Subject: Monthly Activity Report: July 2021

ear Fellow Residents: This report is a bit long due to the notes from the Town Hall and Board of Directors meetings held in July.

Hurricane Season: The Atlantic Hurricane Season is in full "swing" and NOAA has issued the following prediction:

"The latest outlook reflects that the number of expected named storms (winds of 39 mph or greater) is 15-21, including 7-10 hurricanes (winds of 74 mph or greater), of which 3-5 could become major hurricanes (Category 3, 4, or 5 with winds 111 mph or greater). This updated outlook includes the 5 named storms that have formed so far, with Hurricane Elsa becoming the earliest 5th named storm on record."

Please make sure you are prepared in the unfortunate instance that a hurricane decides to pay Largo a visit.

Town Hall 12 July 2021: A town hall meeting was held in the recreation hall and via Zoom on July 12.

- There was some discussion on the ADA bathroom. The board needs to discuss and resolve open questions before bringing a recommendation to the residents.
- There were lots of discussion regarding insurance. It seems that some residents do not understand what liabilities are covered by the Park's corporate insurance and what liabilities are not covered. A separate note was subsequently sent to the residents to help explain the impacts of holding private parties. This note and a follow-up answer to insurance is included in this report.
- Midges near the lake side property are becoming worse this year. Apparently, the county did some spraying to quell some of the problem, but this will most likely be an ongoing issue.
- One resident pointed out that there have been times when visitors have used various residents' homes for short stays. He also pointed out that people from outside the park are roaming the streets in the park.

Board of Directors Meeting 19 July 2021: A Board of Directors meeting was held on 19 July in the recreation hall and via Zoom. The minutes of this meeting will be sent out as a separate email blast and can be found on the parks web page and in the hall.

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Pool: The pool remains in great shape!

- The base of one of our filters cracked and leaked onto the floor and the 10 hp pump. The pump still operates but the lower housing needed replacement. The replacement part came in and was successfully installed. A replacement for the lower housing was also ordered, received, and installed.
- There is a minor leak on a lower valve on one filter. A gasket replacement is required. This will be repaired within a month. The pool mechanicals are up to par and working well.
- The new commercial pool vacuum has been received and works quite well. This should prevent the filters from being overtaxed with dirt and eliminate excess water usage in the pool.
- The pool was treated with algaecide. The treatment went well.
- The pool is using less chlorine since Ed Schuster changed to liquid chlorine. This should lower the cost of chemicals in the future.

Maintenance:

- The holes in the hall roof caused by birds are not covered under warranty. The board is looking into the best solution for repair. Options include new roof of same kind, repair, new roof of new material.
- Cleaning and waxing of the hall floor are being scheduled in the next month or two.
- There was a lightning storm the on the evening of the 12th. Lightning destroyed a transformer and disconnected pool pumps and well pumps. The pumps were reset and are working fine. The transformer was replaced by the electric company.

Water Usage: Water usage is down this past month, but the water and sewer bills remain high due to rate increased from the county. The board expects the rate increases to continue next year and will result in about a 10% increase in rates from 2019 rates.

Compliance and Home Changes: The board is working with one homeowner to resolve weed growth and unsightly bushes.

Legal Issues: There has been no movement on the Wyatt property. The board voted to work with our attorney to file a lean on the property to protect the park's interest.

Office: No news to report.

Web Site: Remember to check our web site at www.lakeseminoleresort.org for news regarding the Park.

New Residents: No new residents.

Financial Status: The July 2021 financial data is included in this letter as an attachment.

- The financial information for July does not include a water invoice from the county. Invoicing from the county occurs every two months.
- Electricity bills are above projections due to rate increases. Usage is near historically normal amounts.

Resident Proposals: The board is examining two resident proposals: one for the addition of an ADA bathroom in the hall that exits to the pool/spa area, and another for a front security gate.

- ADA Bathroom Proposal: The board in looking into the requirements (building code, county licensing, inspection) required to install an ADA bathroom as proposed. To date, the board has determined that the county requires completed plans, approved by a licensed architect (or equivalent) to issue permits. All work must be completed by licensed contractors. The best approach to complete this proposed project is still under investigation. Once the board has completed its review and recommendations, the proposal, along with a justification, will be presented to the residents for discussion and approval.
- Front Gate Proposal: The board is examining the viability for a front gate to the park. This was the subject of an investigation in the past and was rejected by the county and the fire department. Since this first investigation, the board believes that the fire department objection has been resolved.
- Liability Insurance Discussions: There have been several discussions regarding liability and insurance for private parties. The essence of the discussions revolves around the personal liability residents have when reserving Lasereno facilities for private events. At present, if a resident reserves a Park facility for their use, that resident may be responsible for damages or injuries caused because of holding the event. This is the response from our insurance broker and our carrier. The board continues to be in discussion with our insurance agent and hopes to have clarification regarding our corporate policy that incudes the coverage of private parties if the person holding the event is a resident and all attendees are residents. A separate email blast will be provided to all residents regarding insurance. More information will be made available on the park web page and in the hall.






