estwind (including WW1 and WW 2), has a very VOLUM small group of ladies that will call you every morning just to say hello and make sure you are alright. This service has been going on for years and I am sure many of you never knew this. It is very reassuring to some of our seniors who live alone to know that someone will check on them each morning. There have been times when that phone call resulted in getting help to someone who had fallen during the night or had some other issue that they needed help to resolve. Well, the volunteer caller list has dwindled over the years and is in need of an extra couple of people who could take the call book for a little while. The ladies

pass the book around so that no one has the call responsibility for a long period of time. Currently, there are about six or eight people that request a call each day so it is not a lengthy call, unless you choose it to be. There are about five people who make the calls but some of them are snowbirds and some of them can't do it due to their own health issues so I am asking that anyone who would like to volunteer an hour or so each morning to make a few well-check calls...please contact Sylvia Harris in Lot #183. The more call volunteers we have, the fewer days each person has the book. Also this helps when one of the volunteers is away or is ill and can't make the calls. We have volunteers from both WW1 and WW2 and also the calls are made to anyone in either WW1 or WW2 who requests the service. Please give this some thought.

Not to be out done by Lee Miller, we now have an outdoor chandelier. I spied my chandelier in an upscale development in Strongsville, Ohio. It was a Wednesday morning trash day. I purposely ride my bike through several neighbors on Wednesday mornings looking for "treasures." (I have found MANY over the years. This summer, I found a solid cherry hope chest, a new designer pole lamp, a large and a small lantern that will become Halloween decorations. I'm on my bike so I have to hide them in the bushes and then drive back to collect them with the van. I asked permission from a resident to stash the hope chest by his garage. I put one end on a large piece of cardboard. While I was dragging it up the sidewalk, FOUR (4) people came in their vans/pick-up trucks to claim it. They had seen it earlier and went to find someone to help them lift it into their vehicle....but I digress.

I revamped the chandelier by removing the four 110 V light sockets and replacing them with outdoor 12V lights. I then got on eBay and ordered a brown string of 100 "warm" Christmas mini lights .I zip tied them to the chandelier.

The finished chandelier now hangs under the canopy of our deck gazebo. When all the lights come on, the fabric canopy glows. The hardest part of this job was running and hiding wires used to connect it to transformers and outlets.

factory key cylinder switch and installing a unique key instead.

- **3. HIDDEN KILL SWITCH.** A hidden kill switch can be used to disable your cart to prevent theft. When the kill switch is engaged, the cart won't start, even if they're trying to hot wire it. Additionally, there are many hidden locations on a cart that the switch can be installed.
- **4. LOCKING MECHANISM.** Adding a steering wheel lock or pedal lock can deter thieves simply because of the additional time and effort it would take to try to steal the cart. Plus, without being able to steer or accelerate, it would be very difficult to take the cart.
- **5. INSTALL A GPS**. Anti-theft mechanisms are not foolproof and carts can still be stolen despite your best preparation efforts. Consider installing a GPS on your cart so that if it is stolen, local law enforcement officials can quickly track your cart down.



Naturally alarmed, I looked around and there were two guys sitting in a car in the fire lane next to the store. They were obviously watching me intently, and there was no doubt they were somehow involved in this very weird situation. I quickly chucked the errand I was on, jumped in my car and sped away. I went straight to the police station, told them what had happened, and found out I was part of a new, and very successful, scheme being used to gain entry into cars. 

Together with two thousand other refugees, they embark on the SS Winnipeg, a ship chartered by the poet, Pablo Neruda, to Chile: "the long petal of sea and wine and snow." Starting over on a new continent, their trials are just beginning, and over the course of their lives, they will face trial after trial. But they will also find joy as they patiently await the day when they will be exiles no more. Through it all, their hope of returning to Spain keeps them going. Destined to witness the battle between freedom and repression as it plays out across the world, Roser and Victor will find that home might have been closer than they thought all along.





Coming Home, 1945

In 1939, there were 334,000 servicemen, not counting the Coast Guard.
In 1945, there were over 16 million, including the Coast Guard.
At the end of the war, over 8 million of these men and women were scattered overseas in Europe, the Pacific and Asia.

Shipping them out wasn't a particular problem but getting them home was a massive logistical headache.




