

MANAGER'S MOMENT:

A letter from our new park manager, Kristen Pruett:

ello everyone! My name is Kristen Pruett and I am your new Property Manager! I am just getting my feet wet, but I have already met many of you and look forward to meeting many more. I have an open door but the best way to communicate is to email me at Kristen_Pruett@equitylifestyle.com. I'm really looking forward to working with you and for a long and successful partnership!

We are doing some work in the trash area. I'm sure many of you have noticed the work going on. There is a new concrete pad being poured for the roll-off and once complete, we will have a smaller roll-off brought in that you can easily access from the front. The rickety ramp and stairs will be removed. With that said, I would like to mention the rules for the trash area. It is very important to only dispose of things that you can put in the compactor, which is for basic household trash, the roll-off, which is for small furniture and yard waste, and the recycle bin, which of course is for your recycling. PLEASE DO NOT EVER LEAVE THINGS ON

THE GROUND. That takes up our maintenance staff's time that they could be doing more important things in the community. We are working hard to keep the community clean for everyone, so please remember that if you can't get it in one of the containers, you can't leave it in the trash area and will need to contact a junk removal person to remove it for you. You are NEVER allowed to leave large furniture pieces, construction waste, chemicals or propane tanks, or electronics. FYI, the HazMat folks are scheduled to be here in March. Violators will be charged for removing these items.

The 360 inspections have begun!! As you may, or may not know, the prospectus for the community requires that we do a full exterior inspection on every home twice per year. We are fully enforcing all of the rules in an effort to maintain the property at its best at all times, and maintain the integrity and value of your homes. We will be violating for the following: needed pressure washing, weeds in the beds, bushes not trimmed, unrepaired exterior damage, storing things in the carport or patios or anywhere in plain sight, FENCES OF ANY KIND, and expired registrations. Remember, any exception to the rules, if you don't have it in writing, then I can't honor the exception. Our goal is to have the best community for everyone and we want to work together to make that happen. For any unresponsive violations, we will ultimately have the work done and bill you back, but I can assure you that will not be the most cost-effective option for anyone. If you know you are not in compliance, please make an effort to start working on that now so that this is a smooth process.

Did you know you can pay online? Every resident has the ability to pay your rent online, either at will or scheduled payments. No more late fees, waiting for checks to clear, lost, or misposted payments, and this is a safe, encrypted process that will give you verification and peace of mind the minute you pay. I would not steer anyone in the wrong direction and encourage you to get registered with your online portal today!

Please remember if you will be making any changes to the exterior of your home, you need to turn in an Architecture Modification Request for approval before doing so. Painting? Landscaping? Adding a shed? Extending your patio? We need that turned in so that you stay in compliance with the community rules.

SLOW DOWN!!!! The speed limit is 10 MPH throughout the entire community, even slower if you are going by the office with its blind spots. Slow down Speed Racer....we don't want someone hurt!

Happy fall!! I know we are all ready for some cooler temperatures, even if we don't get them until February!! We will be turning our clocks back an hour on November 7th, and that is a good time to remember a few important things housekeeping items that can save you time and a lot of headaches, or worse, later on.

- 1. Check the batteries in your smoke detectors to assure they are all working properly.
- 2. Turn your heat on to make sure it is kicking on, or call an HVAC company for a seasonal tune-up.
- 3. GO CHECK THE ELECTRIC PEDESTALS IN YOUR BACK YARD. A visual

14.9 Dress Code: Shirts, shoes, and appropriate clothing must be worn in the common areas of the community. Cover-ups should be worn at all times to and from pools, spas, and exercise facilities.

No one should be walking to and from the pool without a cover as stated above. (Gentlemen, you may be sporting a six-pack, but save it for home display.)

It is also necessary to *shower* before getting into the pool or spa. There are health reasons for this requirement so please comply. Also, no street clothes are to be worn in the pool or hot tub. (Yes, it's been seen!)

<u>17.1</u> Excerpt from Recreation and Other Facilities rule: All Guests must be accompanied by a resident when using recreational facilities. (Anything at clubhouse area.)

The homeowner with whom they are staying must accompany them to the pool/spa and stay with them.

10.2 Excerpt from Parking rule: Vehicles are not to be parked on the grass or sidewalk at ANY time; 24/7. (Yes, this (sidewalk) is the thin cement strip in front of the mobile homes – and if you need to park for a few minutes, park in the street. If longer, park near the mailboxes, please.)

Article #2:

The Resolution to Declare a State of Emergency has been rescinded by the HOA Board. And to that end - don't forget Thursday, November 19th at 7 p.m. is our first Homeowners Association GENERAL MEMBERSHIP meeting.

Every homeowner is invited to attend but, you must have your **dues paid prior** to the meeting to be able to **vote**. \$10.00 per home, annually, is a small amount to pay for the protection and leadership of the HOA. What protection and leadership you ask?

The HOA is the only protection that you have under Florida Statute 723. A park must have a duly formed HOA Corporation to take advantage of the laws which protect you from unscrupulous park owners and unlimited rent increases. Without the HOA you will be completely at the mercy of the owners.

- The HOA board has continued to meet (using appropriate guidelines) during this pandemic, along with meeting with the Eldorado Village management and meeting (by Zoom) with the Networking for Progress organization.
- We will be explaining the items that concern us as residents and review the things that have been accomplished over the past couple years while most events were shut down and, bring you updates on:
 - The rent increase letters you received,
 - Our Neighbors Helping Neighbors Program and the Neighborhood Watch Program.

Homeowners Association (HOA) action request for new residents:

Florida Statute 723 requires that the HOA keep an account for **every resident in the park.** This is Florida Law and, Eldorado Village Management Office gives us your name, once a year, as they are required to do.

However, when you move in <u>you are given a FORM to either give consent or not</u> to having your information included in the Eldorado Village Directory, Monthly Media and/or Facebook page.

<u>The ACTION requested:</u> **New** residents are NOT completing the FORM and returning it to the HOA or Eldorado office. If you still have that FORM among your papers, please complete, even if you do not give your consent to anything and return it to Dorisanne Gibson, HOA president, at Lot 187. Thank you for your cooperation.

Exterior Modifications:

If you plan to make any exterior modifications to your home, you must get a modification form from management and have your project approved. This applies only to new modifications that will likely also require a permit from Largo. If you are changing/repairing current standing structure, no form is required.

 - 1. Put your awnings down if possible, but if you do not put them down or do not have any, or have side windows where there are no awnings, you might get window locks or stops to prevent the windows from being opened.
 - 2. Deadbolt locks should go into the door frame 1", but the screws that hold the plate on the frame need to be 3" and most of them are not. The longer screws could be bought at the same time you purchase the deadbolt lock. (This would make it much harder for anyone to "punch" your deadbolt equipment to break the door open.)
 - 3. Consider purchasing <u>solar lights</u> for use when the electricity is off INSIDE your home and on your porch or carport. Hopefully, this would discourage vagrancy when the power out and you may not be home.
 - 4. Having cash on hand, especially during hurricane season, is always suggested. Small bills are best but, separate the cash. Don't keep it all in the same pocket, purse, and wallet, put it in several places.

<u>Fraud</u>: Additionally, Officer Tran spoke about the tremendous increase in fraud, especially using Facebook. He had many good tips for Facebook users including keeping your settings on private rather than public and considering NOT using your real name.

<u>Don't forget</u>, if you see something suspicious you can directly call the Largo police at their *non-emergency number 727-587-6730* and report it to your Watch Team leader. Absolutely call if you see a crime being committed. The Neighborhood Watch team members are listed in the front of the Media.





Information About Water Shutoffs:

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado must be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble.

We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you are not sure if your name is on the parks robocall list, I would suggest that you check with the office to make sure they have added you to the list.

We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home which will prevent water from draining out of it and into the water system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE TO ASK ABOUT THE WATER SHUTOFFS!

There is nothing they can do to help you.




POETRY CORNER:

TRASH PICK-UP SERVICES

- 1. All garbage must be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 lbs.
- 2. Please do not place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. All broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely. Dispose of all medical needles and medicines properly do not place in trash bags.
- 3. All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- 4. Trees and brush trimmings <u>must</u> be cut into no larger than 4 foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18-inch diameter in order to be picked up.
- 5. All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for proper pick-up. Bags are to weigh no more than the 25 lbs as specified above.
- 6. Furniture appliances paints and any constructional materials will not be picked up.
 - a. Place furniture and constructional debris in open top dumpster.
 - b. Appliances and paint please call Pinellas county solid waste division 727-464-7500.
- 7. Please do not place any trash out the night before pickup as this will invite animals to rip open your garbage thus making it more difficult and time consuming for pick-up. Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled by your neighbors and by our staff.

Please try to obey these rules--they are for <u>everyone</u>. If you are unable to be up in the morning and take out your trash, please get a heavy duty garbage can with a tight lid to put it in.
