These supplies include food, water, medicine, batteries, etc. Each family and business is advised to be adequately stocked and prepared to face this hurricane season.



During the past three years, four hurricanes have made landfall in Florida, including Hurricane Michael, the first hurricane to make landfall in the U.S. as a Category 5 since Hurricane Andrew in 1992. Please note that for the month of July residents should contact GAO Vice-President Walt Fleitz to arrange use of the Clubhouse and side rooms.


# **SUMMERTIME POTLUCK DINNERS**

Make plans to attend and do stop by the clubhouse, signup and review what others intend to provide.





**Avoiding Coronavirus stimulus payment scams** 

Scammers are using these stimulus payments to try to rip people off. They might try to get you to pay a fee to get your stimulus payment. Or they might try to convince you to give them your Social Security number, bank account, or government benefits debit card account number.

- 4 tips for avoiding a Coronavirus stimulus payment scam
- 1. Only use irs.gov/coronavirus to submit information to the IRS and never in response to a call, text, or email.
- 2. The IRS won't contact you by phone, email, text message, or social media with information about your stimulus payment, or to ask you for your Social Security

number, bank account, or government benefits debit card account number. Anyone who does is a scammer phishing for your information.

3. You don't have to pay to get your stimulus money.

4. The IRS won't tell you to deposit your stimulus check then send them money back because they paid you more than they owed you. That's a fake check scam.

Report scams to the Federal Trade Commission at ftc.gov/complaint.

To keep up with the latest scams, sign up for the FTC's consumer alerts.

**Hang up on robocalls**. Scammers are using illegal robocalls to pitch everything from low-priced health insurance to work-at-home schemes.

Watch for emails claiming to be from the CDC or WHO. Use sites like coronavirus.gov and usa.gov/coronavirus to get the latest information. And don't click on links from sources you don't know.

## **How To Recognize Phishing**

Scammers use email or text messages to trick you into giving them your personal information. They may try to steal your passwords, account numbers, or Social Security numbers. If they get that information, they could gain access to your email, bank, or other accounts. Scammers launch thousands of phishing attacks like these every day — and they're often successful. The FBI's Internet Crime Complaint Center reported that people lost \$57 million to phishing schemes in one year.

Scammers often update their tactics, but there are some signs that will help you recognize a phishing email or text message.

Phishing emails and text messages may look like they're from a company you know or trust. They may look like they're from a bank, a credit card company, a social networking site, an online payment website or app, or an online store.

Phishing emails and text messages often tell a story to trick you into clicking on a link or opening an attachment. They may

- ... say they've noticed some suspicious activity or log-in attempts
- ... claim there's a problem with your account or your payment information
- ... say you must confirm some personal information
- ... include a fake invoice
- ... want you to click on a link to make a payment
- ... say you're eligible to register for a government refund
- ... offer a coupon for free stuff

# **How To Protect Yourself From Phishing Attacks**

Your email spam filters may keep many phishing emails out of your inbox. But scammers are always trying to outsmart spam filters, so it's a good idea to add extra layers of protection. Here are four steps you can take today to protect yourself from phishing attacks.
