

The ladies pass the book around so that no one has the call responsibility for a long period of time. Currently, there are about six or eight people that request a call each day so it is not a lengthy call, unless you choose it to be. There are about five people who make the calls but some of them are snowbirds and some of them can't do it due to their own health issues so I am asking that anyone who would like to volunteer an hour or so each morning to make a few well-check calls...please contact Sylvia Harris in Lot #183. The more call volunteers we have, the fewer days each person has the book. Also this helps when one of the volunteers is away or is ill and can't make the calls. We have volunteers from both WW1 and WW2 and also the calls are made to anyone in either WW1 or WW2 who requests the service. Please give this some thought.

with a young son (Bill) at home. They dated for awhile and married in September of 1968. Immediately bringing his new family together, they took a family trip to Niagara Falls as their Honeymoon. They have one daughter together, Patti, who recently moved to Westwind 2 to



help Paul after some health issues earlier this year. Paul and Lorrie had very busy lives but always made time for family. Lorrie, born in Brooklyn, NY, was a Registered Nurse (RNC) working in many units throughout the hospital: emergency care, medical, surgical and later became certified in psychiatric care after an on-the-job injury sidelined her for awhile. Her hobbies were crafts, sewing, reading and cooking. She enjoyed her family the most and would always be there for any family or friends. They were happily married for 47 years before Lorrie unexpectedly fell ill in December, 2015 and passed away in January of 2016.

After graduating high school, and following in his older brother's footsteps, Paul entered the Navy in 1954. Lorrie loved to shop, Paul not so much. So as she was shopping at the local stores, some had arcade games at the front of the store. Paul mastered the PAC-Man games when they came out. Teens gathered around to watch in awe. Tuesday nights were his movie nights and would always check out the newly released movies before cable was available in our area.

Weekends were for family, whether it be a day at his in-law's pool with a cookout, historical Forts Ligonier & Gettysburg, Amish Country in Lancaster, PA, the Pittsburgh Zoo & museums. They always encouraged educational trips and lots of reading for their children. Summer fun vacations took the family up and down the east coast to visit family in New York City & New Jersey, shore time at Virginia Beach, Jekyll Island, GA and eventually Myrtle Beach, SC as it became a favorite for the kids.

Once the kids were older and on their own, Paul & Lorrie were Atlantic City bound. Lorrie once played the slots for almost 24 hours straight at Trump's Castle on the Bay and because of her winnings, the casino comped them a free week's stay and meals. They often took Lorrie's parents (also former Westwind 2 residents, Ann & Al Parler of #490) along for the casino trips.



Paul's daughter, Patti, graduated high school with honors and was a member of the National Honor Society. She attended Duff's & Pittsburgh Business Institutes. She was a certified travel agent working for DeBolt Unlimited Travel when DeBolt was chosen to provide guide service to HRH, Charles, Prince of Wales during his historic visit to Pittsburgh. She briefly lived in Pinellas Park for a year before returning to the Keystone state.



We visited Brandywine Falls which was way more spectacular than I expected. We then hiked around the Ledges, carefully stepping over rocks and tree roots as we struggled up and down the trail. This is a sculpture dedicated to Berger, an Israeli-American who was killed in the 1972 Olympics in Munich. From there we headed home. Over the years, Lee Ann and I have visited various NPS sites throughout Ohio, but now we can say we have seen them all!

#### **LET'S TALK ABOUT WEEDS**

THANKS TO JACQUELYN FLOOD FOR THE FOLLOWING:

et's talk about weeds. They are getting out of control and I'm having to send letters almost every day. Some of them are 2nd letters and I do not want to send them at all. However, I'm getting lists daily of lots who need to take care of this. I also get complaint forms dropped off, calls, emails and walk-ins of neighbors who are living next door or across the street from these lots. Plus, I see them while inspecting the community. If you read the Occupancy Agreement you will notice that it states the Board of Directors can hire someone to maintain lots and charge the homeowner if it's not taken care of and that seems even worse than a letter. So, instead of simply sending letters, (which I still have to do), or taking a chance on letting anyone get charged, I've decided to give a couple suggestions too. I've been adding the contact info of a neighbor in Westwind I who came down to tell me he is looking for new clients to pull/spray weeds..PLEASE CONTACT ME AND I WILL BE HAPPY TO GIVE YOU CONTACT INFORMATION."

I really appreciate everyone for taking some time to get the weed issue in Westwind II under control. I understand that not everyone lives here full time and others just can't do the weeds themselves.

Also, an important reminder that if you've not gotten your updated insurance info to me, please do so ASAP. Keep in mind that it's the Declarations page that's required and not the invoice. The Declarations page will say that's what it is right at the top. If you aren't sure which page to send, just let me know and I can show you. If you need to make a copy to give the office, there is a copy machine in the library and, if necessary, I'm more than happy to make a copy for you. I can't stress how important it is to keep your insurance updated and to make sure the office has a copy.

We need to do this with any ESA's in the park as well so, if it's time to obtain updated vaccination records, make that veterinarian appointment and get that updated and dropped off at the office too.

Lastly, if anyone has any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to let me know. The Complaint/Suggestion forms and the ARC Request forms are in the plastic bins right outside the office door and there is a mail slot right on the door you can drop the completed forms in. I also want to thank all of the residents who have offered to help as it's a generous offer and very much appreciated. Thank you.




