IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!

Tell folks, we have two more months to go! But don't let your guard down! The hurricane season ends on November 30. Continue to be alert and prepared.

- Listen for weather updates radio (WEOC AM940) and TV.
- Keep your survival kit at the ready.
- Get cash and fuel your car.
- Protect the windows and secure your awnings and outdoor objects.
- Purchase bottled water, freeze containers of water, have coolers handy.
- Refill prescriptions.
- Make an itemized list of personal property and take photos.

Hurricane Warning means that a hurricane is expected within 24 hours. If there is a MANDATORY EVACUATION, <u>all</u> residents must leave when notified. Announcements will be made over the radio and TV. Decide in advance where you would go (to a friend, relative, or hotel). Leave early. If you need assistance in evacuation, you should register in advance with the Largo Fire Department (form is available at the FSE office).

If you must evacuate:

• Take your survival kit, important papers including identification with local address, jewelry and any other items of value.

- Let friends or relatives know where you will be going.
- Turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Check your neighbors and make sure they have a ride.
- Lock all windows and doors when leaving.
- Drive carefully to nearest assigned shelter or local hotel or friend/relative.

Once evacuation is lifted and you can return home, beware of fallen branches, flooding and hanging electrical wires. Before entering your home:

- Check for damage from the outside.
- Turn water, gas and electricity back on.
- If area has been without power for an extended period, the perishables in your refrigerator may have to be discarded.

S'MORES COOKIE CUPS – YUMMY!

Ingredients

- 1 cup finely crushed graham cracker crumbs (about 7 whole graham crackers)
- 1/4 cup powdered sugar
- 6 tablespoons butter, melted
- 12 marshmallows (regular size, not mini marshmallows)

• 2 full size Hershey's Chocolate Bars, unwrapped and divided into 24 pieces

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350F.

- 1. In a small mixing bowl, combine the graham cracker crumbs, powdered sugar, and melted butter.
- 2. Grease a 24 cup mini muffin pan with non-stick cooking spray. Scoop the graham cracker crust mixture into the 24 cups. Gently press the crumbs into the bottom of each cup and up the sides to form little cups.
- 3. Bake the mini graham cracker crusts at 350F for 4 minutes until golden brown.
- 4. Cut each marshmallow in half to make 24 round marshmallows. Place one marshmallow in each graham cracker cup, cut side of the marshmallow facing down.
- 5. Set the oven to broil. Place the pan of s'mores in the oven under the broiler and broil for 1-2 minutes, just until the marshmallows are soft and beginning to look toasted. Note: the marshmallows can burn fast, so watch them very closely.
- 6. Top each marshmallow with one piece of the Hershey's Chocolate Bar. Allow the s'mores to cool for 15 minutes, then use a butter knife to lift them from the pan.






