

Call AARP Fraud Watch Network Helpline: 877-908-3360

This toll-free service is available Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. ET

o you think you have been targeted or have fallen victim to a scam?

Common signs include:

- Receiving a call asking for money or personal information like your Social Security #
- Finding unauthorized charges on your credit card.
- Getting an email or call saying you've won a sweepstakes or lottery you don't recall entering.

AARP's Fraud Watch Network Helpline, a free resource for AARP members and non-members alike, can provide the information you need to protect yourself and your family.

The Helpline is operated by staff and volunteers with extensive training and experience fighting scams that target older Americans. "We know that older people, and people in general, need a wise friend or need support when it comes to dealing with scams and fraud," says Amy Nofziger, director of the Fraud Watch Network Helpline. "The most important thing our volunteers do is that they listen, and they listen without judgment."

Report Scams and Fraud

If you get a suspicious call, text or email (for example, requesting your bank account number, instructing you to buy a gift card or promising an expensive prize), or if you, a relative or a friend has given money or financial information to someone you now suspect was a scammer, call 877-908-3360.

Our volunteers can offer you:

- Tips and advice on how to spot a scam.
- Concrete steps you can take to avoid fraud.
- Actions to take if you have been victimized by fraud.
- Emotional support from peers who have experienced fraud.
- Guidance for families concerned that a loved one is being scammed.
- Referrals to law enforcement and other agencies that fight or investigate fraud.
- Translation services available.

In addition, your call helps AARP and our federal, state and community partners spot scam trends and respond to emerging threats. "People who call us, they're our boots on the ground," Nofziger says. "They're our eyes and ears to what's happening out in the scam world."

HURRICANE SEASON 2021

T's time to start planning for an emergency evacuation now. Pinellas County has a HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS GUIDE available to view online at:



http://www.pinellascounty.org/emergency/pdf/all hazard guide.pdf

Inside this 16 page guide, the emphasis is on three things: 1. Know your Risk; 2. Make a Plan, and 3. Stay Informed. Please note that **ALL MOBILE HOMES IN PINELLAS COUNTY MUST EVACUATE** when an Evacuation Order is issued, no matter where in the County they are located. Community centers in mobile home parks may not be safe shelters.

Before you evacuate, you should place shutters or plywood over windows, remove loose items from around the exterior of your unit, lower/remove awnings and shut off power and/or breakers.

If you are not able to evacuate to neighbors or friends homes, the best option may be a hotel. Know what hotels are available. Visit St. Pete/Clearwater participates in a statewide Accommodations Availability and Information Hotline. Call (800) 317-5050 or visit www.visitstpeteclearwater.com/storm, which is active before and after a storm. Make reservations early and call ahead to confirm your stay. Bring your own food and water and enough supplies to last for two weeks.

Special needs shelters are for those who need minimal medical assistance or who are dependent on electricity for life-sustaining equipment. Please preregister for special needs shelters by calling (727) 464-3800 or visit: www.pinellascounty.org/specialneeds to download a form and find more information.

Planning for your pet is covered on page 7 of the Guide, with supplies needed on page 10.

For a complete list of items/supplies needed for evacuation and more information about preparation, please refer to the guide listed in the first paragraph of this article.

For news and updates during the storm check Pinellas County Connection Television (PCC-TV) - Information on county programs and services, general preparedness and live updates during emergencies from the Emergency Operations Center. Watch it on Spectrum 637, WOW! 18 or Frontier 44. YouTube for Pinellas County Government has videos on general hurricane information. www.youtube.com/pcctv1

During emergencies, the County Information Center is open. Call (727) 464-4333. During non-emergency times, call Pinellas County Emergency Management at (727) 464-3800 or email: ema@pinellascounty.org. The safety of you and your family, and community depends on each of us taking responsibility by knowing your risk, making a plan and staying informed.



TOP MEDICAL ALERTS OF 2021

outhwind is a great Community for those of us who are aging in place and living independently, because we have so many caring and helpful neighbors. Bill Adams, HOA President, wrote about one of our residents who fell on the floor and was unable to get up laying there for several days. Luckily, another neighbor heard the cry



for help and called 911. Fortunately, this neighbor's crisis was averted, a life was saved and recovery is in progress.

What can we do to prevent an incident like this from taking our life? Whether you are married or single, a "HELP" button is available and could save your life!

After researching providers of personal emergency response systems, on the website: www.consumersadvocate.org, I found some helpful information to share. Some solutions also serves family caregivers who want to stay connected, even if they live apart. Here are the top 5 options:

- #1 MEDICAL GUARDIAN 1-800-487-7415, currently offering 1 free month, free activation, shipping, a free lock box and a free extra button for new customers. There are options for mobile phones or land lines. Their recently released smartwatch provides a variety of features. There are 602 customer reviews on this website and a quoted BBB A+ rating.
- #2 BAY ALARM MEDICAL 1-877-522-9633 has a risk-free trial for 30 days, offers in-home medical alert with landlines or 4G cell phones (lowest cost) to bundle packages which include a smartwatch, Help button and necklace button. This company quotes a 4.7 star google rating with 5,899 reviews posted.
- #3 ALOE CARE HEALTH 1-833-649-2016 has a limited time offer for a mobile companion for \$1. Available products includes a central Smart Hub, a mobile companion with fall detection (4G LTE, AT&T), wearable buttons, motion sensors, a family caregiver mobile app, and more or a voice-activated Smart Hub, automatic fall detection, air/temperature monitoring, and cellular connectivity. No contracts.

*note – a lockbox containing a house key is placed on the outside door knob and a pin code is provided to emergency 911 responders to enable them to get in.






