



4 eggs

A small instant chocolate pudding mix

1C milk

18 oz pkg. cool whip

1tsp. vanilla

Heat oven to 350°, mix cake as directed on box, pour into grease floured 9 x 13 pan. Mix ricotta cheese, sugar, eggs & vanilla. Spoon over top of unbaked cake. Bake 1 hour, cool. Mix pudding & milk, Fold in cool whip and spread over cake. Refrigerate – best if made the day before.





incolnshire has many new residents, seasonal, full time or a bit of both. Also of importance is they can be new to Florida and its wet and hurricane season. Leaving where there are blizzards, snow, freezing temperatures and tornados.

Hurricane and tropical storm season starts June first and usually over by mid or late November. 6 months of watching the weather on TV or listening on the radio/internet. Late August to early November are the key months for activity especially coming from western Africa or the Caribbean basin. Some storms pinball their way back and forth in the Gulf of Mexico. Let's not fool ourselves, tropical storms can leave as much rain as a hurricane.

This month's article and in July I will try to provide some tips on preparing our coaches, sheds, carports and planters for extreme weather. As a community we must understand that our lack of preparation can and often does effect the home next door and well down the street. Doesn't matter if we feel safer tucked in-between 2 other coaches, in a cul-de-sac or on a corner lot. Nor a single, double wide, newer and higher or older and lower to the ground. The age of our coach also determines our vulnerability to damage. Add on the number of carport extensions, Florida/screened-in rooms to our coaches can often make ensuring limited damage a bit tougher.

We are fortunate at Lincolnshire that we do have wide streets for emergency vehicles both medical and energy, a robust storm run-off sewer system and modern amenities like our recreation center and laundry room. Our electrical grid in below ground although there are above ground pedestals serving coaches in the original park streets. We all are subject to general power outages outside the park. Duke Energy is very responsive and offers updates on outages both on TV, internet and on our phones.

Next month we will cover some often missed items in and around our coaches that require assessing before the storms start.

We have plenty of time to look under our coaches to ensure our barrier is intact plus the coach tie downs are secure.

If you are reading this and are not a Member please take the opportunity to join. Ensure your voice is heard and also have a vote. The Association's strength is in its membership and let's always maintain that.

The listing of LHOA Directors and contact information is found in the Voice first page and posted on the bulletin board. Questions concerning our obligations on being a tenet should be

re you getting on in years? Just like our humans, senior pets have mobility needs. However, those needs are more specific and require different care than those of younger pets. Get to know the unique challenges our older friends face and how to keep us moving for years to come.

So, what's going on? It can be hard to know what causes your slow down, but don't blame your pet's slow movement to just aging. Age alone doesn't explain why a dog or cat suddenly has difficulty climbing steps or lost interest in playing with toys. Sometimes you might not even notice that a pet is experiencing mobility problems until they develop symptoms we can't ignore, like a visible limp, or drastic decrease in activity. There may be likely treatable issues at hand. So, remember – senior doesn't necessarily mean slow. It would be advisable to have a talk with your veterinarian to get to the root of the problem.

A common cause for a dog's slow down is joint problems leading to stiffness and limping. Osteoarthritis is one possible reason and can actually be found at any stage of a pet's life. Happily, it can be managed with the help of your vet.

Unfortunately, one main reason for mobility issues is obesity. Excess weight can put an unnecessary strain on your dog or cat's bones and joints, putting them at higher risk for developing more debilitating conditions.

On another note, we have listened to residents complain at time about cats pooping in planters. Cats will commonly use gardens a litter trays, as they seem to enjoy defecating on soil, mulch, and gravel. This can a very unpleasant problem that many gardeners battle with, and it is incredibly frustrating to find the garden you have spent time nurturing to be overrun with cat feces. To try to combat a cat problem, pour your coffee grounds in small piles around your plants, or mix it into the top layer of your soil. The smell is believed to deter cats. Ensure you don't create a carpet of coffee grounds, as this can block soil from getting needed moisture

VETERAN'S CORNER

w many of you would like to learn to play guitar? Established in 2007, Guitars for Vets, a non-profit organization, came together when Marine Corps Veteran Dan Van Buskirk took months of guitar lessons from Patrick Nettesheim. Through their lessons, Van Buskirk was able to learn to play the guitar and since then, the two became friends. Both realized that these lessons created an outlet for expression as well as provided a positive interaction. Together they went



to the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to share their story. Since then, Guitars for Vets, or G4V, has expanded to be operating out of 110 VA chapters in 40 states. The G4V guitar instruction program can help Veterans working through physical injuries, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and other forms of emotional distress. Music therapy is an evidence-based clinical treatment designed to help Veterans through music. The therapy can help improve Veterans' communication, coordination and interpersonal skills. Nettesheim also developed the G4V "four-way path," which consists of Patience, Acceptance, Gratitude and Empathy (PAGE). These are the guiding principles used throughout the program. The G4V program starts with a 10-week instruction period. During this time Veterans are given one-on-one individualized lessons. They promote teaching the music that appeals to the student and works at the students' pace. After completing the lessons, the graduation process involves receiving a free acoustic guitar and guitar accessory kit. The next step is to continue practicing and learning. Each month there are group sessions organized by one of the 110 chapters and growing. The group sessions develop a community of fellow Veterans and guitarist. To date, GV4 has provided over 4,000 guitars to Veterans. Enrollment in G4V requires a referral from a case or social worker to a local VA office that offers a G4V program. G4V does not control admission into the program. To find a local chapter they offer a locator tool on their site https:// guitars4vets.org/about-us/find-a-chapter/.

Veterans are encouraged to start logging into the site using their current Digital Service (DS) Logon or creating a new account using ID.me. "VA.gov offers Veterans an enhanced site in terms of usability and security with the implementation of two-factor authentication," said Acting VA Under Secretary for Benefits Thomas Murphy. "The most frequently used features are now readily accessible on one website to include the ability to file a disability claim, check the status of a claim or change direct deposit and payment history." The eBenefits site will remain functional through March 31, 2022, to give Veterans an opportunity to complete claims started on the platform. Thereafter, VA.gov becomes the single source solution to access VA benefit and service information online. U.S. Digital Service worked with thousands of Veterans to test the new and improved VA.gov. The department wanted to ensure Veterans deemed the site functional before migrating Veterans' data.

Without being specific to any chronic condition let's say that <u>you must have</u> certain medications, oxygen, nursing services, dialysis, just had major surgery, batteries for equipment vital to your survival that require replenishment <u>within 10 days</u>. Why 10 days? In a major weather event or disaster the supply of what you absolutely need to live isn't around the corner anymore plus the supply lines to vendors, pharmacies, hospitals, clinics, home health can be threatened. We live in a new supply world where large expensive reserves of almost everything are no longer kept close. With the continued Covid virus supply chains are further constrained. Dependence on UPS and FedEx is pervasive. We are somewhat fortunate in we live in a location where supplies most seniors need are more plentiful but not endless. Being a global economy our medical supplies often come from outside the U.S.

As an RN in Florida's Disaster response team we start with when to actually start preparing. **TODAY!** Preparing isn't as hard as we think. Take it one step at a time. Starting now means you won't rush and forget something vital.

The first is life sustaining equipment. Oxygen and the equipment required to deliver is #1. Find an invoice from the vendor who brings the oxygen and maintains the devices. Put the invoice in an envelope that you will fill with other information. Take a picture with your phone too. If you have a second portable unit always ensure the other one is always full and ready to use. If you have large oxygen canisters they will be hard to transport. Oxygen concentrators can be heavy though newer versions are much lighter. You can't expect every shelter will have unlimited oxygen available. If any. Always register early with the shelters. Also shelters may not have consistent electricity to power equipment. If your equipment has rechargeable batteries then keep them charged. Pinellas County Disaster management can help you know where the best shelter is for you! Staying at home may not be an option and can be deadly. Mandatory evacuations mean emergency services have shutdown. The police will drive through our park several times and tell us still here that we are now on our own. Don't die in your coach.

The second is medications. If you don't have a current list of your medications then you can write down your own or better have you pharmacy print yours list. Medication organizers are a must to have. Also reminds me what day it is! However the downside is that someone else has no idea what each pill is. Believe me. So, keep your back up supply of medications in their original container from the pharmacy. Have at least one pill etc. in the prescription container from the pharmacy. Do not ever wait until the last minute to have your medications including syringes refilled. Remember, shelters don't have pharmacies and getting some vital medications in a disaster can be very difficult if not impossible. Get a plastic container with a locking lid to store all of your medications. Put your full name on the container.

Some liquid medications require refrigeration. Often they come in a Styrofoam container. Keep one, always! Don't toss the frozen ice bag either. Store it in your freezer. Always assume the shelter doesn't have refrigeration or the ability to keep it cool. Oh, write your name on the cooler! I once had someone say that their insulin is in the white one. There were 20 white ones.

Get ready and start today. Help a neighbor get ready too. We are a community.
