple thrills, they gently descend towards a randomly chosen landing site. Depending upon the wind, the landing may be a gentle touchdown or slightly bouncing drag across the ground to a stop. All aspects of that experience create a unique memorable experience. In fact, since you are so glad to have successfully completed the flight, you share a bottle of Champagne, a piece offering, with the owner of the property that almost always greets the uninvited guests. If one does not have a fear of heights and has the agility or willingness to let friends or strangers help them into, and out of the basket, it is truly worthwhile to seek out the experience.
