

BOURBON FRIED SHRIMP

1-2 pounds jumbo shrimp butterflied

1 stick butter

 $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ white onion - chopped

2-3 cloves garlic

1-2 T parsley flakes

3 tomatoes – diced

 $1-1\frac{1}{2}$ tsp salt

2tsp course black pepper

½ cup white wine

½ cup bourbon

1/4 - 1/2 C sour cream

Butterfly & devein shrimp. Sauté onion, garlic, pepper & salt in butter until onion turns clear. Add shrimp and ½ of the wine. Sauté 8-10 minutes until shrimp turns red. Turn heat to warm, add sour cream, and remaining wine. When sour cream becomes creamy, add tomatoes and ½ of the bourbon. Cover pan for 2-3 minutes until tomatoes are hot. Remove lid, add parsley. Add remaining bourbon and flame. Serve over rice.

DEVELOPER'S OPEN HOUSE

INFORMATION PASSED ON BY NEARBY NEIGHBORHOOD

e know that many Lincolnshire residents are concerned regarding the possible development of property across the street form the community bounded by Donegan Rd. and 8th Ave SE. (currently ranch property) The following is a summary of the first meeting regarding the possible development and its possible effect on nearby communities including Lincolnshire.

"Good Morning All,

There was a good showing of neighbors for the developer's Open House last night. I'm estimate about 75 people went through. Although city staff was present to answer questions, most of the interest was in seeing the proposed site plan and talking to the developer's traffic engineer about their "traffic study".

The biggest takeaway from this meeting was that the developer is desperate to SELL his plan, at any cost. He claims he owns the property, which is debatable. When pressed for answers about more than one entrance/exit, he said they would plan on having exit only access on the Donegan side of the property, which the city planner if it when asked, said that was the first she'd heard of it. The Traffic Engineer had a sorry looking bar graph of what COULD be if the existing zoning was left in place, compared to what it could be with their proposed zoning. There was nothing in reality provided! I would like to see the actual study that was done and who conducted it.

Bottom line is this is not a good fit for this area, and we need to keep expressing our concerns and backing it up with factual information. There was some helpful info from city staff and the fact sheets they provided. Let's use that information to keep this from moving forward.

I am attaching photos of the site plan, building and property renderings, the graph of the "traffic study", affordable housing fact sheet, and most importantly, dates for public hearings. It will be crucial that we have large neighborhood attendance and input at these meetings. Please mark the dates that you will be able to attend."

ID YOU KNOW? Rental parks without an active HOA, especially incorporated as LHOA, and a member of the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) our

lobbyist in Tallahassee, never see this sort of information. LHOA is voluntary, does not own, manage, make the rules and membership is not included when you buy your home or in our rent! Join. 2022 Membership drive starts on October 1s t.

All homeowners should have received the 90 day notice from the park owner concerning rent increase, compactor fee and the property tax pass-on charge due on November 1st 2021. The property tax pass-on is allowed by Florida statutes for rental mobile home parks like Lincolnshire. This has been in existence for several years. Each homeowner is responsible for 1/464th of the total difference in the property tax paid from the basis year of 2006 to 2020. Our park owner makes the charge to each homeowner once a year along with the rental increases. Talk to your park manager for more information. Other park owners may blend it into the rental increase or have 12 month installments. Property taxes are based on the value of the property (including the land) owned and is assessed by local or municipal governments plus any applicable real estate taxes. Resident owned parks also see increases and those charges are incorporated in increased monthly maintenance fees. The Board is consistently surprised by the number of new homeowners who have no knowledge of this pass-on tax until they receive the notice. Unlike when we purchased a home with the land all the taxes, fees etc. are disclosed at the "closing." Your Board of Directors ensures that this pass-on is calculated correctly each year by obtaining the tax record from Pinellas County of what amount was assessed and the tax paid.

Certainly disconcerting to a new owner finding out they are paying a pass-on tax from the previous year. The seller should make the new owner aware of this tax plus give the new owner the "Prospectus" which is the contract disclosing the responsibilities of both the park owner and homeowner. Don't have this or never received? Ask the previous coach owner or you can get one for the Florida Department of Professional Regulation in Tallahassee.

The Board will exercise the right by Florida statute to schedule a meeting with the park owner or his representative concerning the rental increase notice and other issues deemed important to affected Member homeowners. Non- members have no vote or voice. This meeting must occur before the rental increase takes effect.

If you are reading this and are not a Member please take the opportunity to join. Ensure your voice can be heard and also have a vote. The 2022 membership drive starts October 1st and ends on December 31st. The Association's strength is in its membership and let's maintain that.

VETERAN'S CORNER

he Defense Department on Wednesday resumed requiring all people – including those who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 – to wear masks indoors at military facilities in places where the disease is spreading quickly. Deputy Defense Secretary Kathleen Hicks said in a memo that, effective immediately, all service members, federal employees, on-site contractors and visitors must wear masks when indoors in areas of "substantial or high community transmission" of COVID-19, as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This applies to everybody, regardless of vaccination status, Hicks said. Those who are not fully vaccinated must keep physically distancing themselves from others, she said. According to CDC guidelines, areas with substantial transmission levels are where there have been 50 to 99.99 new cases per 100,000 persons in the last seven days, and high transmission levels are where there are 100 new cases per 100,000 or more in the previous week. The Defense Department in May began allowing fully vaccinated people to no longer wear masks, whether

indoors or outdoors. But the military's move today to tighten mask rules comes as concerns are growing about plateauing vaccination rates and the spread of a highly contagious Delta variant of COVID-19. On Tuesday, the CDC recommended even fully vaccinated people wear masks in public indoor settings in areas of substantial or high transmission. So, if you go to MacDill, you better bring your mask.



The Department of Veterans Affairs on Monday ordered the majority of its health-care workers to get vaccinated or risk losing their jobs. And the Washington Post and CNN reported that President Joe Biden is preparing to announce Thursday a requirement for all federal employees and contractors to get <u>vaccinated</u> or have to be tested regularly. Veterans Affairs officials urging all veterans and family members to get vaccinated against <u>coronavirus</u> as cases begin to surge again across the country. "[There is] a growing crisis with the increase in hospitalizations from COVID-19, specifically from the Delta variant. More than 97 percent of hospitalized patients with COVID are not vaccinated," Assistant Under Secretary for Health Carolyn Clancy warned lawmakers during a House Veterans' Affairs Committee on Wednesday. Mask will also once again be required in all indoor buildings.

Veterans Affairs Secretary Denis McDonough said that staff are seeing a surge of cases among patients and staff across the department, and the reluctance of some staff to get vaccinated is potentially jeopardizing the health of visitors and other employees.

"We're seeing staffing requirements increase as it is," McDonough told reporters during a press conference on Tuesday. "We're going to continue to see pressure on the system. And that's something that I can't sit and wait to develop for our veterans, especially as we get into the fall with what we expect to be greater COVID infections." Active cases of coronavirus across the VA health care system topped 3,300 on Thursday morning, their highest level since early May. That mark is up 121 percent in the last month alone. At least 12,650 VA patients and 145 employees have died from virus-related complications since March 2020. Nationwide, the virus is responsible for more than 607,000 deaths over that time frame.

ast 2 months we took a look at the basics of skin cancer and treatment. This month, a quick look at the longer range issues that skin cancer can cause. Florida is a true Sunshine State.

Why be so concerned about skin cancer. Our skin is our most protective outer organ, yes it is an organ. The skin's responsibility is defensive and holds us together. Our outer skin cells fall off and the layers underneath move out. Happens 24/7/365 non-stop. Dust mites around our beds wouldn't exist without this. Sorry, it's true.



As we age and have exposure to nature's elements like the sun and other chemicals, some of our skin cells begin to get confused or out of control. Why we get more dry skin, skin tags and those ugly barnacles. When those cells begin to alter their structure and reproduce rapidly then cancer is a primary cause. These cancerous cells can also travel to other areas of our bodies both in the skin and internally. Our body is a vast network of turnpikes, freeways and back roads.

So, our primary doctor doesn't like what they see and send us to a dermatologist. They will decide if a biopsy is needed or topical medications are wanted too. There are creams that are also chemotherapeutics that can destroy the abnormal skin cells. Usually these can be done by us twice a day or once using a "blue light" to activate them. Our skin gets a bit irritated by these chemo creams so know it may itch etc. Creams are only used if the abnormal skin cells are on the surface. There are also creams that simply dry up the skin cells within a week.

When the Dermatologist recommends a biopsy of the area or definitely is concerned they will recommend a biopsy, either small or include an area well outside the lesion. If the biopsy finds cancerous cells the repeat surgery will be much wider attempting to remove all cancer cells. Often those cancer cells will migrate. Cancer cells don't ask permission to travel!

Simply be prepared to have a larger area removed then you can see!

Cancer cells can migrate and hitch a ride almost anywhere in the body. Chemotherapy and radiation may be required if there are multiple internal and external areas affected. "Staging" of the cancer is simply where it is and the effect on our body. Also determines treatment.

My simple message is this: exam your skin with help from a partner, spouse or friend. Examine front and back. A spot is irritating and not going away, see your primary physician. Don't have a primary physician, get one today. I did say "today." Most skin cancer or lesions if treated early don't diminish our lives.


