Let ave you ever noticed how narrow our side streets are? While nearly all public side streets throughout Pinellas County are 35-40 feet wide, ours are only 27 feet. I wouldn't be bringing this up if we had sidewalks, but pedestrians are forced to share our streets with motor vehicles. And you'd think most drivers would be aware of this, and drive at more careful speeds... but sadly, they don't.

It never ceases to amaze me how fast so many people drive through Briar Creek. It doesn't matter if they're from Phase 1 or Phase 2, a homeowner, visitor or a commercial operation, too many people drive far too fast. And how many lives are put in jeopardy every day, just because these inconsiderate drivers are looking to shave a few seconds off the race to the McMullen Booth traffic light? It's sad, and it's pathetic.

I will continue to monitor this situation, and if it doesn't improve then I can assure youmeasures will be taken, up to and including the installation of speed bumps (which have already been approved by the local fire departments). Once you leave Briar Creek, I couldn't care less what your 'road manners' are, but in here-you WILL drive responsibly.

WATER LEAKS

Remember to shut off your water and sprinklers when you are done watering.

ver the past three months I have been called about water leaks on three occasions. Upon investigation found that a hose or sprinkler had been left on for several hours. On two of the occasions, they had been on for several days. The water leak may go undetected for some time as it takes time for the water to drain to the street before it is noticed.



So just be aware when you are watering to shut off your hose or sprinkler when you are finished watering. Residents who are not here, and have someone taking care of their property, call them to remind them to turn off the water. Also, if you are watering and the water is running down the street you have watered enough. The ground is saturated so turn off the sprinkler.

<u>Mow dates for October are not yet available at press time.</u> Lawn Care Maintenance Tips

f you have areas on your property which are extremely soft from rain, please mark those areas with some small red flags. I have on order small red flags to be used to identify soft areas of the lawn. Contact me if you need some.

Unfortunately, the mowers cannot visually identify those areas in advance and after they run over the areas it's too late. They work on so many different properties there is no way for them to recall all areas that may be affected from week to week. Also, it may not be the same worker. If you don't want your entire lawn mowed we have large Red Markers which alert then to not mow the entire property. Make arrangements for the Red Marker ahead of time.

Driveways with cracks. Grass will seed in those cracks and can eventually make the cracks wider and even break away some of the concrete. You may want to spay weed killer or similar product to kill those areas.

If you have vinyl skirting that extends to the ground, please install scalloped edging brinks along the base of the skirting. Unfortunately, the weed trimmers trying to trim the weeds can damage the skirting if there is no protective barrier.

Please report any issues to Gene Arend 727-725-5844. I am documenting all issues. I may not have an instant remedy in all cases but I do hope eventually to educate and improve the service. Replacing a Lawn Care Maintenance Service may seem like an instant solution however we end up back where we are again. I think the solution is to improve the service we already engage. I have met with the lawn service contractor and crew supervisor and in the coming weeks hope to accomplish some improvements. Please do not engage with the crew,







<u>TREES</u>

If you have trees that overhang any street in the community you must keep them trimmed to 14 feet above the road. This allows for the passage of fire equipment, Rescue vehicles, and trash trucks to get in without hitting them. Please look at your trees and if they overhang the street allowing less than 14 foot clearance, Make arrangements to get them trimmed to the proper height.

Oddly, Florida Can Run Short of Water

Jody Larson, Phase II

f you've lived here year round, you know that summer brings massive thunderstorms-and these aren't even hurricane related! You'd think Florida has plenty of water, but most of that storm water runs off or percolates down through the sandy soil.

Our drinking water in this part of the Florida peninsula comes from the Floridan Aquifer. Beneath the ground, a "lens" of freshwater, the aquifer, sits on top of more salty water underneath. As freshwater is removed, there's

a danger that more salt could get into the drinking water. Fortunately, this is not a big danger as long as we use water consciously.

Here are a few tips for conserving drinking water:

- 1. Check your toilet for "silent" leaks. Add a few drops of food coloring to the tank, and wait 10 to 15 minutes. If you have a slow leak, the color will appear in the bowl. Fixing this can be as simple as changing the flapper.
- 2. Fix leaking faucets, and consider using low-flow aerators to save water. For a bathroom sink, a flow rate of 1.5 gal/minute is sufficient.
- 3. Don't let the water run while washing dishes, shaving, or brushing teeth.
- 4. If you have a dishwasher, run it only for full loads.
- 5. Limit showering time to 5 minutes. You can also turn off the water while you soap up.
- 6. Outdoors, follow the Safety Harbor watering guidelines, which restrict lawn watering to certain days and times of day. You can find these at the Safety Harbor website.
