Paradise Island Progress

ere are a few of the many projects on which the Co-Op Board and Committees have been working.

- 8 AC units are being replaced in the Clubhouse.
- As many of the surrounding neighbors adjacent to Pond 3 (Webster) are aware, when we have a heavy rain the drainage system has been inadequate to keep up and as a result water overflows onto Palm Island Street. There is a drainage pipe that is designed to move excess water from Pond 3 to Pond 2 (large one near the Clubhouse). After an inspection it was determined that the drainage pipe is partially blocked due to debris buildup over the years. We have contracted with a company to clean and video the pipes between Ponds 2 and 3.
- The non-potable irrigation system that is 35 years old is being replaced with a new system utilizing Variable Frequency Drive controllers and equipment.
- Matthews Lawn Care company cancelled their contract giving us a 30-day notice due to a lack of sufficient workers. The Board contracted for a 9-month trial period with Millennium Lawn and Landscape, Inc. to provide mowing, edging, trimming, and blowing. All turf areas will be mowed weekly from April 1st to September 30th and bi-weekly from October 1st to March 31st. Millennium's services also include the raking and removal of leaves around all resident homes during the appropriate season. The raking and removal of leaves will be a new service for us and will eliminate the need for residents to bag up their own leaves. If you have concerns, please email our Community Manager pimanager@paradiseislandlargo.com who will forward them to the Crew Leader.
- The Pavilion concrete slab and wood supports, where the BBQ grills are, is deteriorating and needs replacement. A new foundation and concrete wall will be installed to the existing slab height.

Canada and the US is still not open to non-essential travel but hopefully this will change soon.







## Letter(s) to the Editor

#### **Eastern Screech Owls**

By Pam Stover

This robin-sized nightbird is common over much of the east, including in city parks and shady suburbs, where many human residents are unaware they have an owl for a neighbor. The owl spends the day roosting in holes or in dense cover, becoming active at dusk. They are



wonderful birds to have in your yard. They eat rodents and roaches and provide natural pest control. They can be poisoned by eating rodents that have been exposed to toxins and that in turn, reduces the number of owls available to hunt and the rodent population increases. They are a small owl measuring between 6.3 and 9.3 inches. Rather than the typical hoo, hoo, hoo' sound that other owls make, the screech owl whinnies and trills. You might not be able to look for them at night, but you sure can listen for them. Here is a site with recordings of screech owls-AllAboutBirds.org

Courtship displays of males include bowing, raising wings, clicking bills. Males bring food to the female. Mated pairs preen each other's feathers, call in duet. Nest site is in a cavity in a tree, including natural hollows and abandoned woodpecker holes. They will also use artificial nest boxes, usually placed 10-30' above ground. Eastern Screech Owls lay three to four eggs in a clutch. The incubation period is 26 to 30 days. Because incubation usually begins with the first egg, the eggs develop at different rates and therefore hatch at different times. Nestlings leave the nest in the order they hatched. Screech Owls do not migrate; they maintain home ranges throughout the winter. In the wild Eastern Screech-Owls can live to about 14 years of age.


