As we proceed thru the 360 inspections, keep this hotter weather in mind. Schedule early morning or evening to do your cleanup chores.

As most of you know, we have had some issues at the Eldorado Pond in the last month.

While we do not yet have the formal test results, we still want you to use the pier. If you are fishing, you are requested to ask the people around the pond for permission to access their lots. We are working on the actual boundary lines for this. But, for now fishing is from the pier only. We want all residents to be able to use the pier and picnic area.

Parking at the Clubhouse is only permitted for guests and events--NOT your permanent parking spot unless a short time permit was issued by the office. All other vehicles can and may be towed at your expense.

We are just about completed in the East Bay Oaks library. A few finishing touches to go.

Residents will be able to enjoy the new layout. The books will be going back in soon for you to start using it.

If you need to adjust your auto payment with the office, please do before the 18th of the month. As they lock us out until the 7th of the following month.

Maintenance does not pick up your trash, you must take it to the compound or off site yourselves. Gates close at 3:30 PM Monday – Friday. Do NOT dump on the ground! This is a violation and the city will be notified. If you have bags of leaves, the valet people do not pick that up. You must take to the compound yourself.

As a last note, please be sure you are not putting out your trash days before the scheduled day. If you are going out of town, have someone take it to the road for you. Breakdown your boxes. Our maintenance staff no longer picks up trash, so you may want to call them during the week for access to the compound: (727) 638-4844

H.O.A. NEWS

Homeowners Association (HOA) action request for new residents:

Florida Statute 723 requires that the HOA keep an account for **every resident in the park**. This is Florida Law and, Eldorado Village Management Office gives us your name, once a year, as they are required to do.

However, when you move in <u>you are given a FORM to either give consent or not</u> to having your information included in the Eldorado Village Directory, Monthly Media and/or Facebook page.

<u>The ACTION requested:</u> **New** residents are NOT completing the FORM and returning it to the HOA or Eldorado office. If you still have that FORM among your papers, please complete, even if you do not give your consent to anything and return it to Dorisanne Gibson, HOA president, at Lot 187.

Thank you for your cooperation.

NEW Rules and Regulations (Village Rules - Effective 12.01.2020)

The HOA Board is being proactive and explaining or bringing to our attention the new rules that pertain to us all (owner or renter). The method right now is by highlighting some rules every month in the media.

SUBJECT: #5 - SALE AND/OR REMOVAL OF HOME (exerts from complete document)

Rule # 5.2 States that before a new owner for your home is approved for residency, management will inspect the home to be sure it complies with all rules and regulations and meet local code requirements. Assurances must be given that the required repairs/upgrades will be done or proof of completed repairs.

<u>Rule # 5.4</u> Further states that failure to maintain the home according to established standards shall be a violation of these Rules and Regulations.

Management has indicated that going forward this rule will be enforced.

The HOA Board is being proactive and explaining or bringing to our attention the new rules that pertain to us all (owner or renter). The method right now is by highlighting some rules every month in the media.

With NO street names, it is important that the Emergency services be able to locate any resident or tenant in need of attention. This means GREAT house numbering for them to see DAY or NIGHT. It is also in the rules and regulations:

6. SETUP: NEW or RESALES

6.5.10 – Residents MUST secure their street number and/or lot numbers on the front of the Home, placed consistently with surrounding homes as required for emergency services and in accordance with applicable county code requirements.


Formed in 1962, the FMO has a current membership of approximately 15,000 manufactured home owners. FMO operates with more than 1,000 volunteer officers from around the state who serve members by answering questions, assisting with problems, organizing district meetings and workshops, and linking them to the Board of Directors and the administrative staff at the Largo business office.

In 1962, the St. Petersburg City Council planned to enact an ordinance mandating that mobile home owners install tie-downs, a very expensive proposition then. Peggy Johnstone, upset by the impending mandate, contacted fellow mobile home owners and, on March 26th, 77 communities came together to defeat the ordinance. The FMO was founded that day with a clear vision in place:

Protect the interests of manufactured/mobile home owners in Florida. FUTURE MEMBERS



Neighborhood Watch Information

n Monday, July 12, 2021, the Neighborhood Watch Team met with Officer Vu Tran from the Largo Police Department, our partner with the Neighborhood Watch Team.





- 1. Put your awnings down if possible, but if you do not put them down or do not have any, or have side windows where there are no awnings, you might get window locks or stops to prevent the windows from being opened.
- 2. Deadbolt locks should go into the door frame 1", but the screws that hold the plate on the frame need to be 3" and most of them are not. The longer screws could be bought at the same time you purchase the deadbolt lock. (This would make it much harder for anyone to "punch" your deadbolt equipment to break the door open.)
- 3. Consider purchasing <u>solar lights</u> for use when the electricity is off INSIDE your home and on your porch or carport. Hopefully, this would discourage vagrancy when the power out and you may not be home.
- 4. Having cash on hand, especially during hurricane season, is always suggested. Small bills are best but, separate the cash. Don't keep it all in the same pocket, purse, and wallet, put it in several places.

Fraud: Additionally, Officer Tran spoke about the tremendous increase in fraud, especially



Leamon and, currently, Sandy Yost delivering our club donations to RCS. Individuals and families may access services once a month, receiving 3-4 days' worth of food for all household members per visit. A photo ID, SS card and a piece of mail with current address are needed. If you or someone you know need a ride to RCS, please contact Debbie and Steve Ennis or Sandy Yost.

RCS programs and services include:

CS Food Bank served 70,000 Pinellas County neighbors. 32,000 of these neighbors are senior citizens and children. Over 4 million lbs. of food are distributed annually with support for nearly 100 other local food banks and pantries.

RCS Grace House helps individuals and families facing homelessness return to self-sufficiency.

The Haven of RCS provides safety, security and support for women and children facing domestic abuse. Their outreach center serves nearly 17,000 women and children annually. Their safe house sheltered over 300 women and children last year and they provide a resource list for men needing assistance with domestic violence issues. Their hotline receives over 4,000 calls annually with requests for assistance in matters of domestic violence.

Goldsmith Gardens provides comfortable, safe, affordable housing and support for individuals and families. Their housing community serves 12 families and nearly 40 individuals annually. They provide wrap-around programs and services that are conducive to self-sufficiency including education, financial literacy, workforce development and life skill development.

Basic Needs are met through a variety of collaborations and partnerships.



RCS Express Center provides 'get it now' services to meet the needs of the community with direct support related to hunger, homelessness, domestic violence, and basic needs. Small meal ingredients and hygiene products are distributed, and guests are connected to partner agencies for various needs via immediate referrals.



Information About Water Shutoffs:

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado must be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble.



We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you are not sure if your name is on the parks robocall list, I would suggest that you check with the office to make sure they have added you to the list.

We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home which will prevent water from draining out of it and into the water system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE TO ASK ABOUT THE WATER SHUTOFFS! There is nothing they can do to help you.







- 1. All garbage must be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 lbs.
