NEW Rules and Regulations: Subject #5—SALE AND/OR REMOVAL OF HOME

Rule # 5.2 States that before a new owner for your home is approved for residency, management will inspect the home to be sure it complies with all rules and regulations and meet local code requirements. Assurances must be given that the required repairs/upgrades will be done or proof of completed repairs.

<u>Rule # 5.4</u> Further states that failure to maintain the home according to established standards shall be a violation of these Rules and Regulations.

Management has indicated that going forward this rule will be enforced.

The HOA Board is being proactive and explaining or bringing to our attention the new rules that pertain to us all (owner or renter). The method right now is by highlighting some rules every month in the media.

With NO street names, it is important that the Emergency services be able to locate any resident or tenant in need of attention. This means GREAT house numbering for them to see DAY or NIGHT. It is also in the rules and regulations:

6. SETUP: NEW or RESALES

6.5.10 – Residents MUST secure their street number and/or lot numbers on the front of the Home, placed consistently with surrounding homes as required for emergency services and in accordance with applicable county code requirements.

If you plan to make any exterior modifications to your home, you must get a modification form from management and have your project approved. This applies only to new modifications that will likely also require a permit from Largo. If you are changing/repairing current standing structure, no form is required.





to prevent the windows from being opened.

- 2. Deadbolt locks should go into the door frame 1", but the screws that hold the plate on the frame need to be 3" and most of them are not. The longer screws could be bought at the same time you purchase the deadbolt lock. (This would make it much harder for anyone to "punch" your deadbolt equipment to break the door open.)
- 3. Consider purchasing <u>solar lights</u> for use when the electricity is off INSIDE your home and on your porch or carport. Hopefully, this would discourage vagrancy when the power out and you may not be home.
- 4. Having cash on hand, especially during hurricane season, is always suggested. Small bills are best but, separate the cash. Don't keep it all in the same pocket, purse, and wallet, put it in several places.

<u>Fraud:</u> Additionally, Officer Tran spoke about the tremendous increase in fraud, especially using Facebook. He had many good tips for Facebook users including keeping your settings on private rather than public and considering NOT using your real name.

Don't forget, if you see something suspicious you can directly call the Largo police at their **non-emergency number** 727-587-6730 and report it to your Watch Team leader. Absolutely call if you see a crime being committed. The Neighborhood Watch team members are listed in the front of the Media.



s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado must be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble.

We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you are not sure if your name is on the parks reposall list. We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose to not let air into your hot water heater. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.

s promised, I did not include a poem this month but a book review instead! Gute Lesen!!!

Book of the month: Fried Green Tomatoes at the Whistle Stop Café

By: Fannie Flagg

Though this book came out in 1987, it was way ahead of its time. It touches upon almost everything—racism, murder, spousal abuse, lesbianism, euthanasia, loss of a limb and even cannibalism—yes, cannibalism! If that does not entice you to read it, nothing else will! The book takes place in a small town of Alabama and bounces back and forth between the present and the past—all the way back to the 1920s and up. It centers around a woman who meets an older lady in a rest home and the stories this woman tells about her hometown as the two grow inexorably closer. Through these stories, the younger woman, Evelyn Couch, finds her own salvation in weight loss and self-esteem.

Idgie (Imogene) Threadgoode is the main character from the past who becomes a recluse after the death of a beloved brother. Her friend, Ruth, has married a man who beats her frequently. The story relates how Ruth is finally freed from her husband and starts to work at the Whistle Stop Café with Idgie. Homeless people know they can always come to this place for a meal, and when the whites won't let black people come in and eat, the girls serve them from the back and cut down the prices. Ruth's estranged husband comes looking for her and

mysteriously disappears, and love blossoms between Idgie and Ruth. If you saw the movie, they took this element out which is a travesty because it was one of the strongest themes of the book. See the movie FIRST if you are going to read the book! That way you won't be overly disappointed!

The story also describes the lives of others and what fates have befallen each. These are cooks at the café and the various children who are born to the primaries in the story. It has funny moments as well as sad, and at the end are delicious recipes straight from the Whistle Stop Café! One of the best being fried green tomatoes, of course! The closing of the railroad yard takes the café and the town off the map and the fate of Idgie is finally revealed at the end of the book. Evelyn Couch is selling Mary Kay and has a new lease on life and fried green tomatoes are still a strong staple in the southern diet. This novel has been taught in schools and was on the New York Times Best Seller List for 36 months. If you have an open mind and want to learn more about times in the south back before and during the Great Depression, then this book is definitely for you.

Each seems to die according to what happens to each Indian in the poem and the plate with the Indians on it is showing less and less of these figures as time goes by. I don't want to give anything away, but I would definitely recommend this film to a mystery buff. The film has been done quite a few times, but the version I saw and was recommended to me was the one from 1965. I enjoyed it thoroughly as well as the many actors who were in it. It is what you call a good popcorn movie, and until we start having weekly films here again, it is a good one to watch on your own or with family. TRASH PICK-UP SERVICES

- 1. All garbage must be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 lbs.
- 2. Please do not place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. All broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely. Dispose of all medical needles and medicines properly do not place in trash bags.
- 3. All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- 4. Trees and brush trimmings must be cut into no larger than 4 foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18-inch diameter in order to be picked up.
- 5. All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for proper pick-up. Bags are to weigh no more than the 25 lbs as specified above.
- 6. Furniture appliances paints and any constructional materials will not be picked up.
 - a. Place furniture and constructional debris in open top dumpster.
 - b. Appliances and paint please call Pinellas county solid waste division 727-464-7500.
- 7. Please do not place any trash out the night before pickup as this will invite animals to rip open your garbage thus making it more difficult and time consuming for pick-up. Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled by your neighbors and by our staff.

Thank you for your cooperation Management and Staff

People are still putting their trash out before Tuesday or Friday mornings.

Please try to obey these rules--they are for **everyone**. If you are unable to be up in the morning and take out your trash, please get a heavy duty garbage can with a tight lid to put it in. This will not allow animals to get into it and it can be left out a little earlier than the specified time. This is ONLY for tight lidded garbage cans!!! Plastic ones are fine and you can get a good one at Walmart or Amazon.
