Let's keep it that way and continue to attract people to our park. In order to do that, we must not only maintain but upgrade any outdated areas.

MANAGER'S MESSAGE

ndependence Day – July 4th - Happy Birthday USA. The business office will be closed on Monday, July 5th for the National Holiday.

Activities – It is so nice seeing some of the activities have started up again! Thankfully, those of us that have been vaccinated no longer need to wear masks!

<u>Hurricane Season</u> – I like to share a tip on preparing for storm season. Four years ago, I purchased a 2-Week 1-Person Emergency Food Supply. In it is a variety of great-tasting (I haven't tried them yet) emergency foods such as Fettuccine Alfredo, Maple Brown Sugar Oatmeal as well

as delicious dry soup mixes like Creamy Potato Soup. There is also dehydrated fruit and Morning Moo's® Low Fat Milk Alternative, a delicious dry powdered milk drink. In total, the kit provides 140 servings of 1,828 calories per day food. This will give my husband and I one week of food in an emergency. The bucket has a life of 25 years, so we still have 21 more years until it expires. You can purchase a variety of different types of food options and enough to last for a year or more. The one pictured is the one we purchased. As storms approach nonperishable foods become scarce so Brad and I know we won't starve!



<u>Windows</u> – The Board of Directors will be reviewing bids for the replacement of windows in the Office/Library/Fitness building. I am sure the park will save a considerable amount of money



in energy costs when the new windows are installed. The new windows will also be impact rated and be much less likely to suffer damage from high winds.

Mosquitos – Pinellas County has a mosquito control division. There are 11 zones in the county. If you are bothered by mosquitos around your home, call 727-464-7503, or email mosquitocontrol@pinellascounty.org and they will send someone out to inspect your home's exterior. For the best personal protection, use a repellent containing Deet, Picaridin or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus and/or wear loose, light-colored long sleeves and pants.

<u>Mailboxes</u> - The mailboxes still have not been delivered. The Maintenance Team has given both laundry facilities a new look in preparation of them becoming mail rooms too.

<u>Rule Reminder</u> - According to the Declaration of Master Form Occupancy Agreement, Monthly Maintenance Fees are due on the 1st of each month and become late on the 5th of the month. When payments are received late, the owner(s) is assessed a fee of either 5% of the delinquent amount of \$25.00, whichever is greater. When the next payment is made, it will be first applied to any interest that was assessed, then to a late fee, then it will be applied to the attorney or management company's cost. The portion remaining will be applied to the owner's outstanding balance.

- Jefferson and Adams supposedly signed it on July 4, but most signed a clean copy, produced by, Timothy Matlack, assistant to the secretary of Congress, on August 2, 1776. Some waited until January, 1777, to sign, when the document was made public.
- There was a celebration party in Philadelphia on July 8, 1776. George Washington, who had not heard what was happening in Philadelphia so wrote his own declaration on July 2, heard the news on July 9, Georgia on August 10, and London, England on August 30. Canada
- The British North America Act was the law passed by the British Parliament on March 29, 1867 to combine New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Upper and Lower Canada (Ontario and Quebec) to create the Dominion of Canada. It came into effect on July 1, 1867. It also received Royal Assent on March 29, 1867.
- The Fathers of Confederation (36 men from the British North American colonies who attended several conferences) assisted in the writing of the BNA Act.
- The act outlines the structure of government in Canada and the distribution of powers between the central Parliament and the provincial legislatures.
- In 1982 the BNA Act was renamed the Constitution Act, 1867. This was a result of repatriation where the document was transferred to Canada from England allowing Canada to make changes to the Constitution without England's approval.
- On April 17, 1982, Queen Elizabeth II, Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau, Minister of Justice, Jean Chrétien, and André Ouellet, the Registrar General, signed the Proclamation which brought the Constitution Act, 1982 into being.

So, there you have it in a nutshell of how both countries got to where we are today.
