Disc Golf Walking with a Purpose

here's a little known, but fast-growing recreation that people of all ages enjoy. The sport is disc golf and there's a small, beginners' course near Golden Acres at Hammock Park.

Disc Golf is played with aerodynamic discs like Frisbees, using rules similar to golf. A hole is finished when the disc rests in a metal basket. Hanging chains are used to absorb the disc so that it falls into the "hole." Dicks Sporting Goods and Local Route are two nearby stores that sell discs for as little as \$9.

Disc golf is "walking with purpose," but with a greater immersion in the natural world. This is a nice way of saying that if you throw your disc into a bush or a puddle, you should be prepared to get it out.

You can enjoy disc golf anytime. You can go with a group or enjoy the outdoors alone. It's usually easy to meet up and play with whomever is at the course. Some people even play night rounds using glow discs or by attaching small, sticky lights to the discs.

The course at Northeast Coachman is a busy course. You might be surprised at how many older men, women, and families are out there playing. Some people seem to hang out just for the atmosphere. Cliff Stephens is another more serious course, but everyone can feel free to use it. It's pretty cool to watch the flight of a disc thrown as far as 450' or thrown down a path no more than 15' wide. It's important to be mindful of your surroundings. These discs can hurt, and it can be tricky at first to know where the safe areas on a course are.

Disc golf is different than many sports in that you are not playing an opponent as much as you are playing against the course and yourself. You are your greatest opponent in disc golf.

Dr. Stancil E.D. Johnson wrote "When a ball dreams, it dreams it's a Frisbee." A Frisbee just does more, and a golf disc does even more than a Frisbee. Disc are designed to achieve a variety of flight paths and come in many weights to accommodate different arm speeds. Disc can take left turns, right turns, or skip around corners. When thrown overhand, they pendulum *continued on page 10*

left to right before dropping straight down. The farthest throws are usually "rollers". Some pros can throw a roller 650' with accuracy- a pretty challenging thing when you consider the terrain that might need to be navigated.

Each course is very different. The courses with the most variety are often the most fun. This goes against many sports where playing surfaces are measured and manicured. I now view the playing areas of many other sports as being too sterile or fake feeling.

The best courses offer a nemesis on each hole. You might need to throw down a thin trail, up or down hills, or out over water. Maybe it's this combination of problem-solving while being in nature that I like most.

While playing, I've seen gators, deer, birds, and snakes. I've walked within a few feet of an owl eating its prey. On a few occasions, herons and other birds have flown down to look at my disc. They were so interested by its flight that they needed to check it out. In disc golf, wilder seems to be better. I'm enjoying that. One time, I waded into a creek to get my disc, and a large fish came out from hiding. It scared me for a second until I realized it was just a fish.

The sport certainly isn't for everyone. Some people have trouble getting the hang of throwing the disc. But these are some of the people I appreciate seeing the most. They're just out there having fun, moving, and having a good time. I've also found that if you're looking for a sense of community on the course, it's readily available. Disc Golf may just be for you. If you have an interest, feel free to stop by 190, maybe we can throw a round.



Investment Opportunity That Sounds Too Good to be True?

We've all received the pitch — that one investment opportunity that sounds just too good to pass up. But 99.99% of the time, passing it up is exactly the right thing to do. Investment fraud siphons billions of dollars from investors every year. Here's how to spot a phony investment opportunity coming your way.

How it works:

- You get an offer for a "once-in-a-lifetime" investment opportunity.
- There's always a catch you have to act quickly or lose the amazing opportunity.
- You may see the investment pay off at the beginning, giving you confidence to stick with it.



What you should know:

- A pitch that uses phrases such as "incredible gains," "breakout stock pick" or "huge upside and almost no risk" suggests high risk and possible fraud, according to the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.
- The pressure to act now is the key: If the scammer can convince you to engage before you take the time to do any research or think more critically about the offer, they get your "investment" money.
- Early dividends in investment scams are a ploy to make you believe the investment is legitimate; often the money you receive is simply the scammer paying existing "investors" with money from new "investors."
- Investment scammers often target older adults, believing they may be more trusting or have more available assets but anyone of any age can be a target.

What you should do:

- Be proactive: If you're interested in investing, do your research rather than react to a pitch from an ad, a phone call or other source.
- Investigate investment opportunities by learning as much as you can about the offering (whether stock in a company, gold coins, real estate, or any other investment). The SEC offers a <u>database</u> to research publicly traded companies, and FINRA provides one to <u>check</u> the background of brokers.
- Have an exit strategy: Come up with a line that makes it easy to end unwanted contact. Simply "No, thank you" and ending the conversation works!


