EMERGENCY KEYS

There has been a big turnover in our park the past few years and some of the locks have been changed. If you want the office to have a set of keys in case you get locked out or if the house has some type of emergency, you may want to make sure we have a set that works. We will never enter without permission.

HOW TO KEEP YOUR HOME PEST FREE

- Most pests come in from the outside. Make sure your home is well sealed.
- Keep plants of the building as they provide pest "highways" into your home."
- Reduce food, water, and clutter that attract pests inside.
- When leaving for extended periods of time, have someone run water in the drains weekly to prevent pests coming up from the sewers.







Please remember; <u>COME TO THE OFFICE</u> to sign in/out, NOW WE ARE OPEN. This is needed to begin and stopping the Water/Sewer/Trash Bill. Residents can notify Jane by either dropping a note in the black mailbox at the clubhouse front door, email, or come to the office during business hours (9:00-2:30 PM). Facial covering (mask) is highly recommended to enter the clubhouse and required for office visit. We will need your name, lot# and day of arrival or departure. Do Not leave a message on the answering machine, it must be in writing to be effective. Per the Golden Gate Rules & Regulations: (#16 Home sites): Shareholders will be exempt from billing for City utilities for any month which the home is unoccupied providing the sign out procedure with the office has been properly completed.

Closing up your home when you leave remember to;

• Turn off your water

- Store all garden items and trash receptacles
- Forward your mail.
- Sign out

"The feeding of non-domesticated animals or birds or roaming cats and dogs is not permitted on the association grounds."

POOL - You must be out of the pool area by 2300 (11 p.m.). The FOB's turn off at exactly 2300 (11 p.m.) and if you are still inside the pool enclosure you will be locked in.

Reminder: GG Rule #18.

OMPLAINT, COMPLIANCE, AND DEFAULT: Any complaints regarding breaking any of the rules in the governing documents by a Shareholder or their guests are to be written on a complaint form (available in office) and must name the resident or guest against whom the complaint is being filed, specify the rule being violated and date when alleged violation occurred, be signed and dated and presented to the office. The Board of Directors should send a Notice of Violation to the Party noted in the complaint containing a description of the alleged violation, statement identifying which provision of the governing documents has been alleged violated, a reasonable time to abate the violation and a statement that a hearing may be held or requested. How to pay your monthly maintenance fees

olden Gate residents use many different methods to pay their monthly maintenance fees



- 1. Write a monthly check INCLUDING LOT#, place in the mail, or deliver to the office before the 1st of each month to avoid late charges.
- 2. Write one check to cover two, three, six or twelve months mail or deliver to the office.
- 3. Pay in cash– Highly discouraged or money orders. We will no longer take postdated checks.

Cash payments are discouraged as the homeowners' association incurs a bank charge. The bank charges approximately \$10 for large cash deposits. Seems outrageous but they must call for a pickup to deposit extra cash in the federal reserve bank and remove it from their premises.

BEST OPTION TO PAY YOUR MONTHLY MAINTENANCE FEE IS BILL PAY!

Use Bill Pay at your bank (most banks offer this service at no charge and saves postage) If you have a computer, you can do it yourself or go to your bank, they will assist you.

- Sign on to your account
- Go to Bill pay
- Set up recurring payments
- Put in Golden Gate Residents
- Address 8201 40th St No, Pinellas Park, FL 33781
- Account No. Your address/lot number
- Date to mail on the 25th to 28th of the month to ensure payment received by GG by the 1st of the month to avoid late charges. Checks are never deposited by GG before the 5th of the month.
- Recurring 12 payments

Remember to change amount annually if necessary, according to approved budget. If you need help, your bank will help you or one of the directors will guide through the process



Top Tips to Protect Your Bike...

1. Get a decent lock

Bike thieves need to operate quickly to reduce the chance of being caught, so a decent bike lock is literally worth its weight in gold.

A heavy-duty bike lock can make a thief's job more difficult, with the result that they abandon attempts to steal your bike or move onto a bike with a less secure lock.

- Buy a decent lock preferably two
- 2. Make your mark

Marking your bike with a unique code ensures that Police will be able to trace your bike back to you if it is stolen and

- will be able to trace your bike back to you if it is stolen and recovered.
- 3. Insure it

A bike can cost as much as an item of jewelry, an antique or a painting so make sure you are well covered by insurance in case of theft.

4. Out and about Bike thefts can occur at any time - day or night. A growing trend is that thieves are stealing certain makes and models to order.

- Park your bike in a well-lit area, where it can be easily seen by passers-by.
- Lock both wheels and the frame of your bike to a cycle stand or other immoveable object. Use designated parking areas where possible.
- Make sure the locks go through the bike frame as well as both wheels and the post you are securing it to.
- 5. At home

More than half of bikes are stolen from home. Reduce the chances of this happening by:

- storing your bike in a locked shed or garage
- keeping it out of view
- securing it to an immovable object.

6. Follow the Three R's:

Record-

Keep a record of the frame number, make and any other marks that can identify your bike if it is stolen. Take a photo of the bike and write a description of it, so you can describe it accurately if it does get stolen.

Register-

Register your bike details onto BikeRegister.com. By marking and registering your bike you stand a chance that the police will be able to return it to you if it is stolen and recovered.

Report-

More and more marked bikes are being recovered and returned to their rightful owners, so if your bike is stolen you should definitely report it to the police.

PLEASE NOTE

There is no doubt that COVID-19 has affected us all in one way or the other. The fact that many of our snowbird residents have not been able to come to our park for almost 2 years shows in the condition of many homes in our park. suggest that you might want to consider scheduling some maintenance to be done on your home prior to your arrival. The Board has been very aware and understanding of the effect of COVID-19 on our residents and the difficulty with not being able to hire contractors to come to our homes. Pressure Washing and overgrown weeds are the number one issues right now. Weeds and/or dirt and Mildew on some of homes need immediate attention. It may be more difficult to get someone to hire for these issues when you come down, as many others not only in our park, but also every other park in our surrounding area will be trying to hire them also. You may not be able to get anyone to come to your home for months or longer. Please consider scheduling this work as soon as possible. Many of our residents use the same contractors year after year and have their names and numbers. If there is anything the Board can help you with on this issue, please don't hesitate to contact the office. Looking forward to seeing you all back in our community this fall.
