Why We Skip Fertilizer in Summer

Jody Larson

From June 1 to September 30, regular fertilizer containing nitrogen and phosphate should not be applied to lawns and landscaping in Florida. The reason is all the rain we get! The fertilizer washes into the ponds and waterways, causing a green algae scum. The algae buildup can kill fish and other water creatures.

Pinellas County recommends using a nitrogen-free and phosphate-free mixture that still contains potassium and other micronutrients if needed, such as a “0-0-16” fertilizer. These micronutrients won’t lead to algae buildup. But most lawns that use Florida-friendly grasses, such as St. Augustine grass, don’t need even this.

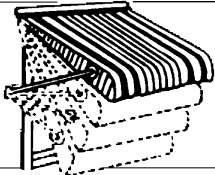

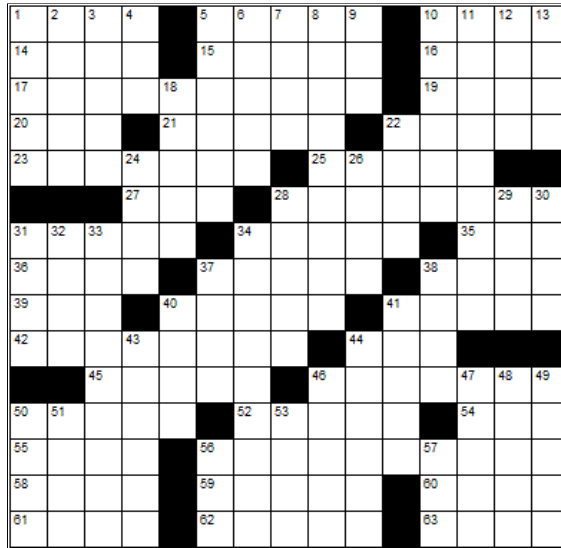

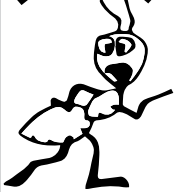
