FROM THE BOARD



Office Closure – The business office will be closed Thursday, November 25th and Friday, November 26th for the Thanksgiving Holiday. We will reopen

on Monday, November 29th.

Maintenance Fees —The Postal Service warned, as of October 1, 2021, mail formerly delivered in 1 to 2 days may now take up to 5 days! If you mail your maintenance fee, please do it earlier now; any payments received after the 10th of each month will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee.

<u>Air Pump</u> – Don't forget we have an air pump if your tires need air. It's located in the east parking lot, near the Adult Pool and is very simple to use. Left of the pump you will find the off/on switch; turn it on, then fill your tire. If you *do not* hear the motor turn on when you turn the switch on, that doesn't mean it is not functioning. If air in the tank is full, you may not hear anything until the air pressure is used and you will hear it come on as you fill your tire. Be sure

<u>Cable TV & Internet</u> – The new bulk agreement with Spectrum begins November 2nd. If you already have Spectrum, you do not need to do anything. If you are here in the park, and you need new equipment, you simply need to call Spectrum to have your equipment delivered to your home by UPS. As an alternative, you may visit the Spectrum store located at 4049 Park Blvd and tell them you are a new bulk cable/internet customer through Clearwater Cascade and they will provide the equipment to you. If you are not a current Spectrum customer with both cable and internet services, please call the bulk care center **ON or AFTER** 11/2/2021 at **1-833-697-7328** to subscribe to the new bulk package. When calling, tell the Spectrum representative your address, unit number and that there is a bulk agreement in your community.

<u>Mailboxes</u> – Parking at the laundry facilities is for residents doing their laundry or picking up their mail. We will notify you by VOLO Message, when we will begin using the new mailboxes exclusively. After that date, the post office will no longer deliver mail to the current freestanding mailboxes; however, they will remain up for a while, so returning residents can still retrieve any mail that may have been delivered to them prior to the changeover.

<u>Mailbox Keys</u> – By now most of our year-around residents have received their new mailbox keys. Seasonal residents can pick theirs up when they visit the office to sign in.

<u>Golf Carts</u> – Remember, you must have a drivers' license to drive a golf cart. In addition, as of September 22, 2021, all golf carts in the community must display a registration sticker on the rear of the vehicle.

<u>Architectural Guidelines</u> – There are new guidelines for installing pavers around residents' homes. A copy of these will be sent along with the First Notice of Annual Meeting later this month.

<u>Water Charges</u> – Beginning January 1st, the park will start reading the water meters again and as of March 1st we will start invoicing residents for any water used, in excess of 3,000 gallons per month.

<u>Library Doors</u> – New doors have been installed on the library facility; they are taller and a little wider to accommodate wheelchairs. They look nice and now match the clubhouse and office doors.

<u>Craft Fair</u> – I don't know about everyone else, but I am really looking forward to the Craft Fair on the 13th. There will even be a food truck. I am looking forward to doing some holiday shopping and enjoying a nice lunch!



o you have what it takes to be a good board member? Chances are you do. If you have a mix of some of the following traits and skills, consider running for a seat on the board. We'd love to have you.

Respect. If you can give others respect and expect it in return, you can help keep board discussions civil, productive and on point. We're looking for people who can lead by consensus, not by command.

Good listening. People want to be heard. Can you listen to board members and residents with sincere interest? You may have a few ideas of your own, but everyone benefits by sharing and discussing.

Thick skin. Sometimes, residents—even other board members—can be mean and insulting. Are you good at turning a conversation around and finding out what's really bothering people?

Egos aside. If you can give others credit, the board will operate better as a team.

Agenda aside. Members who come to the board looking to help only themselves are a problem. A board is more productive when members don't have a personal punch list. Are you able to look after the community, not just your own interests? Are you willing to compromise?



Skill. An association is a business. So having board members with accounting, organizational behavior and teambuilding backgrounds can help. Someone with a financial background, for example, might make for a good treasurer.

The ideal board comprises a mix of management styles, professional skills and temperaments. If you know people with some of these traits or relevant skills, ask them if they'd be interested in joining the board. Some people don't think about running for a seat unless asked.

You don't have to know everything when you join, but you should be familiar with the governing documents and the responsibilities of the job. Fellow board members and managers can help you with the transition and train you on board responsibilities, current work, projects and hot issues.

Leaders can come from different places and backgrounds. There's no one mode that fits all. Share your knowledge and passion with the community.



DID YOU KNOW THESE THANKSGIVING FACTS?

The First Thanksgiving Took Place in 1621

lthough there are several accounts as to where the first Thanksgiving celebration took place, the most well-known version describes the inaugural Thanksgiving as a three-Aday pilgrim celebration that took place in 1621 at the Plymouth Colony (now Plymouth, Massachusetts). Most traditional historians recognize this as the first American Thanksgiving

Over 200 years later, President Abraham Lincoln issued a proclamation declaring the last Thursday in November as a day to give thanks. It wasn't until 1941 that congress made Thanksgiving an official national holiday.

Every Thanksgiving, the President Pardons a Turkey

Every year since 1947, a ceremony known as "The National Thanksgiving Turkey Presentation" has been conducted at The White House a few days before Thanksgiving. During the ceremony, the current President of the United States is presented with a live turkey. The commander-in-chief does not eat the turkey; instead, he "pardons" the bird and spares it from being slaughtered. After being pardoned, the turkey gets to live out its days on a farm.

Thanksgiving Dinner Hasn't Changed Much Over the Years

The food eaten at the first Thanksgiving feast in 1621 was not too different from our modern standard. The pilgrims' meal consisted of turkey (debatable), venison, waterfowl, lobster, fish, clams, pumpkin, squash, berries, and fruit. Aside from the seafood, most of these foods are still staples of our present-day Thanksgiving dinners.

Americans Eat a Lot of Turkey

While there is no official reason why turkey is the quintessential main dish used in Thanksgiving dinners, it was likely the most plentiful type of meat in Plymouth Colony in 1621. We've carried on the tradition of eating Turkey for

Thanksgiving dinner ever since. According to the National Turkey Federation, over 95% of Americans eat turkey on Thanksgiving. Around 280 million turkeys are sold during the weeks leading up to the holiday.



There Is an Official Thanksgiving Postage Stamp

In 2001, the U.S. Postal Service issued a commemorative stamp in honor of the Thanksgiving holiday. The stamp was designed by artist Margaret Cusack to resemble traditional folk-art needlework. The intention behind

the stamp's creation was to commemorate the tradition of

being thankful for the abundance of goods we enjoy in America.

Watching Football Is a Central Part of Most Thanksgiving **Celebrations**

In the United States, football is a major part of many families' Thanksgiving celebrations. This tradition dates back to the first-ever football game between



In Canada, the biggest one is the <u>Kitchener-Waterloo Oktoberfest Thanksgiving Day Parade</u>.




