

#### MESSAGES FROM MANAGEMENT

Ust a couple of Reminders from the Gateway Mobile Home Park. Well the weekend is upon us yet again and although we hope everyone enjoys their weekend and enjoys all the amenities here at Gateway we have been noticing some troubling trends beginning that we would like to stop before they get out of hand.



#1 GLASS BEER BOTTLES IN POOL AREA- for those who don't know about this rule, this is not a new rule but there is ABSOLUTLY NO GLASS ALLOWED IN POOL AREA,

including beer bottles. If a glass of any kind gets broken in the pool or in close proximity the pool must be shut down immediately, and will remain closed until at which time it can be drained and cleaned to insure the safety of our residents. (THIS RULE APPLIES TO ALL GATEWAY RESIDENTS AND GUEST.)

**#2 DOGS-** More and more of our Residents are becoming pet owners which is great but it is the duty of ALL pet owners to clean up EVERY TIME after your pet. This means throughout



the park as well as the Dog Park. You took it upon yourself to get a pet; you should be the one to clean up after it. This is no one else's responsibility; your neighbors should not have to pick up poop from their yards or Dog Park from your dog. It's just not right.

**#3 CATS-** This will be my final notation about people letting their cats roam the park. Cats are pets the same as dogs and should be held to the same rules and regulations. Therefore if I continue to see cats roam the park (No leashes, No tags or registration) I will have no other choice but to have them



picked up by animal control. This issue has been addressed more than once with no change. So please keep your cats inside if you wish to keep them.

Note: A Little add on.

That pool is a 40,000 gal pool. At almost a dollar a gallon to refill will be a considerable expense and Gateway office will not foot the total bill plus expense to clean it. So hopefully residents and guests will keep this in mind as well.

First off the Gateway Mobile Home Park office would like to thank all of our residents that have taken such great interest in making Gateway a better and safer place to live. With that being said, I receive on a daily bases at least 20 to 30 calls from our residents telling me of rules that are being violated or ignored. Now we all as adult know the rules and should be glad to follow them so that we all can enjoy our home and community, But there are others that are not as willing to



follow the rules like the rest of us which in the long run makes our home office set down rules that effect us all and not always in a good way.

I will tell you that I do hear all of your objections and I try my best to take them seriously but in most cases only one resident saw the violation but with it not in writing or a picture it is so very hard to prove especially if the offender denies the claim, then it becomes 'He said She said' and really nothing can be done about it. But if we have a picture or video proof then the allegation would be undeniable and it gives the office much more leeway into fixing the issue.

Now days almost all of us have cameras and or cell phones with camera and video capabilities. You don't even have to bring them to the office, you can email them to me (<u>Gateway@ ARCInvestments.com</u>) and I will keep your name out of it. I would just like us all to get to the point where it is second nature to follow ALL of the rules, Not only because we take pride in where we live but also because we never know who is watching and may or may not catch in a photo or video.

#### **LOCAL CORONA VIRUS AT A GLANCE**

s of May 15th there were 1771 reported cases in the Gateway Zip Code (33716). There are about 435 residents here at Gateway and to my knowledge we experienced less than a 1% rate of infections. We know for certain more than 20% of park residents have been vaccinated. I believe the number to be much greater.



As a 55+ park, Gateway has been a 'vulnerable' community and from the beginning of the alarms as to the dangers presented by the virus I am pleased to say that virtually all of us have taken the steps necessary to protect ourselves and friends and neighbors from transmission of any cold or flu, let alone Covid-19. The history of the spread then deceleration of cases and deaths in the State of Florida is strong evidence as to just how responsible the State's residents, both year around and seasonal, reacted to the danger and took the precautions necessary.



#### **ONLINE SECURITY – FACEBOOK**

The Editor

I receive a monthly Norton Security email bulletin and my May email contained a link to this interesting piece from Yahoo Finance.



Facebook data in January, and now that data appears to have escaped into the wild. According to Business Insider, security researcher Alon Gal has discovered that a user on a hacking forum has made the entire dataset public, exposing details for about 533 million Facebook members. The data includes phone numbers, birth dates, email addresses and locations, among other revealing info.

About 32 million of the users are in the US, while 11 million are from the UK and another 6 million come from India.

Gal first spotted the data in January, when Telegram users could pay to search the database. The intruders reportedly took advantage of a flaw that Facebook fixed in August 2019 and reportedly includes information from before that fix. You might not be in trouble if you're a relative newcomer or have changed key details in the time since the fix, but the breach still leaves many people vulnerable.

We've asked Facebook for comment.

As Gal noted, Facebook can only do so much when the data is already in circulation and the related flaw is no longer an issue. The social network could notify affected users, though, and there's pressure on the company to alert affected users so they can watch for possible spam calls and fraud.

In recent months some of us at Gateway have received Facebook Friend Requests from people who are already Friends and in some cases have been for years. Friend requests from existing 'Friends' are nearly always a scam attempt to gain access to your own Facebook page and friend list. Setting up a Facebook page/account and using an existing name of someone is allowed. Different individuals do have the same names. But it should become obvious that something nefarious is happening when someone with the same name is looking to have Friends with the same names as another.

I make it a practice to never accept Friend requests from existing Friends unless I am contacted personally and told they have set up a 'new' account.

I take pains to limit my Friend list and especially to limit access of my list to 'Friends only' and not 'Friends of Friends'. My current Friend list is 70, one is a dog and three I know for sure are deceased, I really should do a close review and 'unFriend' those with whom I will never share further contact. So if I do not respond to your friend request, please do not take it personally.
