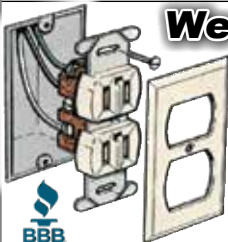

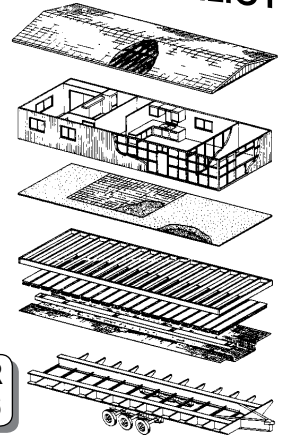

INFORMATION PASSED ON BY NEARBY NEIGHBORHOOD

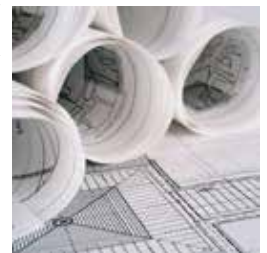

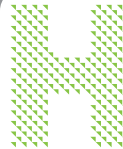

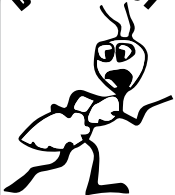

COFFEE CAKE

THANKS TO: PAST RESIDENT DEE HOGAN

CAKE BATTER:

- 1 pkg. yellow cake mix
- 1 pg. inst. Vanilla pudding
- 4 eggs
- ½ C. Crisco oil
- 1 8oz. container sour cream.

CINNAMON STREUSEL

- ½ C. granulated sugar
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 2 tsp cocoa
- 1C chopped nuts



Grease tube cake pan and preheat oven to 350°. Combine all batter ingredients and beat at medium speed for 2-5 minutes. Meanwhile combine streusel ingredients and set aside. Pour ½ of the batter in prepared tube pan. Sprinkle ½ of streusel mix over batter. Pour remaining batter on top and sprinkle with remaining streusel mix. Bake 55 – 60 minutes

DID YOU KNOW?

LHOA has Board meetings monthly and are business related though members/owners are always welcome. Members may and are encouraged to speak to an agenda item or after the agenda has cleared. LHOA will have two stated Member meetings, January and February (annual) in 2022. Any homeowner may attend though unable to vote on Board business. December and March Member meetings are town hall style. Dates will be in the Voice for Board and Member meetings and posted on the bulletin board in the laundry/post room as required by law.

The 2022 LHOA membership enrollment will start on October 1st. The \$15 yearly assessment for membership is a small premium for the state established mandates your LHOA has and takes very seriously. Payment can be given to Dennis Hornsby, Membership Chairman, at Lot 112 or Allyn Webert at Lot 1438. When weekly clubhouse coffee resumes a Board Director will be there to assist in joining or renewing membership. Checks can be made out to LHOA. Cash is ok as a receipt will be given. New members will receive a membership card and current LHOA bylaws by email.

LHOA has an attorney, often called our legal representative or legal agent. This addition of legal expertise is a hallmark of LHOA. Many Florida 55+ rental mobile home parks seem not have a legal agent to discuss park issues. The LHOA attorney counsels LHOA and not an individual homeowner.

Join and maintain your yearly support of Lincolnshire Homeowners Association. LHOA has been in existence for 27 years! Board meetings are generally monthly and Member meetings occur in January with the annual meeting in February. Members and homeowners are encouraged to attend.

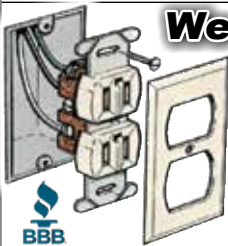

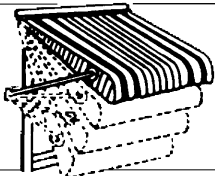

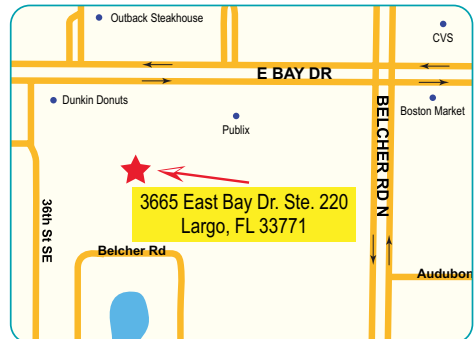

COLA INCREASE

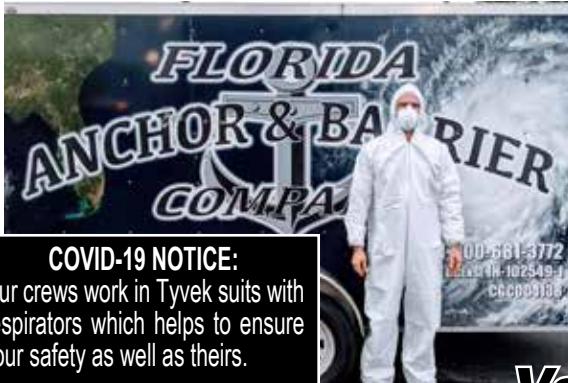

This month's dose is everyone's favorite subject. Immunizations! Yup the season is upon us again and more than ever. There remains vaccines for those who have not previously received for Covid, boosters for those who have received both jabs and our yearly flu vaccines. Pneumonia vaccines on our vaccine schedule too. Shingles jab is also available though not required by the FDA. We shouldn't forget that getting our flu shot is also critical in view of the Covid virus spread. Keep your immunization record current with your medical team. Don't have one, talk to your medical team.



Almost all of us whether from other countries have since being a young child received all the various immunizations along the way. Anyone who served in the military probably has a shot record as long as mine. We received all of these shots because they were required not voluntary as some are now. My point here is that as baby boomers we have a habit of getting immunized. So don't stop now just because they "aren't required." Vaccines have over 200 years of being developed. Did not happen overnight.

And did you know that when we get vaccinated, we also help protect our families and close friends here at Lincolnshire. Because of community immunity, vaccines help keep diseases from spreading to our friends, family and grandchildren. The Covid virus and the variants further complicates this year. Our flu vaccine is a long line of variants over the last 100 years. Not a new concern.

I've gotten all my childhood vaccines. Why do I need more? As older adults we need vaccines for several reasons. Some vaccines are recommended only for adults, who are more at risk for certain diseases like shingles and pneumonia. Protection from childhood vaccines wears off over time so you need additional doses of certain vaccines to stay protected. You may not have

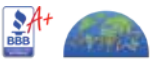

gotten some of the newer vaccines that are now available. Some viruses, like the virus that causes the flu, can change over time. You may be at increased risk for diseases based on where we have traveled, lived part of the year, or our own health conditions.

How do I know which vaccinations I've had and which ones I need? Do the best you can and at the very least ensure your current doctor has as much of a record as you do. Get your shots at a major pharmacy then they can print your record.

There are 2 types of the yearly flu vaccine, one is regular and the other is a Higher Efficacy Dose for those over 65. It's best to get vaccinated before flu season begins spreading in our and your home community. It takes about two weeks after vaccination for antibodies (the elements of our immune system that tackle the infections) to develop and protect against any virus including the flu. 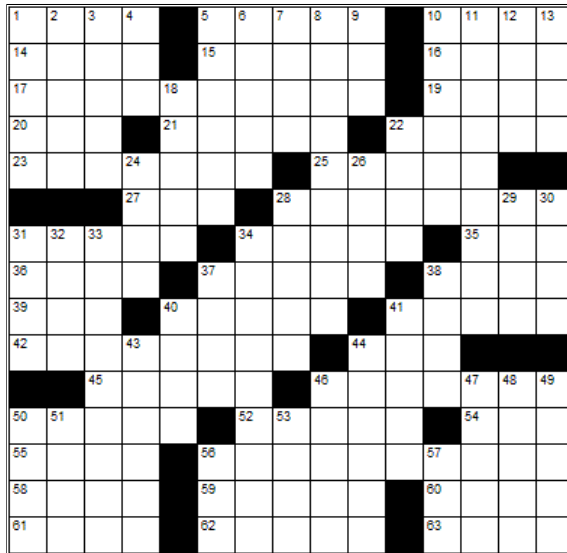
