KNOWING YOUR NEIGHBORS

SPRING HAS ARRIVED

t last spring has arrived. It arrived a little earlier than the calendar says it should but who cares? We started getting some warm days mid-August. Chilly at night but temperatures in the low 20c in the day



Our seasons change on the first of the month (1st September is Spring), unlike the northern hemisphere which changes on the solstice. Why? Not sure.

Where we are we have lots of eucalyptus trees which as you may know are evergreen, so we are not treated to fall colors and spring growth as much. They do however, flower, some nondescript, others with white flowers, even others with yellow, red or orange. To the back of our property is a green belt of trees, these burnt in the bushfires of 2019/2020, but now are green and lush again. We are all praying that there will be no fires this coming summer. We look at the fires in the Northern hemisphere and our heart goes out to those affected. Bottle brush, is an Australian native (we see them in Doral Village) are beginning to flower, as are grevillias. The beautiful yellow wattle trees flowered at the end of July and through August. I have sweet peas, poppies, daffodils, bluebells, and jonquils all in flower, plus lots of others.

Ray and I have virtually stayed put, mostly due to the continued lockdowns in Sydney and the state borders being closed. Then the virus started to spread to regional centers, so they got locked down as well. This extended to all our state NSW. Sydney lockdown has been extended until at least October, still people ignore the rules and keep spreading the virus. Hopefully by the time you read this we will all be "free".

We live close to the main interstate highway, there's hardly any traffic on it during lockdown. Can you imagine US19 with barely any traffic?

A story that will probably shock a lot of people is that in Melbourne in mid-August a family ignored the "no more than 5 people in your home rule". They held an engagement party and had 69 guests, no masks. Someone took a video and send to authorities. Result EVERY person was fined \$A5,500. Total \$A350,000.

I am so sick of Covid and hearing about it in the media daily. Probably everyone the world over feels the same. The other knock-on effect is that there are very few flights to go anywhere. We can do some road trips which, now the weather is warmer and lockdown over, we will. As I said previously one of the things Ray particularly misses the Florida bars. Our bars are totally different. The legal drinking age here is 18. Bars...we call them pubs are almost like little casinos. In cities they are generally relatively big places, people usually sit at tables, not around the bar. Every pub has poker (slot machines), these days in a separate area as you can't smoke indoors.

They don't have the charm of UK pubs or the unique character of Florida bars. We do have lots of clubs, not as in a book club but again like casinos. These can be a lawn bowling club (a very popular activity here), a football club, golf club, RSL (returned services club). These clubs can be enormous, always with bars, restaurants, auditoriums, and poker machines. The machines are not the only form of gambling allowed in clubs ...there's keno, online betting on sports events as well. However, you can't play blackjack, poker etc., that's reserved for the few casinos we have. The poker machines, as with everywhere, the payouts are far less than the money put in. The clubs usually use this money to fund local charities and events. The pubs? Well, I guess goes into the licensees' pockets.

Another unique thing is the meat raffles. Most pubs and clubs have raffles, usually for a tray of meat, but sometimes seafood or fruit and vegetables. At Christmas it's legs of hams. In the late afternoon tickets go on sale, cheap. Then around 6 pm they draw the raffle, usually about 20 prizes.

To go to a club, you need to be a member (about \$5-10) a year or live over 5 km away. Such an odd law. These clubs, before and after covid we hope, also have live shows, often overseas artists. Most of these artists are a little past their glory days but we still enjoy seeing them. The clubs support local charities, have lots of children's activities during the holidays and host weekly events such as bingo, bowls etc. During lockdown all pubs and clubs have been closed. On the same theme one thing that we notice in Florida is there is no RBT (random breath testing). Some of you will find the below a little "infringing on our civil liberties", but we are in the majority, happy if it stops us or our loved ones being injured or killed by a drunk driver.

In NSW our drink driving limit is .05. It was introduced in the 1980s. The police set up a type of roadblock anytime of the day or night, anywhere and pull over drivers. Not everyone gets pulled over, it's pretty random. You are then tested via a blow device. If over, fined, sometimes taken back to the police station for a blood test. The fines are heavy and can be jail but it has certainly curbed the drunk drivers on the road. They have also now introduced a drug test via the same method.
