

PINELLAS COUNTY COVID-19 VACCINATION INFORMATION

As of July 27, 2021 some 512 thousand of the 806 thousand adult Pinellas County residents were fully vaccinated or had received at least one of the two dose Pfizer and Moderna vaccines.

Where to get the vaccine:

Sign up for a free vaccine with a participating pharmacy or other community site

(see list of distribution sites below). The vaccine is completely free of charge for everyone.

Important Řeminder: Stay safe until your vaccine reaches full effectiveness:

- Pfizer and Moderna vaccines take up to 2 weeks after the 2nd dose for full effectiveness; 1-dose Johnson & Johnson can take up to 28 days.
- All three vaccines are highly effective at preventing life-threatening illness, but they do not offer 100% protection from catching or spreading COVID-19; no vaccine gives 100% protection.
- While the virus continues to spread, mask-wearing and social distancing are still important safety protocols.

Pfizer approved for age 12 and up

- Minors as young as 12 are now eligible for the two-dose Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine per the FDA.
- A signed <u>Vaccine Consent Form</u> is required before the vaccine is given.






