We were the owners and no longer had to worry about losing our homes. Price tag \$18,500,000.00. Happy to report in little over year and will be paid for. There were a lot of ups and downs through the years, but we always came through.

I hope this article sheds some light on the history of our park. That is why 9-2001 is important to me.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to our sick and shut-ins and those who have lost loved ones.



# **Lift Station Monthly Reminder – Important**

LUSH ONLY: Body waste and toilet paper. It is highly recommended that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.



**DON'T FLUSH:** Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **<u>UP</u>** and **<u>OUT</u>** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.





n July I had the opportunity to start traveling again and was in August joined by another
Travel Committee member for part of my journey.



One of the biggest reasons for going away is to be able to report back my experiences with the current restrictions (which vary!). Our Western Canadian Rocky Mountaineer journey was wonderful. Everyone on board felt comfortable and secure with all the provisions in place. Vancouver, Banff and Calgary were in total compliance with all Canadian restrictions, and we truly felt at ease visiting. We flew with 2 different airlines and experience compliancy with everyone involved.

I then headed to Europe with a group of friends residing in different states, including Florida and Texas. We travelled first to the Netherlands. Everyone wore their mask and were only permitted to remove it during the 2 meals served. To help protect the staff, we had to wait for the flight attendants to move past our aisle before beginning the meal.

While visiting Amsterdam and Rotterdam masks were mandatory inside and optional outside. This included the transit system and trains. Everyone on board the 7-day River cruise was fully vaccinated including all tour guides at destinations and all bus drivers taking us to daily activities. The maximum capacity permitted on board was capped at 70%. Masks were worn inside, and temperature checks were taken daily.

As I proceeded to Paris, the experience was similar with added provisions. On my 4th day in France a new policy was implemented where proof of vaccine was needed in all café's (Inside or out) restaurants, museums, any public area. No proof...no entry.

The Paris-Normandy River Seine cruise also followed all country protocols and of course the same restrictions as my previous Rhine cruise. Masks were worn inside, and dining tables were set up according to the size of the group traveling together. Once again, on day 5 the PCR testing was arranged for our departure home.

Celebrity Cruise lines is the luxury line of the Royal Caribbean Group and has worked very closely with CDC to ensure all provisions are working.






impressed with the policy adopted by Celebrity and the Royal Caribbean group.

Everyone was vaccinated and tested within 72 hours of boarding the ship, all were negative. Check in was 98 % touchless and took 10 minutes from curb to stateroom. The luggage arrived to the cabin before we did. We were 800 passengers. Day 5 was nose poke day. The testing was very organized and completed within an hour. A couple hours later, Captain Kate announced in a very frank and transparent way, that during the testing, there was a positive result. In that impressively small window of time, the couple was "very comfortably" isolated in the expanded medical facility, and through the technology on the ship they completed the full contact tracing, tested all those who were deemed close contact. Thankfully there were no additional positives onboard. The murmurs around us were not of panic but relieved.... "their protocols work".

The next day we are in Nassau where organized excursions were required if you wanted to leave the ship. We planned on enjoying a leisure day on board so I went to my favorite hangout, Café al Bacio.. I looked out the window as an ambulance showed up. A few minutes later, a couple, and luggage, surrounded by several clad crew members, boarded the ambulance. Of note, they were waving goodbye to the crew in a pleasant, not angry fists, but genuine thank you waves! I felt fortunate to witness this. Captain Kate came on the speaker a few moments later to offer the update. The couple had just disembarked and were being taken to the airstrip where they would be flown directly home in the chartered jet!
