uzanne and I flew in on October 12th, and have been enjoying the warmth and sun after the cool fall up north. I look forward to another peaceful and warm winter with friends.

It has been a very quiet month in Blue Jay, after a pretty eventful summer which saw the workers from Solitude shoring up the banks of our 2 ponds.

We are between major projects, however, with Pool Works due in mid to late November to begin replacing our pool well. The pool will be closed for an extended period of time as they will be lowering the water level and boring through the side of the pool to install a state of the art leveling system that will hopefully solve the recent problem we have been having with keeping the pool filled properly. At the same time a completely new filtering system will be installed and new underground piping will be done between the filter, the heater, and the pool. This is a very expensive project, costing well over \$30,000 dollars. But keep in mind it only works if we can control the tanning lotions and oils introduced into our pool. If we can't we will continue to have problems, even with a brand new system. It is up to you and your guests to determine how successful our spending will prove to be.

Our landscapers are now on a bi-weekly schedule, which should make shrub trimming and weed control much easier. If you have any issue that needs addressing there is a large supply of reporting forms in the clubhouse. Fill one out and put "put it in the box."



#### Feast Food Pantry Dan & Max Karpf, Coordinators

The FEAST Food Pantry provides food and personal care items to residents in North Pinellas County. They distribute bags of shelf stable food based on family size which typically equates to a 3–4 day supply of food. They also provide perishable food staples such as meat, milk and fresh produce to their clients which helps them to create a balanced diet for



their families. Additionally, their clients receive personal care items such as toilet paper, paper towels, toothpaste and other hygiene products not permitted for purchase under SNAP.

During a visit, they ask their guests "How many in your household?" They distribute the following portions to them: 1-2 guests = 18 lbs., 3-4 guests 25 lbs., 5-6 guests 44 lbs. Weekly, FEAST is distributing approximately 4200 lbs. of food.

At any given time, the most needed items are peanut butter, jelly, pasta and sauce, canned soups, canned veggies of all kinds, side dishes like rice, mashed potatoes, pasta salad and snacks like chips, popcorn, snack bars. FEAST will also take Aldi, Publix & Walmart gift cards as this helps them shop for any items they need most. Donation items can be left in the blue FEAST box located within the clubhouse on the stage. Monetary donations / gift cards should be dropped off to us personally at 172 Hickory Gate Drive. As always, please ensure donated items are unopened and not expired.

During the corona virus emergency, FEAST opened up their doors to everyone, including those not in their regular service area. With the increase in clients, donations are very much appreciated.

As a reminder, Palm Harbor residents may receive food twice a month. You will need to bring your ID and always remain in your car. FEASTs hours for food pick-up are as follows: Monday 430pm – 630pm, Tuesday through Friday 9am - 12noon. FEAST is located at 2255 Nebraska Avenue in Palm Harbor.




