

I often get asked how your sales office earns their commission.
Our sales office will help you come up with a selling price for your mobile home. From there they will take several high-definition pictures and place them along with a description of your home on our website. We inform interested parties waiting for homes with our office and people can



see your listing anywhere in the World. It's not uncommon for someone in Canada to buy a home site unseen by just visiting our website. When a person is interested in seeing a home, they must pass our residency application, which includes a background and credit check. After passing our residency application if someone finds their dream home and wants to make an offer our sales office will present it to you. Once you agree on a price, a deposit is taken, a legal contract is drawn up, and a closing date set. The buyer is allowed time to get any inspections which we often handle for you. When it comes to closing the sale, we work directly with the DMV to transfer the title and complete all the paperwork required by Teakwood Village. We also have the ability to work as your power of attorney to complete all paperwork if you aren't in the country or don't want the hassle. The new owner will be provided a copy of the prospectus and a copy of the directory.

If you decide to sell by owner or with an outside realtor, please keep in mind that all of these items must be done. If your title doesn't get transferred correctly or your potential buyer doesn't pass our residency application, we will not transfer your lease to the new owner. Before you transfer your title to the new buyer, please direct them to our sales office so that they can complete our residency application.

### TEAKWOOD MOBILE HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS

### ARTICLE VIII OFFICERS

SECTION 1. OFFICER POSITIONS. The officers of the Board of Directors and the Association shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board may from time to time by resolution create. All officers shall at all time, be members of the Board of Directors and no officers may be elected or appointed who are not members of the Board of Directors.



the Board of Directors and shall take place at the first meeting of the Board of Directors which shall immediately follow the adjournment of each annual meeting of the members.

SECTION 3. TERM. The officers shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors and each shall hold office for one year unless he or she shall sooner resign, or shall be removed or otherwise disqualified to serve. Officers serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.

SECTION 4. SPECIAL APPOINTMENTS. The Board may elect such other officers as the affairs of the Association may require, each of whom shall hold office for such period, have such authority, and perform such duties as the Board may, from time to time, determine. Such additionally elected officers shall be chosen from the Board of Directors and shall at all time be members of the Board of Directors.

SECTION 5. RESIGNATION AND REMVOAL. Any officer may be removed from office with or without cause by a majority vote of the Board. Any officers may resign at any time by giving written notice or at such later time specified therein, and unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

SECTION 6. VACANCIES. A vacancy in any office may be filled by appointment by a majority vote of the Board. The officer appointed to such vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the term of the officers he or she replaces.

SECTION 7. MULTIPLE OFFICES. The offices of President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer may not be held by the same person.

SECTION 8. DUTIES. Duties of the officers are as follows:

- A. PRESIDENT. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors; see that orders and resolutions of the Board are carried out; and shall have all of the powers and duties which are usually vested in the office of the president of the Association.
- B. VICE-PRESIDENT. The Vice-President shall act in the place and stead of the President in the event of his or her absence, inability or refusal to act, and shall exercise and discharge such other duties as may be required of him or her by the Board of Directors.
- C. SECRETARY. The Secretary shall record the votes and keep the minutes of all meetings and proceedings of the Board of Directors and of the members; serve notice of meetings of

the Board of Directors and of the members; keep appropriate current records showing the members of the Association together with their addresses; and shall perform such other duties as may be required by the Board of Directors.

- D. TREASURER. The Treasurer shall receive and deposit in appropriate bank accounts all monies of the Association and shall disburse such funds as directed by vote or resolution of the Board of Directors; shall sign all checks of the Association; keep proper books of account; if determined by vote or resolution of the Board, shall cause an annual audit of the Association books at the completion of each fiscal year; and shall prepare a statement of income and expenditures to be presented to the membership at its regular annual meeting.
- E. CUSTOMARY DUTIES. The officers, in addition to the duties specifically set forth herein, shall perform the duties of those offices customarily performed by officers of association.
- F. COMPENSATION. The officers shall serve without compensation.

### ARTICLE IX.

ACCOUNTING RECORDS, FISCAL MANAGEMENT; DUES AND ASSESSMENTS SECTION 1. BOOKS AND RECORDS. The Association shall keep correct and complete books and records of account including all receipts and expenditures. The books and records of the Association shall be open to inspection by members or their authorized representatives at reasonable times. Such authorization as a representative of a member must be in writing and signed by the person giving the authorization and dated within thirty (30) days of the date of the inspection. Written summaries of the account records may be made available to the members. Such records if made available shall include a record of all receipts and expenditures.

SECTION 2. FISCAL YEAR. In administering the finances of the Association, the following procedures shall govern:

- A. The fiscal year shall be the calendar year.
- B. Any monies received by the Association in any calendar year may be used by the Association to pay expenses incurred in the same calendar year;
- C. There shall be apportioned between calendar years on a pro rata basis any expenses which are prepaid in one calendar year for operating expenses which cover more than such calendar year;
- D. Items of operating expenses incurred in a calendar year shall be charged against income for the same calendar year regardless of when the bill for such expenses is received
- E. Legal expenses shall include, but not be limited to, such items as: attorney's fees and costs, litigation expenses, liability insurance premiums, expenses associated with statutory requirements, or actions involving disputes with the management of the Park.

SECTION 3. DEPOSITORY. The depository of the Association shall be such bank or banks as shall be designated from time to time by the Board of Directors in which the monies of the Association shall be deposited. Withdrawal of monies from such account shall be only by checks signed by such persons as are authorized by the Board.



### ARTICLE X FIDUCIARY RELATIONSHIP

The officers and directors of the Association shall have a fiduciary relationship to the members.

### ARTICLE XI INDEMNIFICATION

The Association may be empowered to indemnify any officer or director or any former officer or director, by a majority vote of a quorum of directors, or by majority vote of a quorum of members, who are not parties to such action, suit or proceeding, in the manner provided in the applicable Chapter of the Florida Statutes. If such indemnification is authorized by the directors of members, expenses incurred in defending such civil or criminal action, suit or proceeding may be paid by the Association in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding, in the manner described in the Florida Statutes upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of the director, officer, employee, or agent to repay such amounts unless he or she is found to be entitled to such indemnification. If he or she is not entitled to indemnification but has received the benefits of funds expended in his or her defense, then he or she shall be liable to the Association for repayment in full.

### **ACTICLE XII**

#### AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS

These By-laws may be amended by majority (50% + 1) of the Members of this Association in attendance at any duly noticed regular or special meeting. The notice of any meeting at which amendments of the By-laws are to be considered shall contain a statement that amendments to the By-laws shall be considered. No By-laws shall be revised or amended by reference to its title or number only. A copy of the amended By-laws shall be available for review on the bulletin boards in three clubhouses and/or at the Secretary's or another authorized board member's home.

### **ARTICLE XIII**

### AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The Articles of Incorporation of this Association may be amended by majority (50% + 1) of the members in attendance at any meeting. The notice of any meeting at which amendments of the Articles of Incorporation shall be considered.

### ARTICLE XIV

No loans shall be contracted for on behalf of the Association, and no evidences of indebtedness shall be issued in its name, unless authorized by a vote or resolution of the Board of Directors. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

### ARTICLE XV DEADLOCK

A. SUBMISSION TO ARBITRATION. Should deadlock, dispute, or controversy arise among the members or directors of the Association in regard to matters of management policy or matters arising under the provisions of the charter and should the members, by using their legal power and influence as members, be unable to resolve such deadlock, dispute or con-

troversy, the matter shall be submitted by the members to arbitration.

- B. DETERMINATION BY ARBITRATION. Should the members or directors be unable to agree as to the scope of this provision or the application of this provision to the deadlock, dispute or controversy at issue, the scope and applicability of this provision shall be determined by the arbitrator.
- C. NOTICE. Notice shall be given by such objecting or dissenting member(s) that such deadlock exists within fifteen (15) days of such deadlock, by certified mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the remaining member(s) at the addresses listed on the corporate books.
- D. SELECTION OF ARBITRATOR. The members shall then select an arbitrator within sixty (60) days of the receipt of such notice of deadlock, upon unanimous vote of the members entitled to vote. The members shall reserve the right to replace the arbitrator by unanimous vote of the members entitled to vote.
- E. INABILITY TO SELECT. Should the members be unable to select an arbitrator or a successor arbitrator, the deadlock dispute or controversy shall be resolved in accordance with eh Florida Arbitration Code, Chapter 682 of the Florida Statutes, as amended.
- F. FINAL DECISION. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon all members. The members shall vote as the arbitrator shall direct.
- G. ENFORCEMENT. To enforce these provisions, the arbitrator may obtain as injunction from a court having jurisdiction to direct the members to vote as the arbitrator has determined.







### PINELLAS COUNTY YELLOW DOT & VIAL OF LIFE PROGRAMS

ow the programs work:
Pinellas County's Yellow Dot and Vial of Life programs give you a voice when you are seriously injured or impaired and can't speak for yourself. Simply complete the medical information form and place one copy in your car's glove compartment and another copy in a plastic bag on your refrigerator. Then put the Yellow Dot sticker at the bottom on the left side of your car's rear window and the Vial of Life sticker on your home's front door to tell first responders that your health care information is inside.

The information you provide will help first responders:

- Identify who you are.
- Determine if you have a pre-existing medical condition that may inhibit you from communicating.
- Ensure that your current medications and pre-existing medical conditions are considered during decisions made about your treatment.





## FROM DEE'S KITCHEN TO YOURS

Recipes of the Month by Dee Potenti

#### **CHOCOLATE CHESS PIE**

1/2 (14.1 ounce) refrigerator pie (1 sheet.)

- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 (5-ounces)can evaporated milk
- 1/4 cup butter, melted and slightly cooled
- 3 tab unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 teas vanilla extract
- 1 cup whipped cream



Preheat oven to 375° unroll piecrust, and fit into a shallow 9 inch pie plate. In a medium bowl combine sugar and eggs, Beat at medium speed with electric until blended. Add milk, melted butter, cocoa and vanilla, beating until smooth. Pour into prepared piecrust.

Bake until a knife inserted near the edge comes out clean. 30 to 35 (Middle of pie will jiggle slightly)Let cool on a wire rack for one hour.(Pie will continue to set as it cools)



#### LEMON - MANGO SHRIMP & VEGETABLE PASTA

1/2 cup crumbled feta cheese, 1 tab fresh basil 8 Shrimp skewers 4 garlic cloves

1 mango 1/2 cup julienne cut sun dried tomatoes

2 lemons 1 teas salt

14 oz zucchini spirals 1/2 cup olive oil

- 1. Slice large, wide sizes of mango, slightly off center to avoid the pit cut, score mango flesh out of skins about 1 1/2 cups and set aside. Zest lemons (2 teaspoons) squeeze for juice(1/4 cup)
- 2. Add to blender (or food processor bowl) lemon juice and zest, 1/2 cup mango, basil, garlic and 1/2 tablespoon salt, process until smooth. Drizzle oil while in blender is running on low.
- 3. Arrange shrimp skewers in shallow dish, coat with 1/2 cup lemon basil dressing and let stand 15 minutes to marinade.
- 4. Place skewers cook 2-3 minutes on each side until opaque. Toss in serving dish, zucchini, sun dried tomatoes, feta and remaining lemon basil dressing about 1 cup, 1 mango, and 1/2 teaspoon salt top with shrimp. Serve and enjoy.

#### Herb Lemon Soap

Glycerin soap comes in small blocks that melt readily in the microwave.



**You will need:** 2 pounds glycerin soap. Several sprigs of fresh herbs like basil, mint, or rosemary. Essential oils of lemon and orange.

Melt your glycerin soap in a microwave in 30 - second intervals, stirring between shots of heat. While you are melting the glycerin, puree the herb sprigs and squeeze out any excess liquid by wrapping the puree in a paper towel. You will need to add one tablespoon of herb mixture for each cup of melted glycerin. Let the glycerin cool five minutes before adding the herbs. Add 10 drops of lemon essential oil and five drops of orange, stirring well. Pour this liquid into molds and let it set in the freezer for one hour.
