Are We Alone in the Universe?

Since the beginning of civilization, people have wondered if we are alone in the universe or whether there is intelligent life somewhere else. 

FROSTED PUMPKIN CAKE SQUARES

Ingredients:

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup canned pumpkin
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup cream cheese
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract

- 2 large eggs
- ½ cup vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ½ cup confectioner's sugar
- 2 tablespoons butter or margarine, softened

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350F. Grease 9-inch square pan.
- 2. Prepare cake: In bowl, with mixer at medium speed, beat sugar and eggs for 2 minutes. Beat in pumpkin and oil. At low speed add flour, cinnamon, baking soda, baking powder, and salt; beat 1 minute.
- 3. Pour batter into prepared pan. Bake 25 to 30 minutes or until toothpick in center comes out clean. Cool pumpkin cake in pan on wire rack.
- 4. Prepare frosting: In Bowl, with mixer at low speed, beat confectioners' sugar and remaining ingredients 2 minutes or until fluffy; use to frost cake.



THE CURIOSITY CORNER

Editor's Note: Armistice: a temporary suspension of hostilities by agreement of the warring parties; truce: World War I ended with the armistice of 1918. (Dictionairy.com, 10/15/02021).

Armistice Day

Armistice Day commemorates the armistice that ended the First World War on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of the year, in 1918. It was man's first, "World War." The scope of the war was so horrible that it was known for decades as "The War to End All Wars." The phrase is apparently often associated with President Woodrow Wilson. The original phrase, The War That Will End War, appeared as



a title of a book by H. G. Wells, containing a series of articles about the war that was critical of Germany. The title became a catch phrase in the second half of 1914. The phrase "The War to End All Wars." has become the more popular variation of the phrase in the last 50 years. In the United States, Armistice Day would later be named in 1954, Veterans Day to honor all veterans

The assassination of Austria's Archduke Franz Ferdinand in Sarajevo, Bosnia would be the catalyst for this great conflict. The assassin wanted Bosnia to be able to separate from the Austro-Hungarian Empire and unite with neighboring Serbia. Germany encouraged Austria to invade Serbia. The invasion initiated a call for help, and because of treaties and suspicions of intent, other European countries were slowly drawn into the conflict.

The military conflicts up to 1914 paled in comparison to what Europe was about to experience. The scale of the impending conflict would be unprecedented, and previously unimaginable or maybe thought of as an "end of days" scenario. The conflict would be a struggle between the great powers of Europe; the Central powers—(Germany, Austria-Hungary, Bulgaria, and Turkey), and the Allied powers—(Britain and Empire, France, Belgium, Russia, Italy, and USA). This war would be considered the first "total war" in which the combatants mobilized all their resources, military, industrial and human, on a scale never before contemplated. Not only would this conflict engulf all of Europe but also extend to parts of Africa and Asia. The entire world became a potential battlefield with much of it affected by this war. The total number of men mobilized by the two sides of this conflict, according to sources, was over 65 million, with an estimated 10 million deaths and 20 million wounded. (Note: Estimated casualty numbers seem to vary widely among references with some much higher.)

Man has been quite inventive when it comes to war. Some of the new instruments of death introduced in this conflict were airplanes, tanks, submarines, flamethrowers, poison gas, and the improved machine gun. Although when World War I is mentioned, it's the image of an endless network of trenches filled with bodies and mud that comes to mind. The early optimism of quick victory faded as trench warfare created an endless demand for men, munitions and supplies with often no apparent gains or victories. The optimistic two-month conflict, dragged on for four and half years. Now with both sides weary of war, riots, and the rumblings of possible revolution in a couple countries, the Central powers sought a truce, peace.

On November 7, 1918, a loud bugle call echoed through the forest as a three-car, German delegation approached the front lines. The delegation informed the front-line soldiers that they

wished to discuss terms of surrender with the French commander. Field Marshall Ferdinand Fochs and Gen. John Pershing, initially had no desire to give terms. Eventually, after some sincere begging by the Germans, Field Marshall Fochs gave his, very harsh, terms and the German government had to accept them before November 11, at 11 a.m., or the offer would be withdrawn. The German delegation requested a ceasefire during this period, however, neither Field Marshal Fochs nor General Pershing had much trust in the Germans sincerity. So, until the terms were accepted, hostilities would continue until the agreed upon time.

On November 11, 1918, at 5 a.m., the German government agreed to the terms. Word of the agreement was sent to commanders in the field and that it would take effect at 11 a.m., but no instruction on how to spend the remaining time. To some, it seemed obvious, why waste lives trying to take ground that will be freely given to you in several hours or days. However, others thought it may be their last chance to improve their country's position at the bargaining table, for a promotion, or one last chance for glory. So, after realizing that the armistice had been signed, some Allied commanders decided to continue ongoing attacks or launch new ones, up and down the front lines, sporadic attacks against the enemy took place. It has been stated that artillery, on both sides, after learning of the cease fire around 9 a.m., even increased their rate of fire.

Commonwealth commanders wanted to retake the city where they had lost their first soldier, English Pvt. John Parr on Aug. 21, 1914. After retaking the city, 25-year-old Canadian Pvt. George Lawrence Price, decided to check out homes along the canals while civilians in the center of Mons had already broken out the wine and whiskey, hidden for years from the Germans, to celebrate with the Canadians. With only a couple of minutes to go, a shot pierced the sounds of celebration and Price collapsed.

A Frenchman, named Augustin Trebuchon, 40, was also shot moments before the cease-fire. He was running to tell his friends where and when they would have a meal after the armistice.

Then there is 23-year-old Pvt. Henry Gunther. Gunther, an American of German descent, was drafted and given the rank of sergeant. He was later demoted for writing a letter to a friend complaining about conditions in the trenches and supposedly discouraging him from joining. It is possible he was brooding about his demotion on No. 11th and saw this attack as a means of redemption. He and his fellow soldiers emerged from a bank of fog in front of two machine gun nests. Most of them stopped short as the first rounds zipped overhead, but Gunther continued. The Germans tried to wave him off, after all the war would end in mere minutes. They yelled but he still came on, so... with one last pull of the trigger, a final burst was sent towards Gunther, recognized as the last American to die on the battlefield, time of death 10:59 a.m.

The senseless fighting seen on the morning of Nov. 11th inflicted a total combined casualty count of approx. 11,000. Had Foch and Pershing heeded the appeal from the Germans on Nov.

8th to stop hostilities while the talks took place, thousands of lives would have been saved. Congress later investigated the seemingly senseless waste of lives on the morning of Nov. 11th and found no one culpable for those deaths.

The victors imposed very harsh treaty conditions on Germany. In some ways the conditions were similar to the treatment given towards China in the previous century. British staff officer Archibald Wavell, a future field marshal and viceroy of India, said of the Paris Peace Conference, "After the 'war to end war', they seem to have been pretty successful in Paris at making the 'Peace to end Peace'." The Treaty of Versailles was signed



on June 28, 1919, with an effective date of January 1920. It only created animosity towards the victors and sowed the seeds for continuing the war at a later date.

Looking back upon the history of man, there seems to be very few periods of true peace. We appear to be a warring species, with someone always determined to impose their will upon others. A utopian peace is only a fantasy, for history seems to dictate that another conflict looms somewhere in our future. Appreciate and value the beauty around you now.

"Let dreamers dream what worlds they please,

Those Edens can't be found.

The sweetest flow'rs, the fairest trees

Are grown in solid ground." - Richard Wilbur

During the war, Canadian Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae, a surgeon for an artillery unit saw a patch of poppies after the second battle of Ypres in 1915. He had tended the wounded and dying, and was very familiar with the hardship, destruction and carnage the war was inflicting upon soldiers. The site of this hardy weed, the poppy, inspired him to write the poem, Flanders Field. The popularity of this poem had spread throughout Europe and the United States before his death, in January 1918, and would become forever associated with World War I.

"In Flanders Fields"

by John McCrae

In Flanders fields the poppies blow Between the crosses, row on row, That mark our place; and in the sky The larks, still bravely singing, fly Scarce heard amid the guns below.

We are the Dead. Short days ago, We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow, Loved and were loved, and now we lie In Flanders fields.

Take up our quarrel with the foe: To you from failing hands we throw The torch; be yours to hold it high. If ye break faith with us who die We shall not sleep, though poppies grow In Flanders fields.
