# A Message from our Community Manager

few things to remember when setting out your household trash and yard waste. All household trash and yard waste must be out for pick-up no later than 8:00 a.m. on Monday and Thursday regardless to where you live in the community as the pick-up rout is subject to change.



Household trash needs to be in plastic trash bags 15 to 30 gallons in size, and the bag must be closed. Yard waste needs bundled and tied tightly together no longer than 4' feet in length, or in heavy duty plastic trash bags no larger than 30 gallons in size. All bags must be closed and not left open. If it is left open it will not be picked up.

Any cardboard boxes must be broken down, and if you have more than one piece of cardboard you must tie the cardboard pieces together. If the cardboard Is not tied together, it will not be picked-up.

Please remember to recycle all that you can, every little bit helps in the cost of removal, and the environment!

# **Co-Op Update**

Clubhouse Air Conditioning – 8 new Air Conditioners have recently been installed. One unit was completely dead and the other



7 were proactively replaced because they were close to the end of their predicted service life expectancy. Upgrading the aged units to a higher Seer will reduce electrical expenses as they are more energy efficient. Projected energy savings for all 8 units over15 years is \$33,471. Replacing all 8 at once offered discounts.

**Street Lighting** - Soon you will see the Duke Energy crews converting the fixtures in all 116 streetlights and replacing the bulbs from 100W to 50W LED with a savings of approximately \$50 a month. The LED lighting gives a wider and brighter area of lighting. The conversion will not incur any cost to Paradise Island.

**Non-Potable Water System -** As soon as the parts arrive, our irrigation / non-potable pumping system will be installed. We will be eliminating the 35+ year old 2000-gallon tank that has been rewelded many times and is at the end of its useful life. As we are all aware, the entire system is in desperate need of replacement. The old system will be replaced with new variable frequency drive controllers and equipment, all pumps and motors that were repaired earlier this year will be reused.

**Pavilion Patio Repair -** The deteriorating wood support poles and cracked concrete slab on the west side of the Pavilion where the BBQ grills are located has been replaced with a new foundation and concrete wall. There will be new landscaping added behind the grills to finish off the area.

**Entrance To Pool Area -** The concrete under the south pool gate was deteriorating presented a trip hazard. To provide a gentle slope the triangular concrete area was replaced.

**Pool Maintenance -** We have contracted with a professional pool company to treat and maintain our pool and spa. They will be on site 3 times a week (Mon, Wed, Fri). to maintain all chemical feeders, test water, skim and vacuum pool and spa, brush walls and floors and make sure all equipment is working properly. Our maintenance team will continue to test and record twice daily the PH and Chlorine levels.

**Wooden Fence** - The wooden fence around the perimeter of our property is deteriorating and will be replaced with a vinyl fence. The Largo City ordinance requires that all wooden fences must be replaced by vinyl fences. We are in the process of finalizing the project details. The perimeter adjacent to the mechanical shops and apartments will be the first phase of installing 8ft fencing. This should help make the community more secure.

### **Tufted Titmice**


ufted Titmice look large among the small birds that come to feeders, an impression that comes from their large head and eye, thick neck, and full bodies. The pointed crest and stout bill help identify titmice even in silhouette. Color patterns are a soft silvery gray above and white below, with a rusty or peach-colored wash down the flanks. A black patch just above the bill makes the bird look snub-nosed. Tufted Titmice are acrobatic foragers, if a bit slower and more methodical than chickadees. They often flock with chickadees, nuthatches, and woodpeckers and are regular visitors to feeders, where they are assertive over smaller birds. Their flight tends to be fluttery but level rather than undulating.

The tufted titmouse gathers food from the ground and from tree branches. It eats berries, nuts, insects, small fruit, snails, and seeds. Caterpillars constitute a major part of its diet during the summer. Titmice will stash food for later use. The titmouse can demonstrate curiosity regarding humans, and sometimes will perch on a window ledge and seem to be peering into the house.


