

COVID PROTOCOLS RELAXED AS OF MAY 31, 2021

May be amended as necessary. Watch for announcements.

1. MASKS: No longer required.

Those who have not taken the vaccination are strongly urged to continue social distancing and wear a mask when indoors or at a large gathering.

2. HOURS OF OPERATION: 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. – All facilities accessible using key fob Hand sanitizer will be available in Park facilities.

- 3. GOLF CARTS ON GOLF COURSE: More than 1 person is permitted in the golf carts.
- **4. SIGN-IN SHEETS** will continue to be used at all amenity locations.
- 5. LIMITS ON FUNCTIONS: All events/functions involving more than 50 attendees must be approved by the Park Manager.

CORONAVIRUS RESTRICTIONS AT PALM HILL

- Be alert to Webmaster email alerts/updates
- Check Channel 732 (and below) for details of current restrictions.

ALL RESIDENTS, VISITING FAMILY MEMBERS AND GUESTS:

• SIGN-IN REQUIRED at all amenities/locations.

RULES FOR VISITING FAMILY MEMBERS AND GUESTS:

- MUST REGISTER with the office with photo i.d. (ex. driver's license or passport) before they can make use of any park amenity.
- GUEST BADGES: must have and display their guest badges when using any amenity (as permitted re. restrictions as noted in guidelines).
- SIGN-IN REQUIRED: Visitors and guests must continue to sign-in at the Pool areas, and to play Golf.

REMINDERS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS IN PALM HILL:

- 1. No yard sales, carport sales or driveway sales are permitted within Palm Hill. Please use bulletin boards posted in laundry rooms and/or web-site for items that are available for sale.
- 2. Obey posted swimming pool rules. Residents are responsible for the safety and behavior of their guests. Identification badges should be visible when entering one of the pool areas. Please report any concerns to the office with as much information as possible so that appropriate follow-up can be done. Children should be under the supervision of a responsible adult in the pool areas. Observe rules posted in each pool area.
- 3. While a driver's license is not required you must be 16 years of age to drive a golf cart in Palm Hill, per our current Rules and Regulations. Skateboards, scooters and any form of roller skates are not permitted in the park. Please observe the speed limit of 15 miles per hour on the streets in Palm Hill

HURRICANE SEASON TIPS AND HELP

URRICANE SEASON runs through November 30. It is time to plan what you will do if a hurricane is forecast to hit the Tampa Bay area. If an evacuation order is issued, Palm Hill is a mandatory evacuation zone as are all mobile home communities.

Should you choose to remain in the park and need medical or emergency assistance, the authorities will not respond as they will be dealing with other emergencies and you should have heeded the evacuation order. The nearest shelter is Largo High School at 410 Missouri Avenue North; this is a pet friendly shelter but will probably fill up quickly. The two Clubhouses here in Palm Hill are not rated as hurricane shelters and therefore cannot be used by residents as a shelter.

Due to liability issues both Clubhouses will be locked down when an evacuation order is issued. Please ensure that your gutters are cleaned out and any pots, chairs, planters or anything that may become airborne are stored either in the shed or inside the home.

Maintenance is responsible for ensuring that the common areas are secured, and, if time allows, we will pick up items that were not stored and remove them to the sanitation field.

The star means the publisher has not received any complaints about that company.

The circle with the number 29 means that's how long ASC has been in business.

The rest of the ad also includes the company's license number whether they are insured, and list their website and phone number along with other messages. Some include coupons.

If there are no squares, stars or circles, that means the advertiser is new to the LINK. A company has to advertise for a year to get that first square with a number.

The ads tell you a lot more than you see at first glance.
