Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

Driveways

There have been close calls with residents backing out and not looking. We strongly urge residents to obey the one-way arrows. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten hit because of someone going against the arrows.

Mowing

f you have any problems with the mowing, please contact the office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact the manager and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

Golf Carts

olf carts are only to be driven by persons 18 years old and older with a valid driver's license and you should obey the speed limits within the park.

Fire Hydrants

e have been asked to advise you not to hang anything on the fire hydrants. It will hinder the fire department if they must come into the park.


