

The subject of bears in the county came up – please do not put birdseed or any other type of food for critters (including cat food for the stray cats) outside as bears can smell it from far away.

Another issue is empty homes and the fact that they draw bugs, termites, rodents and cats. We cannot force owners to come to their homes, but if there are issues that can be taken care of, such as weeds, painting, power washing, etc., please contact the office and they will take a look and contact the owners. If the owners don't take care of it within 3 weeks of notice, the park will do it and charge the owners.

We discussed new activities for the summer and everyone is happy with the fact that summer activities are taking place. More info coming on the July Piper calendar.

Beth said they will be testing the new electronic voting system. If you've signed up for that, look for an email in the next few weeks for a test vote.

- Also, our maintenance man Doug is no longer with us. We have hired Will Daisy.
- There is going to be a Crime Prevention Meeting at the Clubhouse on June 30 with Deputy Skipper at 11:00. This first meeting is going to discuss Crime Prevention only, and future meetings will cover additional subjects.
- Lot 276 was sold at auction, and the new owner is trying to re-sell the house. He hasn't done the proper paperwork to become a resident, and therefore cannot sell the home at this time. Beth is trying to reach him, with no response. The home is a tear-out situation.
- Beth also said that gates at the entrances are not going to happen. Our park is just not laid out for this and there are too many issues with having them. But we are looking into getting more and better resolution cameras.
- There will be sewer work to address an issue behind unit #50, where the old clay pipes are getting roots in them. They will be replaced with PVC at a cost of about \$7000 or less.
- There is also a depression remediation at #283, where the Florida room is sinking. This starts on July 21 and will cost approximately \$20,000 as they have to put piers in at a depth of 30 feet. We do have money in the GeoTech Account for this issue.
- Also, if you see solicitors in the park, note the date and time, and then call the Suspicious Activities line -- 727-582-6177 -- and they will come out and take care of it. Do not approach them.

Bill Shedd covered hurricane preparedness and recovery. They delivered the Hurricane Preparation Guides throughout the park. Specifically, everyone must remove anything from their property that could become airborne during a storm, such as: potted plants, welcome mats, tables and chairs, figurines/statues, etc. Put these items either in your shed or inside your home. Lowering your awnings is also a good idea if you're gone for an extended period of time. The office has forms for people with special needs to enable them to get space at a special needs shelter. These shelters are for people in wheelchairs, on walkers or on oxygen, etc. You need to fill this form out each year and mail it in. We do have two generators at the park, one for the office and one for the library. Should we be out of power for any length of time, the library will be available for people who need to refrigerate medicines, charge phones, plug in their oxygen, and, in general, get out of the heat and be in the air conditioning.

Also, when cleaning up your homes, please look at your mailbox. The older plastic ones are very hard to clean and some are looking pretty shabby. If you need a new mailbox, come to the office, and for \$25 they can get a new one for you.

Security at the park – due to the golf cart thefts, people have talked about having a neighborhood watch program that would include residents on golf carts going around the park after midnight. You can do this if you want but it is NOT sanctioned by the park or by the police. If you see something suspicious, please call Pinellas County Sheriff's office at 727-582-6200 or the Suspicious Activities line at 727-582-6177. Put these numbers in your cell phone for easy accessibility – I just did. If you will be gone for an extended period of time, you can also call them and ask to be put on the list for home safety checks. One of the best things you can do at your own home is LOCK THINGS UP! And use a motion detector light or put in cameras that notify your cell phone if anyone is in your carport. It was reported that these cameras are about \$120. LOCK UP AND LIGHT UP!

There was no financial report due to new company, but will have one at next meeting. Beth and Sharon met with the auditors and they cleaned up a lot of little stuff, and everyone learned a lot.

Unfinished Business: There will be NO water meters on resident homes. However, we will install them on common buildings specifically for leak detection (less than \$1000).

No new business. Meeting adjourned.





The Silver Rollers

Tim and Shirley Billingsly, Unit #187, in 1994, Jim age 61 and Shirley age 60, decided to take roller skating lessons! They took lessons for a couple of years in Maryland, then in 1996 decided to move to Lake Highlander. Continuing their lessons here, they learned to do the more complicated dances and moves. There was the Glide Waltz, the March, the Blues, the cross and the double cross, and many more. Shirley also learned one of the hardest skate moves, called figures. Easier to do on ice skates than on roller skates, for sure!

During their time in Dunedin, they first skated at Rainbow, on Ulmerton Road (now a car repair shop), then at Southland in Pinellas Park (now named Astro), and then on to Spination in Port Richey. (When the floor was replaced at Spination, Jim was able to take some of the wood and made a side table for their home.) Their group, called Senior Rollers, had the rink to themselves during the day a couple times a week. They would start in a "free skate" and then the host would call out a specific dance and the group would go into that dance, then another would be called, and another, and then back to "free skate". All of this was to the old-fashioned organ music that we all remember from our younger days at the rink, and sometimes "Mr. Lucky" would play live.

The Senior Rollers had a few ladies that would sew costumes and bring them to the rink for the other ladies to buy. Shirley had a minimum of 50 costumes in her closet! Jim would wear tan pants and a colored shirt to match her costumes. They made many good friends over the years, some of them still skating well into their 80's.

After skating for over 17 years, they had to give it up, but they still go to the rink to see their friends (except this year due to COVID), but look forward to going back next year. Jim also plays the organ and is a very talented artist, and Shirley does beautiful 3-D embroidery. Jim says, "We'd like to be able to skate anywhere, but it won't happen!"



We'll start out with this frequently requested recipe from Shirley Greer, which turns out to be the Original Nestle Toll House Chocolate Chip Cookie recipe – but it is does make very good cookies!!

ORIGINAL NESTLE TOLL HOUSE CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES

2 ½ cups all-purpose flour

1 tsp. baking soda

1 tsp. salt

1 cup (2 sticks) butter, softened

³/₄ cup granulated sugar

3/4 cup packed brown sugar

1 tsp. vanilla extract

2 large eggs

2 cups (12 oz.) Nestle Toll House Semi-Sweet Chocolate Morsels

1 cup chopped nuts (if omitting nuts, add 1 to 2 tsp. of all-purpose flour)

Preheat oven to 375°.

In a small bowl, combine flour, baking soda and salt.

In a large mixing bowl, beat butter, granulated sugar, brown sugar and vanilla extract until creamy.

Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.

Beat in flour mixture gradually.

Stir in morsels and nuts.

Drop onto ungreased baking sheets by rounded teaspoon.

Bake for 9-11 minutes or until golden brown.

Cool on baking sheets for 2 minutes; remove to wire rack to cool completely.

Makes about 5 dozen cookies.

"And what if you run out of money" inquired the father. "I will come home and get some," readily replied the child.






