NEW PROCEDURES ON SELLING YOUR HOME

- 1. If you are selling your home, you must contact the office and make them aware of it.
- 2. When signing up with a Realtor other than Island in the Sun, please inform them that they must contact the office to receive a Realtor Selling Packet.

Island in the Sun already has a supply of these packets.

- This packet contains all the forms they will need to sell your house in our community. If the Office does not receive a completed Realtor Requirements and Check List Packet from your Realtor at the time of sale, this could delay the closing sale of your home.
- 3. If you are selling your house on your own, you must likewise obtain a Selling Packet and follow the procedures therein.
- 4. All buyers must attend an in-person, zoom, or conference call Orientation before the closing.

These procedures are following the Rules and Regulations spelled out in your Prospectus, By-Laws, Rules & Regulations, and Board Resolutions.

Renting your Home – from the Co-Op Board of Directors NEW PROCEDURES ON RENTING YOUR HOME

1. If you are going to Rent your home long-term or for the required minimum of 90 days, you must contact the office and make them aware of it.







Handsome and hardy, Texas sage is an outstanding South Florida landscape choice with its silvery foliage, purple flowers and drought-tolerant nature. The lavender to purple blossoms appear on and off all year amidst small, soft, silver or gray-green leaves. Though not a true sage, this shrub is easy to care for and doesn't like to be fussed over. In fact, this is one plant where too much care - water, fertilizer, trimming - can actually be detrimental to its health. A native of Texas and the arid southwest, Texas sage is called the Barometer Plant there, because as soon as the humidity begins to rise after very dry weather, this shrub bursts into bloom. This is an excellent plant for those areas so dusty and dry nothing wants to grow there. The silver foliage - not to mention the pretty flowers - makes it stand out in a landscape of green-green-green.

VETERAN'S CORNER

he Defense Department on Wednesday resumed requiring all people — including those who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19—to wear masks indoors at military facilities in places where the disease



is spreading quickly. Deputy Defense Secretary Kathleen Hicks said in a memo that, effective immediately, all service members, federal employees, on-site contractors and visitors must wear masks when indoors in areas of "substantial or high community transmission" of COVID-19, as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This applies to everybody, regardless of vaccination status, Hicks said. Those who are not fully vaccinated must keep physically distancing themselves from others, she said. According to CDC guidelines, areas with substantial transmission levels are where there have been 50 to 99.99 new cases per 100,000 persons in the last seven days, and high transmission levels are where there are 100 new cases per 100,000 or more in the previous week. The **Defense Department in May** began allowing fully vaccinated people to no longer wear masks, whether indoors or outdoors. But the military's move today to tighten mask rules comes as concerns are growing about plateauing vaccination rates and the spread of a highly contagious Delta variant of COVID-19. On Tuesday, the CDC recommended even fully vaccinated people wear masks in public indoor settings in areas of substantial or high transmission. So if you go to Madill you better bring your mask.

The Department of Veterans Affairs on Monday ordered the majority of its health-care workers to get vaccinated or risk losing their jobs. And the Washington Post and CNN reported that President Joe Biden is preparing to announce Thursday a requirement for all federal employees and contractors to get vaccinated or have to be tested regularly. Veterans Affairs officials urging all veterans and family members to get vaccinated against coronavirus as cases begin to surge again across the country. "[There is] a growing crisis with the increase in hospitalizations from COVID-19, specifically from the Delta variant. More than 97 percent of hospitalized patients with COVID are not vaccinated," Assistant Under Secretary for Health Carolyn Clancy warned lawmakers during a House Veterans' Affairs Committee on Wednesday. Mask will also once again be required in all indoor buildings.

Veterans Affairs Secretary Denis McDonough said that staff are seeing a surge of cases among patients and staff across the department, and the reluctance of some staff to get vaccinated is potentially jeopardizing the health of visitors and other employees.

"We're seeing staffing requirements increase as it is," McDonough told reporters during a press conference on Tuesday. "We're going to continue to see pressure on the system. And that's something that I can't sit and wait to develop for our veterans, especially as we get into the fall with what we expect to be greater COVID infections." Active cases of coronavirus across the VA health care system topped 3,300 on Thursday morning, their highest level since early May. That mark is up 121 percent in the last month alone. At least 12,650 VA patients and 145 employees have died from virus-related complications since March 2020. Nationwide, the virus is responsible for more than 607,000 deaths over that time frame.


