Recipe

Baked spaghetti

Ingredients

- Meatballs about 18 fully cooked
- 24 oz jar marinara sauce
- 1/2 yellow onion diced
- 3 cloves garlic crushed
- 1 tsp Italian seasoning
- 2 TBSP olive oil
- 3/4 # spaghetti noodles
- 1-2 cups grated cheese
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan

Instructions

1. In large cast iron skillet, sauté onions in olive oil over med/low heat. Add in garlic and continue sautéing until onions are tender.

- 2. Add cooked meatballs.
- 3. Add marinara sauce and tsp Italian seasoning.
- 4. Heat over med/low heat for about 20-30 minutes.
- 5. In separate large pot, cook spaghetti noodles according to package directions (under cook by 2 minutes).
- 6. With large slotted spoon, scoop meatballs from sauce and set aside.
- 7. Scoop cooked spaghetti (with large slotted spoon) into marinara sauce. Add in about
- 1/2 cup pasta cooking water. Gently stir until pasta is fully coated with sauce.
- 8. Add cooked meatballs to top of spaghetti.
- 9. Top with grated cheese & parmesan cheese.
- 10. Bake at 350* for approx 20-30 minutes or until hot and bubbly and cheese is melted.

If you don't give 100%, you will always assume your partner isn't giving 100% either.



The telephone technician sat up. "Excuse me, gentlemen, but I should tell you that the best praying I ever did was when I was hanging upside down from a telephone pole."


