

COMMUNICATIONS AT PALM HILL

SAVING WATER USAGE IN PALM HILL

he Planning committee is kicking off the water saving program with a distribution of dye tablets attached with the August Link.

With the water and sewer bills cost \$12 per every 1000 gals of water. It is an excellent place to reduce out expenses where we can. Any place we can conserve water we can reduce our expenses. When a toilet or faucet etc. is changed, there are options where some devices use less water, please choose wisely.

The description of how to use the dye tablets are attached to the bag.

Palm Hill BOD has agreed to pay for a plumber to repair the toilets that are wasting water. The cost to repair one toilet is about \$150 and in 4 months we will save \$150 in water and sewer expenses for the one toilet. Since that toilet should not leak for the next 5 years, we will save an additional \$150 every 4 months for 5 years for a total of \$2100.

If your toilet shows to be leaking water, go by the office and fill out a consent form with your contact info so a plumber can be scheduled to make the repair.

When we get 10 or more toilets that are leaking, we will schedule the plumber for a day to make the repairs. The office will call the residents to confirm that they will be available on the day the plumber is scheduled to make the repairs.

When the plumber comes to make the repair, he will retest the toilet and if it needs repair, he will repair it. He is instructed not to spend time and money repairing toilets that are not leaking.

If for some reason you can't test your toilet, we have some volunteers that can come by and perform the test for you. Just call the office and ask to put your name on the list to test your toilet.


he HOAst Online software has rolled out and we have done the first practice vote to let everyone experience what a board election looks like. If you had looked at it there was a PDF file that included the resumes of the past presidents.

The results of the election were:
1st place was Abe Lincoln with 142
2nd place was George Washington with 67
3rd place was Thomas Jefferson with 34
There were 248 total ballots cast to include 5 blank ballots

Once you have logged in, (https://palmhill-cc.myhoast.com) it is good to bookmark the site, since you can't search for the site. We have also added it to the Palm Hill website for your convenience.

Why are we doing online voting?

It saves Palm Hill money, every time we must do a mass mailing, we must buy paper, print, fold, stuff in stamped envelopes all the paper notices. With the ability to vote electronically we also can go paperless for the notices.

It also saves time. The post office is getting less reliable in a timely manner. When a mailing goes out, it would take a week or more to receive it. Electronically would be received the same day. This last year we were forced to use overnight express, and we delayed the voters meeting to try to collect as many paper ballot as we could.

With online voting you could cast your vote before the ballot gets to the post office to be mailed out.

More info pertaining to online voting.

Some don't want to vote online; they would rather cast a paper ballot. This is fine but to get timely notices, sign in and opt into online voting and paperless communication. When it comes time for a Board election, the office can issue you a paper ballot. When the voting is closed the HOAst software can print a list of all the addresses that has cast an electronic vote. The committee counting the ballots will compare the unopened envelopes that has the address on them, to the HOAst address list. If the address has not voted electronically the paper ballot is allowed to be counted manually.

If you are a snowbird, it is necessary to advise the office of your coming and going, that is if you want mail delivered to where you are residing. If you opt in for online voting, it also lets you opt in to email communication, then all you must do is make sure your email address is up to date to get your correspondence.

This software is new to all of us, and we are learning all the ins and outs of it. Bear with us and we get the bugs out of it. Most of the problems is getting the office database info up to date so all can get logged in. We started at a good time of the year to give us time to make it work before we have an election.

Thanks also to all the positive and the negative feedback, the negative is valuable as to what problems exist and what we can do to make it work.

Email Hackers

ver the past few weeks, many Palm Hill residents have had their email address books hacked. It is difficult to believe that this is a coincidence.



They all follow the same script. The email starts off with a "how are you" and moves on to "Could you do me a favor". DO NOT OPEN IT. Delete it right away. If you do open it, it may ask you to purchase a gift card. If you get that far, you may be doomed. Don't get curious about the favor. Even if you think it is legitimate, just delete it.

Our website email list, available for email blasts of information of interest, numbers close to 1,200 now. We have been in touch with our vendor and have been assured that (1) there has not been a recent breach, and (2) we are well protected. So, rest assured that the hackers have not gained access to our website file.

Be aware. Be cautious. And if in doubt, hit DELETE.
