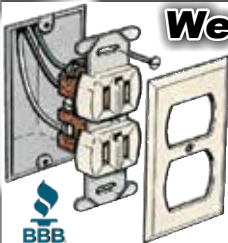

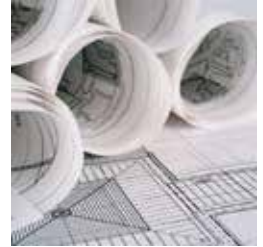

## UPDATES Around the Creek (Phase I & II).

### Bye bye beetles

Pat Rivera

Just like John, Paul, Ringo and George Beatles, the University of Florida air potato beetles five-year program has reached the end of its run.

Hopefully, BC will be propagating the beetles to keep eating the vines, laying eggs, dormant in winter, repeat. Repeat. You can check the underside of leaves for eggs/larvae



### *What's the life cycle of the beetles?*

*The life cycle begins in the egg stage, which lasts about 4 days. Larvae hatch from the eggs, feed on air potato leaves for about 10 days, and then drop to the ground where they pupate. Adults emerge about 2 weeks later, and begin feeding on air potato leaves. The adults can live for as long as 6 months, during which time females may lay as many as 4,000 eggs.*

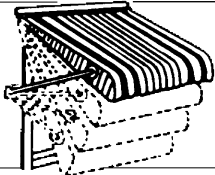

## What is that sound? (or noise) it's a loud song

*Recipes for taco cicada available on line...not kidding*

The cicadas are a superfamily, the Cicadoidea, of insects in the order Hemiptera (true bugs). Cicadas have prominent eyes set wide apart, short antennae, and membranous front wings. They have an exceptionally loud song, produced in most species by the rapid buckling and unbuckling of drumlike tymbals. They typically live-in trees, feeding on watery sap from xylem tissue, and laying their eggs in a slit in the bark. Most cicadas are cryptic. The vast majority of species are active during the day as adults, with some calling at dawn or dusk. Only a rare few species are known to be nocturnal. One exclusively North American genus, Magicicada (the periodical cicadas), which spend most of their lives as underground nymphs, emerge in predictable intervals of 13 or 17 years, depending on the species and the location. The unusual duration and synchronization of their emergence may reduce the number of cicadas lost to predation, both by making them a less reliably available prey (so that any predator that evolved to depend on cicadas for sustenance might starve waiting



for their emergence), and by emerging in such huge numbers that they will sate any remaining predators before losing enough of their number to threaten their survival as a species.

The annual cicadas are species that emerge every year. Though these cicadas' life cycles can vary from 1–9 or more years as underground larvae, their emergence above ground as adults is not synchronized, so some members of each species appear every year. *Wikipedia*

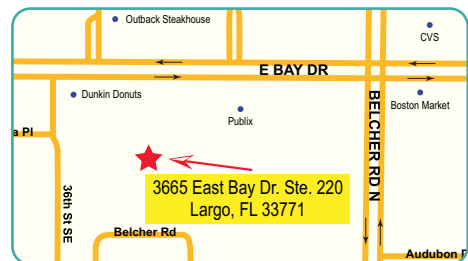

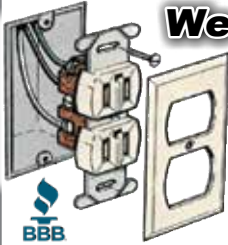

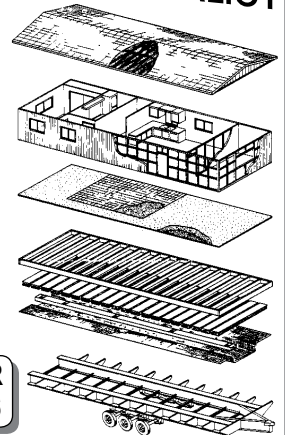

### **Update on phone dialing**

Yesterday (August 11), I received an email from Spectrum Mobile announcing the start of 10-digit dialing in selected area codes. People living in these area codes will be required to dial the area code plus the phone number for local calls. The list included some Florida area codes. **The area code 727 was NOT included in the list of area codes where this change will take effect at this time.**

However I have just spent an exhausting hour trying to find out from Spectrum about their future plans, that is, whether they plan to eventually require the use of 10 digit dialing everywhere, and the best answer I could get was “We don’t know, We haven’t been told anything.”

It seems probable that in time this will become a universal requirement as the population of Florida increases, and so I am planning to prepare for this change by adding the area code for all numbers listed in the Briar Creek Phase 2 Directory. 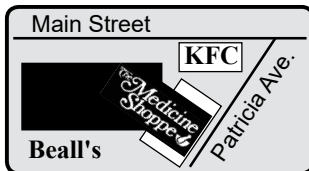

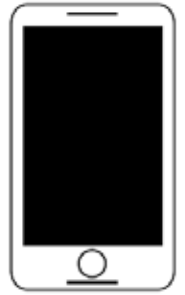

Over the past several months I’ve spotted an odd-looking white bird. At first I thought it must be a Snowy Egret because it was about that size—around 2 feet tall. As time went on, I noticed it was getting slate-blue feathers in patches on its body. Often it was in the company of a solid-colored Little Blue Heron.

A bit of internet browsing told me that the “calico” bird was an immature Little Blue. Their feathers are all-white at first, and as the bird goes through molting over about a year’s time, blue feathers come in. Last week I saw it with two others that were completely blue, and I assume they are its parents. But, maybe they’re just a couple older buddies out on the town—who knows?

Little Blues have two-toned bills with black at the point. In contrast, the Snowy Egret has a solid black bill and bright yellow feet, which looks like it’s “wearing gloves.”

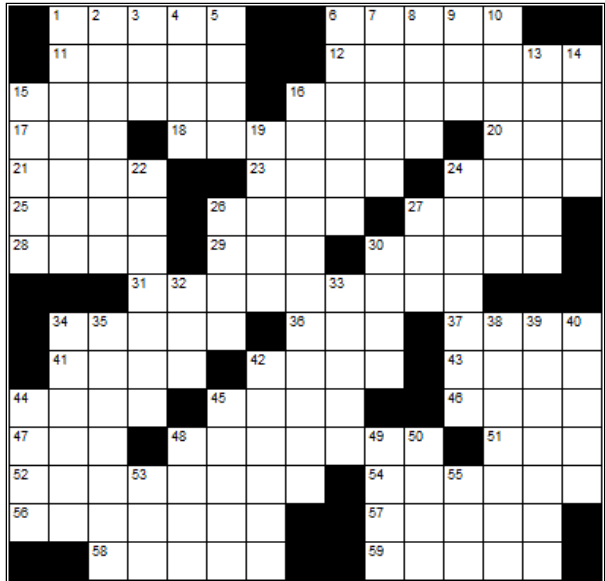
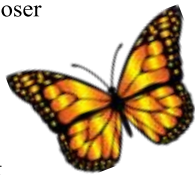

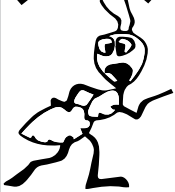
