

ach month I will focus on a different aspect of the Rules and Regulations for Caribbean Isles.

Did you know??...

*The speed limit in the Community is 15 miles per hour.



*No repairs or overhauling of any vehicle is permitted in the Community, including oil changes.

*Parking in our Community is limited. It is recommended and urged that all Residents and/or Guests utilize the resident's home driveway. Vehicles may park anywhere in the Community that is available for legal parking and does not interfere with the parking, backing, or safe operation of the vehicles of others. A two (2) foot clearance must be left on both sides of existing driveways to allow safe entry and backing. Cars should not be parked in front of mailboxes. Individuals who park a vehicle in a no parking area may be towed at the owner's expense.

*Motor homes, recreational vehicles, or boats may be parked for a maximum of two (2) consecutive nights in the Community for the purpose of loading or unloading. There will be no fresh water hookups. Sleeping overnight in a camper, travel trailer or motor home is not permitted. Boats, travel trailers, trucks and/or recreational vehicles are not to be stored on the Resident's Unit at any time.


*Motorcycles, motorbikes, mopeds, auto cycles, and motor scooters are NOT permitted in the community at any time, with the exception of three-wheeled electric bicycles and approved medical aids.

*Electric golf carts are permitted and must be registered with the Management Office. All drivers of the golf carts shall be sixteen (16) years of age or older and carry a valid driver's license with them when driving in the Community.


