since 1988. Right next to the property the developer is looking to build more than 1000 new homes. The fact that the developer wants into this rural area and slam high density against farms, just blows their minds. One of the concerns is the traffic that will have to cut through those residential neighborhoods to get to the new development. Other neighbors are worried about the environmental and flooding impacts on the wetlands there which will be degraded. SoHo stated that the project will contribute money to road improvement in the area. Neighbors are skeptical and want more answers, what we do not want to see is high density slammed against us, said one neighbor.

The area has been zoned for development for years, Pasco County still must approve the project.

Should Recreational Marijuana be Legal in Florida?


here is no shortage of opinions in Florida on the use of recreational marijuana. From ardent supporters of a measure to approve it, including deep-pocketed attorney John Morgan, to those who pump the brakes on any full-blown open use of it -mostly from law enforcement. Talk about the push for legislation in Florida, who is for it, who is against it and why some other industries statewide may be in no rush to back it. Meanwhile. A driving force behind legalizing medical marijuana in the state, says it is only a matter of time for recreational as well. "It is such

a no-brainer I can't believe it's a debate," said Morgan, who added he uses it medicinally with gummies. Morgan also said a recreational marijuana industry could benefit the state financially as well, adding jobs and taxes and a wealth of new opportunities, -- But not everyone is sold.-Obviously, law enforcement is not so gung-ho on the issue. Pinellas County Sheriff Bob Gualtieri, said marijuana enforcement is not a priority of his department, but he also said he is not in favor of full-blown legalization. I think the community attitude and sentiments toward marijuana continue to change. They have changed dramatically over the years; we need to be aware of what the community wants and believes.

Poultry Prices

he pandemic has led to shortages of many items. One of the latest is chicken wings.

David Rhoden, owner of Clearwater Egg and Poultry says there is an increased demand of chicken wings and prices have skyrocketed over the past year. "The demand of chicken is just unbelievable, and the fact that the plants are shorthanded, they just don't have enough workers to meet the demand. Prices are also high on meats other than chicken.

Rhoden sells meats to local restaurants. He says before the pandemic, chicken wings cost roughly \$1.00 per pound. In May of 2020 he was selling them for \$2.00 per pound, now they are \$3.70 per pound. "Every week, the price has gone up 10 to 15 cents a pound and it's making the restaurants struggle. Since the start of the year, many restaurant owners he works with have only been able to get about 75% of what they order.

David Berlo is one of Rhoden's customers who owns Varsity Club in Clearwater, there is a sign on the door telling customers his new wing prices and why he had to raise them.

Don't expect prices to drop anytime soon.






A bit of history.

NATIVE AMERICAN INDIAN CHIEFS GERONIMO;

Perhaps the most famous Native American leader of all time, Geronimo was a medicine man in the Bedonkohe band of the Chiricahua. Born in June 1829, he was quickly acclimated to the Apache way of life. As a Jung boy, he swallowed the heart of his first successful hunting kill and



In 1848, Mexico ceded control of vast swaths of land, including Apache territory, in the treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo. This preceded near-constant conflict between the new American settlers and the tribes which lived on the land. Eventually, Geronimo and his people were moved off their ancestor's land and placed in a reservation in a baron part of Arizona, something the great leader deeply resented. Over the course of the next ten years, he led several successful breakouts, hounded persistently by the U.S. Army. In addition, he became a celebrity for his daring escapes. He finally surrendered for the last time on September 4th, 1886, followed by several different imprisonments. Shortly before his death, Geronimo pleaded his case before President Theodore Roosevelt, failing to convince the American leader to allow his people to return home. He took his last breath in 1909, following an accident on his horse. On his deathbed, he was said to have stated; "I should never have surrendered; I should have fought until I was the last man alive."

SITTING BULL

A chief and holy man of the Hunkpapa Lakota, Sitting Bull was born in 1831, somewhere in present-day South Dakota. In his youth, he was an ardent warrior, going on his first raid at only 14. His first violent encounter with U.S. troops was in 1863. It was his bravery which led to him becoming the head of all the Lakota in 1868. Though small conflicts between the Lakota and the US would continue for a decade, it wasn't until 1874 that full-scale war began. The reason: Gold had been found in the sacred Black Hills of South Dakota.

The violence culminated in a Native American coalition facing off against US troops lead by Custer at the aforementioned Battle of Little Bighorn. Afterward, many more troops came pouring into the area, and chief after chief was forced to surrender, with Sitting Bull escaping to Canada. His people's starvation eventually let to an agreement with the US whereupon they were moved to a reservation. After fears were raised that Sitting Bull would join a religious movement known as the Ghost Dance, a ceremony which supported to rid the land of white people, his arrest was ordered. A gunfight between police and his supporters soon erupted, and Sitting Bull was shot in the head and killed.






