Dear Fellow Residents: The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Lake Seminole Resort (LSR) is initiating a monthly activity report to help improve communications in the park. Please let us know if this newsletter is helpful and if you would like to see any changes, additions, or deletions.

In this letter, several items will be discussed. If you have any questions regarding any of these items, please send a note to the Board.

Committees: The Board has established written charters for the Compliance Committee, Standards Committee, and Fining Committee. These charters detail the authorization delegated to each committee and the processes needed to enforce our rules and regulations. We are still in need of committee members. If anyone would like to join a committee, please send Steve Schaefer a note.

Pool: Toward the end of 2020, the pool water experienced several issues. Ed Schuster has worked diligently to correct the issues. We have repaired water leaks, replaced filters, repaired symbiont heaters, changed out chemical controllers, and added extra chemicals as needed. The county health inspector has given LSR an acceptable rating for our water quality. As a result of the hard work, the pool water has improved and there have not been any reported issues for the past five months.

Maintenance: Our maintenance work continues throughout the park. Weeds were removed from the common areas of Lake Seminole in accordance with our permit. We changed the vendor who was spraying the weeds in the lake to a new vendor. The new vendor started spraying the first part of May. Andrew (our maintenance person) is pressure washing the sidewalks as he has the time. In the past, volunteers took on the job of cleaning the sidewalks but with the lack of residents coming to the park this year, volunteers were not available.

Pool chairs have been repaired, saving the park substantial money. Again, this is normally done by volunteers, but Andrew and Dave Middleton took on this job this year.

We have sprayed for fleas in the common areas around the pond and the near the lake.

Four palm trees were planted around the park and mowing has been increased for the summer months to once a week.

Garbage pick-up has been reduced for the summer months.

Paul Burke, one of your directors, has put together a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) compilation for the chemicals used in the park. This is the first time the park has had a complete, centralized SDS book. The binder is in the maintenance shed.

Water Usage: City water usage is still a concern. It appears that the actual usage is increasing. This is needs to be addressed as the county is increasing our rates by up to 19% over a period of two years. The Board, in conjunction with some residents, are looking at mitigating actions.

Compliance and Home Changes: Ann Haines, one of your directors, is the chairperson of the Compliance Committee. She is working to improve the time to either approve or disapprove any changes requested by residents.

Legal Issues: One of our long-term residents died from Covid earlier this year. He passed without leaving a will. This creates an issue for the park in collecting fees and determining the status of the home. Our lawyer is leading the effort to resolve this issue. His fees and our expenses will be paid for out of the deceased resident's estate. The time to resolve this is several months due to the extended legal process.

Office: A new high-speed router was installed in the office. This should support the park's evolving needs for the next few years. In addition, a new server was installed to support the cameras in the park. The old server failed and was obsolete.

Web Site: The Lakeseminoleresort.org web site is the official internet site for park business. A new feature to the site is the availability to list properties for rent. To submit your home for rent, log onto the site and fill out the form for houses for sale or rent. This form will then be reviewed for inclusion on the site.

New Residents: We have a few new residents moving into the park as well as some relocations.

• Cash and Reserves: the \$30,148 charges to the reserve fund were movement of money *continued on page 9*

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from the reserves to the operating account for maintenance items covered by reserves in 2020. These reserves were allocated to pool heaters and filters which were replaced in 2020.

- \$9800 dollars were spent to clean-up the lake weeds. Of this, \$4000 were reimbursed the park by a resident who generously shared in the cost of the clean-up. Board took this action to continue to beautify the park and allow boats to access the cove by the hall. The Board also believed that this expense could be recouped through cost savings in other areas of the operating budget not aligned to the pool, water, and electric.
- The water and electric bills continue to be above budget. The park water rates have been increased this year by approximately nine percent (9%) over last year. The rates are scheduled to increase another nine percent (9%) next year. The Board and some trusted residents are monitoring the water usage to determine if anything can be done to mitigate the aggregate rise in our water expenses.
- The computer and web expense is due to the replacement of the cameral server that failed.
- Pool expenses increased due to a chemical controller that required replacement as well as the increase in chemical to treat the pool.
- The pond expense increase was due to the pump that required replacement.

Reminders: Just a few reminders for all residents:

- Please register all guests at the office.
- When leaving the park for the season or returning for the season, please register at the office.
- Remember to register your pet.
- When leaving the park for the season, please remember to prepare your home for the time you will be gone. You can find a list of suggestions in the May bulletin.
- Remember, no furniture or appliances are allowed in the refuse area.
- If you see trespassers, please call the police.
- Keep your cars locked and valuables out of sight.
- When planning changes to your home, please fill out the appropriate forms available in the office. Board approval is required for most changes to your home. But please note, your requests will be addressed as quickly as possible and with thoughtfulness.

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
