ho can tell me where exactly the Summer went? There have not been too many things going on over the Summer. The new doors were installed on the front of the Clubhouse, the pool had an acid wash, the outside restrooms received a much needed facelift, two of the shuffleboard courts have been re-leveled and we have been able to get back to a little closer to our normal lives. Now, all we need are our snowbirds!



I finally got to take some much needed vacation as well, for the first time in almost four years! All those days have just been building up, waiting!! Tracey has settled back into her Admin position in the office and Jim keeps on doing his thing! The park looks great and the mowers are doing a fantastic job at keeping our grounds neat and tidy! Has anyone else noticed they are doing the job better, in half the time and with half of the staff?? And, they actually come back if they get rained out to do their job!

Some of this sounds like a broken record, I know, yet we still have people who are not following our rules. I have had some who ask, "why do you tell us the rules"? The answer is, some can't follow them and try to push back. These rules are not mine. I do not make them, I am however, tasked to enforce them by direction of the Directors. I do not have cars towed. We have had a contract with a tow company for well over ten (10) years who randomly patrols the park. If they see a car on the streets after hours, they will tow. If they see a vehicle in the parking lot with no visible parking pass, they will tow, at the owner's expense. That is their job. It has also been brought to the attention of the office that "I" evict people from the park. To be clear, the Board of Directors make the decision as to whether eviction action is to be initiated, not the management company or the office. I will also add that there have been no evictions in the almost four years that I have been the Association Manager. While the speeding has slowed down, we still have speeding and violation letters continue to go out about that. We still have unit owners moving people without going through our application process. Just do the right thing, please. We always find out and then you are upset with the office because you have violated the rules.



drafted it and they make all of the final decisions for admittance or denial, not the office. We always find out, eventually, that you have smuggled an animal in, so again, just do the right thing.

Please stop going to Eddie's home after hours for park related business. We have also had a few go to Jim's house as well. If you have an emergency, call the after-hours line. If not, please come to the office during business hours.

If you have filled out a request to plant things outside of your planter box, **you** must call 811 for locator services. They will collect information from you, including your address, email address and phone number. As each utility clears their own service, they will notify you of such. Then, you will need to provide that information to the office before se pay we can approve your request. This is not the responsibility of the office. It is also not necessary to be rude to the office Admin in regards to this process. Please refrain from such, she is there to help you.

If you are up at the pool, please enjoy it! Also, please watch your language. We have senior adults and young children visiting, who don't care to hear foul language. There is to be no smoking in the pool and no drinking in the pool, alcohol or not. Please pay attention to the posted pool rules and please do not get in the pool fully clothed.



We are still having issues in the office with people not checking in and out as they come and go from the park. This is important for multiple reasons. One is, we are in hurricane season. Should we have a storm and are impacted with damage, we need to account for you! We would have no idea if you were hurt or missing if you are not checking in and out. The second is for park mailings. These are mailings that we must certify via the post office. If we do not have your current address, you will not receive whatever we are mailing. We are required to mail to the "address of record". So, if you want to make sure you are getting your mailings, please make sure you are following our check in and check out procedures.

If you have a complaint, please remember that there are complaint forms available at the office. We must have things documented, so we will need the required form filled out and signed.

If you want to rent your unit out, please let me know that you are interested in renting your unit. I take several calls each week from people wanting to rent. I will then put you together with the potential renter and you can then work out your terms with them. I, nor does the Association charge a fee for this. It's just something that I am happy to do for you. Our rules do not allow your unit to be rented/listed on VRBO or any other such site. All renters have to go through our application process. We recently had a VRBO rental who "just showed up". These sites do not do any checks on the people trying to rent. We want to know who is coming into our community for safety reasons. We also want our owners, whether they are HOA or ROC, to be protected as well.

## **IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!**

#### he hurricane season is from June 1-November 30. **Be prepared**:

- Listen for weather updates radio (WEOC AM940) and TV.
- Build your survival kit.
- Get cash and fuel your car.
- Protect the windows and secure your awnings and outdoor objects.
- Purchase bottled water, freeze containers of water, have coolers handy.
- Refill prescriptions.
- Make an itemized list of personal property and take photos.


Hurricane Warning means that a hurricane is expected within 24 hours. If there is a MANDATORY EVACUATION, all residents must leave when notified. Announcements will be made over the radio and TV. Decide in advance where you would go (to a friend, relative, or hotel). Leave early. If you need assistance in evacuation, you should register in advance with the Largo Fire Department (form is available at the FSE office).

If you must evacuate:

- Take your survival kit, important papers including identification with local address, jewelry and any other items of value.
- Let friends or relatives know where you will be going.
- Turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Check your neighbors and make sure they have a ride.
- Lock all windows and doors when leaving.
- Drive carefully to nearest assigned shelter or local hotel or friend/relative.

Once evacuation is lifted and you can return home, beware of fallen branches, flooding and hanging electrical wires. Before entering your home:

- Check for damage from the outside.
- Turn water, gas and electricity back on.
- If area has been without power for an extended period, the perishables in your refrigerator continued on page 17 may have to be discarded.

#### **BET YOU DIDN'T KNOW!**

D id you know the saying "God willing and the Creek don't rise" was in reference to the Creek Indians and not a body of water? It was written by Benjamin Hawkins in the late 18th century. He was a politician and Indian diplomat. While in the south, Hawkins was requested by the President of the U.S. to return to Washington. **BOOK OF THE MONTH CLUB** Lorraine Mann, #119

The name of the book I recently read is The Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society by Mary Ann Shaffer. It is set on Guernsey Island off the coast of Normandy in 1946 and is considered historical fiction. It tells the story of the island's residents and how they outwitted the Germans who had invaded their island homes.

It might be difficult to get past the first pages because it is written in the form of letters, but as the story progresses you'll get hooked! My sister first told me about this book. After I read it I recommended it to someone else in the park who especially enjoyed the story because he had been to Guernsey. My daughter recently texted me that she is now hooked also.

This book is a favorite selection of many book clubs. It was made into a movie in 2018. It is a remarkable story of the resilience of people in German occupied countries during World War II.

### Who knew 🙆 The Benefits Of Peroxide

y friend who is married to a doctor was over recently for coffee and smelled the bleach, I was using to clean my toilet and counter tops. This is what she told me.

- 1. Take one capful of hydrogen peroxide (the little white cap that comes with the bottle) and hold in your mouth for 10 minutes daily, then spit it out. (I do it when I bathe.) No more canker sores, and your teeth will be whiter without expensive pastes. Use it instead of mouthwash.
- 2. Let your toothbrushes soak in a cup of peroxide to keep them free of germs.
- 3. Clean your counters and table tops with peroxide to kill germs and leave a fresh smell. Simply put a little on your dishrag when you wipe, or spray it on the counters.

- 14. Another place it's great is in the bathroom, if someone has been careless, has peed on the floor around the toilet, and it's begun to smell of urine. Just put some peroxide in a spray bottle spray. In the blink of an eye all the smell will be gone and the bacteria eliminated!






