here have been several instances in the past where owners have left for a trip and come back to find that there was a water leak in their home. The water had done extensive damage to their floors; sometimes to their walls causing thousands of dollars of damage.

Planning on going away? If so, listed below are a few things you can do to protect your home.

- Shut your water off. This will prevent major damage in the event you have a small water leak (most likely from one of your toilets). The main water shut-off valve should be at the back of your home. If you don't know where it is contact a Board Member for assistance.
- Leave your air conditioner on as this prevents mold in your home. You can set your thermostat to 82 or 84.
- Turn off your hot water heater by turning off the circuit breaker in your electrical panel.
- Make sure all outside furniture is put away. This is to prevent it from blowing around in case of a hurricane or tropical storm.
- Ensure all windows are closed.
- Cover your toilets with plastic wrap this prevents water from evaporating.
- Cover all your sink drains. This will prevent bugs from coming in while you are gone.
- If you are leaving for an **extended period** of time you may want to **empty and turn off your refrigerator**.

• You should consider having a family member or neighbor look after your home while you are away. Or contact 727-582-6177 to schedule vacation checks by Sheriff's department.

The month of August was not kind to our lawns due to the constant rain. While it was good for the growth of our grass it was not good for the heavy equipment used to mow our lawns. We attempted to mark off the areas where the ground was saturated but to get 100% coverage of all suspected areas was not possible and telltale marks from the wheels of the mowing machine were visible. While we believe most of those areas will recover in weeks if any linger on with permanent damage, we will attempt to resolve those issues.

October will see the lawns cut 3 times in that month and November will be reduce to every other week.

December, we will have a schedule; I will attempted to schedule it early in December so lawn Christmas ornamentation will not be affected. As we move into the coming months, I am working with the lawn crew to resolve issues you have reported to me. I may not have provided all of you with 100% satisfaction but we are working in that direction. Contacting me is the best solution. I understand when you call you are not frustrated with me (I hope) but the situation and together my goal is to better manage the service and get them to the Ivory Soap level of 99.44 percent good.

In 1994, fourteen years after BC II's founding, the residents approved a combined and updated set of documents. This is the existing set we are now working with. Over the years numerous amendments have been passed and notices mailed to owners. These were intended to be kept with the documents—but not all owners have kept them. The results is that incomplete information is always being passed around.

In 2021, twenty-seven years since 1994, it's time to merge the documents once again to start fresh.

A Committee of your neighbors worked for months to come up with a revised set of documents—not to change any rules, but to make things more readable and to fold in the

amendments. The revised versions have been accepted by Progressive Management, their Legal Department, and our Board of Directors.

In addition to the updated wording, the Documents will be printed on  $8-1/2 \times 11$  paper (not legal sized), and all owners will get a new set!

On the ballot this year, you'll be asked to vote on the updated Declaration of Condominium and the Bylaws. We, the Committee, urge you to vote Yes for these documents as presented. Do not "kick it to the curb" because you don't like one of the items or a word change. As mentioned, our current rules still stand, so a No vote just means you want keep those yellowed, legal-sized, typewritten pages with loose pages tucked in.

Further amendments to the updated documents can be made as usual, but first owners need to approve the docs.

Please vote YES on the ballot to accept these documents.





# **White Peacock Butterfly**

The White Peacock is a smallish butterfly, with about a 2-inch wingspan. Its wings are white with golden or orange margins and a total of six large dark spots. These resemble the "eyespots" on peacock feathers, which is what gives them their name. Males and females look alike.

The caterpillar form is about 1-1/2 inches long, black and spiny, with tiny white freckles on the body.



I use no pesticides.



The White Peacock is widely distributed in warmer climates in the East. I hadn't encountered them until we came to Florida. But during the summer months this butterfly may wander farther north. One sighting was reported in the Chicago area in 2015!
