HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION REPORT November 2021

Real ushers in our first official meeting of the HOA membership since the changeover in Directors. We encourage you to take the time to be involved in the issues regarding management of Riviera Estates. A good understanding of how responsibilities are shared between park owner and residents will help us all to appreciate what is being done and an opportunity to provide your inputs on what is important to you as a resident.

Please NOTE date and time for the November HOA General Meeting has been adjusted to 11:00am Saturday, 6 November.

The agenda for the November meeting includes proposed changes in the HOA By-Laws

which adjust the HOA meeting days and establish how many are required to carry a vote.

Additionally, at this meeting we should have the 2022 prospectus which we hope will include any changes in rules, regulations, lot rent and passthrough charges. It will be of utmost importance



for you to review the prospectus and be prepared to discuss questions and concerns. We are limited to 30 days in which we can discuss these changes with the owners.

Finally, there will be discussion regarding the Directors and Officer insurance which protects your HOA volunteers from potential lawsuits. The need for this coverage has been painstakingly researched and was approved in 2019. However, since HOA meetings were stopped due to COVID, the policy was cancelled. With the reestablishment of an active HOA, coverage has been resumed. While there are adequate funds to cover this year, we will need to discuss how continuation of this coverage will be paid in the future. Current HOA membership dues are \$5 per year. One way to cover this need would be to raise dues to \$15 per year, with dues increasing by \$5 each year for the next two years. There are also other ways to raise funds and we would hope for discussion during this meeting.

All residents are welcome and encouraged to attend, but only HOA members can vote, so please bring \$5 for your dues. There is one vote per household.

November in History

ovember 11, 1918 - At 5 a.m., in Marshal Foch's railway car in the Forest of Compiegne, the <u>Armistice</u> between the Allied and Central Powers was signed, silencing the guns of <u>World War II</u> effective at 11 a.m. – the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month. In Canada and many places in Europe, a moment of silence in memory of the millions of fallen soldiers is still observed. Celebrated in the U.S. as Veterans Day (formerly called Armistice Day) with parades and military memorial ceremonies

November 22, 1718 - Blackbeard the pirate (Edward Teach) was killed off the coast of North Carolina after a long and prosperous career. Lt. Governor Alexander Spotswood of Virginia had sent two sloops to put an end to him. The sailors encountered Blackbeard and Lt. Robert Maynard killed him in the fight that followed.

November 26, 1789 - The first American holiday occurred, proclaimed by President George Washington to be Thanksgiving Day, a day of prayer and public thanksgiving in gratitude for the successful establishment of the new American republic.

November 29, 1864 - U.S. Army troops led by Colonel John Chivington attacked and killed at least 400 Cheyenne and Arapahoe Indians at Sand Creek, Colorado after they had already surrendered.

This Month Meet: Lavonna Csutoras

y name is Lavonna Csutoras, and I moved to Lot 57 on 7th Way S in Riviera Estates on 4 Dec 2020. I moved from Palm Harbor, where I lived for the previous 3 years with my husband of 34 years, Richard. Before that we lived 28 years in southern Illinois.

Now, back to the beginning, I was raised in a little town called Tokio in western Texas. My mother, father, brother, and I worked very hard on our 500-acre farm and while we had a very modest home, we always had plenty of food on the table. Tokio, Texas is now an official Texas ghost town. The only pleasant part of living in Tokio was the ability to

see to the horizon in all directions. We played chase with the tornados, and I spent many evening hours on the hood of our car looking at EVERY star in the dark sky. I met a wonderful man who was a firefighter in the Air Force. I married him and we moved to Germany for 4 years with our 4 children. It was a magical 4 years, exploring Europe. I was excited to get an entry level civilian job at the Air Force Base as a computer engineer. We made some great friends and had a wonderful time as line judges for our children's swim team, touring throughout Germany one swim meet at a time.

After his 4-year tour was over he got orders to move to southern Illinois, across the river from St Louis. We were there for 28 years and during that time he retired from the Air Force and worked as Chief of Public Safety at Mid America Airport. I continued to work as a civilian in the Department of Defense but did not stay in the Air Force. During my 25-year career I also worked for the Army, and a unified command, US Transportation Command. I retired as a GS-13 Intelligence Officer. My various assignments were dedicated to the area of financial

management. I spent a lot of time traveling coast to coast and abroad or at the Pentagon working to defend budget requirements within the President's Budget. My career was filled with many exciting times.

Unfortunately, my husband was diagnosed with Primary Progressive Multiple Sclerosis in 2010 and by 2013 he was in a wheelchair, by 2017 he was confined to bed. He and I both ended up retired earlier than planned.

We had always wanted to retire in Florida close to a beach. Our son in law's parents had a condo in Innisbrook and loved this area. In 2017 we decided to move to Florida and away from the hard winters (even harder in a wheelchair!) Our daughter, son in law and



granddaughter decided to speed up their move to Palm Harbor too! We all packed up with 2 cats and 2 dogs and headed south!

We were also sad to leave our son and his family in the St Louis area. Our other two sonscontinued on page 16

Place sweet potatoes in a saucepan; cover with water and bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and cook for 15-20 minutes or until tender. Drain.

In a large mixing bowl, mash the potatoes. Add the milk, brown sugar, butter, egg, cinnamon, vanilla, allspice, salt, and nutmeg; beat until smooth. Transfer to a greased shallow 2 1/2 qt baking dish. Bake, uncovered at 350 degrees for 40-45 minutes or until heated through.

Top with marshmallows. Bake 5-10 minutes longer or just until marshmallows begin to brown.

Yields 10 servings

Crunchy Topped Sweet Potato Casserole

Omit marshmallows and reduce brown sugar in sweet potato mixture to 1/4 cup. Before baking, combine 3/4 cup all-purpose flour, 3/4 cup packed brown sugar, 3/4 cup chopped pecans and 1/2 cup melted butter in a small bowl. Sprinkle over the mashed sweet potato mixture. Bake uncovered at 350 for 60-55 minutes or until heated through and topping is browned.

Chakras

Green Chakra

e have now reached the central Heart Chakra within the sevenfold system--the heart of our journey. It mediates between the worlds of spirit and matter. Through this chakra we relate compassionately and unconditionally with others with love. Yet this love is not dependent on others. It is not tribal love of the Root (first) Chakra or sexual love of the Sacral (second) but is the state of being, enduring and constant, regardless of externals--as ethereal as air.



This chakra is concerned with forgiveness and compassion-- unconditional love through which we accept another for doing their best. We then begin to develop true self-acceptance. It is a particularly challenging chakra because of its abstract nature.

Mastering the Heart Chakra helps us to enhance our emotional development and recognize the potency of that powerful energy we call "love".

Chakra characteristics that are excessive, (too open) or deficient (too closed/blocked) and balanced, check to see your energy and how you relate--and then determine (should you choose) to take the necessary action, using the tools and techniques learned here.

Too open (chakra spins too fast) loves conditionally, withholds emotionally "to punish", overly dramatic.

Blocked (chakra spins sluggishly or not at all) --fears rejection, loves too much, feels unworthy to receive love, self-pitying.

Balanced (chakra maintains equilibrium and spins at correct vibrational speed) --compassionate, loves unconditionally, nurturing, desires spiritual experience in lovemaking.

The Heart Chakra (fourth) further develops the internal focus that started with the lower chakras and is concerned with balancing the love for others and the love of ourselves. Our challenge is to pass the test of unconditional love, compassion, and forgiveness for which we are challenged daily, to move on to the higher centers.

- 1. Lie face down on the floor with your arms by your sides, palms facing towards your hips. Breath in, imagining a string attached to your hands pulling upward on to your lower back and lifting your upper body away from the floor. Keep your neck elongated as you look straight ahead, breathing smoothly. Maintain the pose for as long as comfortable.
- 2. Lower yourself gently to the floor again and, as you breathe in, extend your arms out at shoulder level like wings and lift your upper body away from the floor-again facing forward. Imagine your heart area opening and being



offered as a gift to an imaginary recipient in front of you. Ensure that your shoulders don't hunch up, so that you allow your neck to lengthen.

3. A third version on this exercise is, from position 1, to breath in and lift your upper body off the floor, at the same time extending your arms directly in front of you. If it feels more comfortable lift your straight legs away from the floor also. Visualize your heart muscles. then lower your arms and legs to the floor on exhalation.

Two people heart connection exercise is good for developing mutual unconditional love. Lay your right hands on each other's Heart Chakra and your left hands over the other person's hand. Gaze into each other's eyes for a few minutes. Then close your eyes for a while, sensing a continuing deep connection.

Crystals that are useful to use on the Heart Chakra vary between the commonly associated color pink, for "love" as well as green. Green is particularly, is traditionally regarded as a psychologically balancing color.

Rose Quartz--the soothing vibration of this gentle pink quartz helps comfort anyone suffering from emotional "wounds". It prompts the development of self-love, through which one can learn to love others unconditionally.

Watermelon Tourmaline-- usually has a green rind and pink center. It is said to be the "super activator" of the Heart Chakra, allowing this area to become connected with the higher self. This stone helps with any emotional dysfunction and enhances co-operative efforts and tact.

Green Jade--is said to offer reassurance and protection to those feeling vulnerable, when placed over the Heart Chakra. Its gentle resonance encourages strength and stability when you feel afraid or threatened. Green is the energy of balance and healing, and light green jade carries a vibration of love and forgiveness.

Aventurine Quartz--Most commonly green, contains particles of Mica or Hematite, giving it a metallic glint. This uplifting crystal is good for depression, encouraging lightness and enthusiasm for life. It is valuable in maintaining the balance of the Heart Chakra after it has been closed by grief.

Green Calcite--helps develop the strength needed to cope with change or transition by forming a link between the heart and the head. It is an excellent choice when dealing with emotional "wounds" affecting the heart and encourages compassion and tenderness towards oneself and others.

Heart Chakra Meditations:

Choose a leisurely and relaxed time and place to meditate.

- 1. You are beginning a journey to the Heart Chakra. Are you nervous, excited, or pained? Acknowledge these feelings, don't dwell on them...know that you are safe, protected and loved.
- 2. See yourself on a red pathway... feel firm earth beneath your feet.... Notice the road changing to sandy orange, then rippling beneath your feet like water. Your feet feel lighter and help you move closer to your destination.
- 3. The road changes again, to a rich golden yellow... feel its warmth penetrate your feet, warming your entire being......Everything is bathed in golden sunlight.
- 4. Look ahead and see that the road ahead has become green and leads to a pink castle...... As you take this green pathway it falls away beneath you, as if you were walking on air.... You are now at the entrance of the pink castle.
- 5. Feel the heavy door swing open into a vast pink hall.... on a table lies your heart. How does it look? Is it frozen in a block of ice? Or encased in chains? Or is it hemorrhaging energy from being too open to others? Consider its state...Don't judge what you see--you are here to heal it.
- 6. Have the appropriate remedy available to you. Take a pick and chip away at the ice, breath warm air to melt it faster...unlock the chains with a golden key from your pocket...
- 7. Place your hands lovingly on any scars and send universal love to your heart to dissolve them...allow your natural healing energy to give your heart what it needs.
