



The boy, however, couldn't sleep, because he kept wondering if the girl had secretly kept some of her candy, just like he did with the marble.




priest, a minister, and a guru sat in a new interfaith community center. While a telecommunications worker installed the new phone system, they began discussing the best positions for prayer.
