COVID PROTOCOLS RELAXED AS OF MAY 31, 2021

May be amended as necessary. Watch for announcements.

1. MASKS: No longer required.

Those who have not taken the vaccination are strongly urged to continue social distancing and wear a mask when indoors or at a large gathering.

2. HOURS OF OPERATION: 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. – All facilities accessible using key fob Hand sanitizer will be available in Park facilities.

- **3. GOLF CARTS ON GOLF COURSE:** More than 1 person is permitted in the golf carts.
- 4. SIGN-IN SHEETS will continue to be used at all amenity locations.
- **5. LIMITS ON FUNCTIONS:** All events/functions involving more than 50 attendees must be approved by the Park Manager.

HURRICANE SEASON TIPS AND HELP

URRICANE SEASON runs through November 30. It is time to plan what you will do if a hurricane is forecast to hit the Tampa Bay area. If an evacuation order is issued, Palm Hill is a mandatory evacuation zone as are all mobile home communities.



Should you choose to remain in the park and need medical or emergency assistance, the authorities will not respond as they will be dealing with other emergencies and you should have heeded the evacuation order. The nearest shelter is Largo High School at 410 Missouri Avenue North; this is a pet friendly shelter but will probably fill up quickly. The two Clubhouses here in Palm Hill are not rated as hurricane shelters and therefore cannot be used by residents as a shelter.

Due to liability issues both Clubhouses will be locked down when an evacuation order is issued. Please ensure that your gutters are cleaned out and any pots, chairs, planters or anything that may become airborne are stored either in the shed or inside the home.

Maintenance is responsible for ensuring that the common areas are secured, and, if time allows, we will pick up items that were not stored and remove them to the sanitation field.

NEW BEGINNER COMPUTER CLASSES OFFERED ON WEDNESDAYS





BOOKS TO READ:

Recommended/Reviewed by Book Club Founder Susan Fisher

Books about pandemics/epidemics.



Pale Horse, Pale Rider by Katherine Ann Porter is a short novel set during the influence pandemic of 1918, which killed five times as many Americans as did WW I. Its main character, Miranda, is a young reporter who falls in love with a soldier; the book's fever-dream-style captures the experience of the disease.

The Andromeda Strain by Michael Crichton is a best-selling techno-thriller that begins when a military satellite crashes to earth and releases an extraterrestrial organism that kills almost everyone in a nearby small town. Then things go from bad to worse.

<u>Love in the Time of Cholera</u> by Gabriel Garcia Marquez is the great Colombian author's beguiling tale of a 50-year-old courtship, in which lovesickness is as debilitating and stubborn as the disease.

<u>Nemesis</u> by Philip Roth is the author's last novel set in Newark N.Y. in 1944, as the U.SA. is in the grip of the polio epidemic that killed and disabled thousands of children.

Station Eleven by Emily St. John Mandel is a bestselling novel about a group of actors and musicians traveling through the Great Lakes region in future years after a mysterious pandemic called the Georgian flu has killed almost everyone. I read this one when it came out with such great reviews. The whole point is we can't just exist. We must continue with music, theatre, etc. as we can.)

<u>The Old Drift</u> by Namwalli Serpell is a dazzling debut novel set in Zambia, spanning a century but focusing in part on the disaster wrought in that country by the HIV-AIDS epidemic.
