



COOKING IN LINCOLNSHIRE

This month's "Holiday" recipe follows:

<u>PUMPKIN PIE BISCOTTI</u> <u>THANKS TO: ANNONYMOUS</u>

3 ½ C. FLOUR 1 ½ C. PACKED BROWN SUGAR

2tsp. BAKING POWDER ½ tsp. SALT

2 tsp. PUMPKIN PIE SPICE ½ C. CANNED MASHED PUMPKIN

2 EGGS LIGHTLY BEATEN 2 TBS. VANILLA EXTRACT

2 TBS. BUTTER 1 ¼ C. CHOPPED MACADAMIA NUTS

Combine first 5 ingredients in lg bowl. Combine pumpkin, eggs, vanilla, - stir well with wire whip. Slowly add pumpkin mix to flour mixture. Stir until moistened (will be crumbly)

Melt butter in lg. skillet, add nuts stir until nuts are browned. Remove from heat & cool, then knead into dough.

Place dough onto floured surface – divide into 4 portions. Shape each portion into a 1" x 15" log. Place 3" apart on lightly greased cookie sheet.

Bake at 350° for 23 minutes, cool logs for 15 min. Reduce oven temp to 300°

Cut each log crosswise into $\frac{1}{2}$ " slices. Place on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 300° for 15 minutes -cool completely



ome residents will remember that I love to sing (Remember my Elvis?) but I have serious medical problems with my hearing. Now my hearing has decreased even more, and often earaches may last 6 to 8 hours per day at any time. So, since I am no longer able to sing due to this condition, I

VETERAN'S CORNER:

Infortunately, the Veterans Day Celebration for the City of Largo has been moved to 11am this year on the 11th of NOV. That causes a conflict for me since I run our Veterans Day ceremony in our park at the same time. Since I cannot be in to places at once I would like to invite you to our



Veterans Day Ceremony at Largo Central Park at 11 Am. I am sorry if this causes any hardships for any of you. It will take place by the Veteran's Memorial in the park and if it rains will take place in the Largo Cultural Center in the park. Please join us for this celebration to Honor our Veterans.

Military retirees and veterans receiving disability payments from the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) will see their paychecks go up by 5.9% for 2022, triggered by inflation and an annual adjustment to the federal Cost of Living Allowance (COLA). For 2022, retired military members will see a \$59 increase for each \$1,000 of military retirement pension they receive each month. Disabled veterans will also get a bump. The average VA disability check will go up about \$8.50 per month for those with a 10% rating, and \$185.65 for those rated at 100%. Military retirees and VA beneficiaries aren't the only ones who benefit from the COLA increase. Civil Service retirees and Social Security recipients also will see the 5.9% jump in their monthly checks. For Social Security recipients, the monthly increase will mean an extra \$91 per month for the average beneficiary. Each year, military retirement pay, Survivor Benefit Plan Annuities, VA Compensation and Pensions, and Social Security benefits are adjusted for the rate of inflation.

Military family members whose identification cards expired during the pandemic should make appointments to renew their IDs now, the Pentagon is advising. Roughly a half-million DoD ID card holders -- mainly family members of active-duty, Reserve and National Guard members, as well as retirees and their dependents under age 65 -- were allowed to use expired IDs through much of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. But now these dependents and former service members must renew their cards, with deadlines fast approaching for most, according



to a Pentagon news release issued Friday. A month after the pandemic began last year, <u>DoD officials issued guidance</u> on the use of expired ID cards in an effort to minimize exposure and reduce appointments at ID card offices on military installations. The DoD <u>extended the deadlines</u> several times, most recently in June. Under the latest guidance, dependents of active-duty, Guard and Reserve members whose ID cards expired before July 31, 2021, have until Oct. 31, 2021, to get a new ID card.

Just a reminder that there is a Law that Authorizes Veterans' Salutes during National Anthem. Veterans and active-duty military not in uniform can now render the military-style hand salute during the playing of the national anthem, thanks to changes in federal law that took effect this month. "The military salute is a unique gesture of respect that marks those who have served in our nation's armed forces," said Secretary of Veterans Affairs Dr. James B. Peake. "This provision allows the application of that honor in all events involving our nation's flag." The new provision improves upon a little-known change in federal law last year that authorized veterans to render the military-style hand salute during the raising, lowering or passing of the flag, but it did not address salutes during the national anthem. Last year's provision also applied to members of the armed forces while not in uniform. Traditionally, members of the nation's veterans service organizations have rendered the hand-salute during the national anthem and at events involving the national flag while wearing their organization's official head-gear.

edicated to Sally Schneider who was a long term and loved resident along with her husband Dick who passed before her. Taken from all of her family and devoted friends after a tragic fall while visiting family. New research shows fatal falls have nearly tripled in older Americans in recent years, rising to more than 25,000 early fall related deaths yearly.

Traumatic brain injuries and not only Sally's and another current resident from hitting hard objects like sinks, tables and concrete steps. Plus the associated hip/leg/ankle fractures leading to a very steep health decline are among causes of death in older adults who fall.

Deaths with major injuries from falls have increased because we are living longer, living longer independently, and are living longer with other medical issues that can effect mobility and sensation.

Some medications can also make us prone to falls. That includes prescription drugs affecting balance. Certain psychiatric medications that can cause drowsiness and vision problems has increased substantially in recent years.

Falling is not 100% preventable though you can get pretty dog-gone close. That's a great goal for all of us at Lincolnshire or at your home wherever that wonderful place is. Falls can happen anywhere! And Do! We can't fall up from the floor but the floor can cause us to fall. More on that later (a ploy to keep you reading.)

Ever notice how toddlers fall down but land on their backsides where there is a lot of extra cushion. As veteran adults, we don't do that anymore. Certainly would be less consequences if we still did. Older adults fall forward. That is why so many broken hips, wrists, elbows and shoulders plus a nose or two.

Let's face that fact that all our senses begin to age especially as we get older. Hmmm. And the senses don't always age in the same manner or rate. Sight, Sound, and Touch are used constantly to assist in propelling all of us and our movement. When a person's ability to hear is taken away they are tentative. Simple example. You are walking on loose gravel, you feel it through a sense of touch, hear the crunch plus see it. Our pace gets adjusted to slower and bit more cautious. Gosh we are miraculous.

Speed is a major culprit to falls. Seems the older we get many of us want to get things done faster. Don't want to waste time. We know why that is. Whatever trek we make now just has to be a bit more calculated to ensure we not only get to where we are going but get back successfully. Stop the hurry! Take time to notice the buildup of dust on the lampshade by the sofa. Or a new crop of weeds.

Medications are well known for causing us to have an altered awareness. Read the most important part called "Precautions and/or Side Effects." If it says "causes drowsiness" then it

will believe me. We can become drowsy and not be aware.

Let's take a peek at well-known household hazards (they don't have blinking yellow lights but really should.) Number one is throw rugs on wood floors or tile. We either can slide or get caught up on them. Secondly it is electrical cords especially vacuum cleaners etc. Third is uneven floor surfaces like carpeting to wood or tile then back to carpet. Many falls in Lincolnshire are caused by the homes steps. I always use the railing no matter where. The last biggie is the bottom lip of a walk-in shower. I know this very well!

Outside our homes there are plenty of obstacles to overcome. Steps, curbs, parking space spacers, changes in the walking level and surfaces that are waiting for us. Eyes wide open here!

The last significant item is called distraction and pre-occupation. When I would ask someone who had recently fallen what was going on right before they fell. "I was talking and looking at my friend and didn't see the curb or step or my cell phone rang as I was trying to get it out of my pocket or purse." Eyes are our radar. Always keep looking forward while walking. Pay attention.

I believe you get the picture here. Even familiar surroundings have surprises. Again, slow down. Our sight is the most significant allay we have in avoiding so many falls.

Have a decent day, accident and fall free.
