- 1. Kitchen and household waste:
- a. Garbage should be placed in plastic bags not to exceed 25lbs, tied, and placed at the street for pick up by 8:00 a.m. Monday and Friday. If a holiday should fall on any pick-up day, that pick up will be lost and not made up.



- b. NO garbage or recycling should not be placed on the street overnight.
- 2. Trimming/yard waste and construction debris:
- a. This waste will be collected Monday and Friday after 8:00 a.m. MUST be bundled or bagged and less than 25 lbs. and not over 3 feet in length.
- b. Two "roll off" dumpsters are available in the maintenance yard at the west end of 3rd St. for residence use only. Contractors doing work in the community should not use the community dumpster.
- 3. Recycling:
- a. Wednesday is recycling collection, place containers at the street by 8:00a.m.
- b. "NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT". Container can be all "mixed recycling", including mixed paper, flattened carboard, aluminum foil trays, tin or steel food cans, glass bottles and jars, milk and juice paper cartons and all plastic #1-7 (on the bottom of the container), these include butter tubs, fruit containers, take out plates, plastic cups, yogurt containers, plastic clam shell containers, etc... any plastic with a recycling sign. ### **BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR RENTERS AND RESIDENTS**

Both long term and short-term occupants of a home, whether a renter, an owner, or an additional occupant are required to have a background check run. Anyone staying in Ranchero Village as more than a guest of 15 days up to twice a year is required to have a background check. **This rule applies to <u>everyone</u>**. If you have been here before but have had an absence of over two years you will be required to have a current background check run. We also require a rental agreement with the name of the renter, monthly fee, and the length of time the home will be rented.

### **SELLING YOUR HOME:**

Please give the office a 60-day written notice if you are going to sell or rent your home along with a copy of your titles. All homes are inspected to assure they are complying. All sales must be approved by the Park Manager BEFORE any sale is finalized.



Please allow up to 15 days for the application process to be completed. You cooperation is greatly appreciated.

### SEASONAL REMINDERS

Fall is here and it's time to check the batteries in your smoke alarms.

It is also the time to put the Root Kill down the sewer to keep roots from plugging up your plumbing. Cooper Sulfate, available at local hardware stores, should be used twice a year: once in spring and again in the fall.

### **PRECAUTION**

The Park the manager is urging all residents to come to the office and register their goflcarts and bicycles. Registration forms from the City of Largo Police Dept. are available for registering bicycles. A sticker is then placed on your bike which will help in returning it to you should you become the victim of a theft.

Let's take all steps possible in preventing these thefts. Be sure to keep bikes and golfcarts securely locked up or chained. If you see suspicious activity, call the Largo Police Dept. at 727-587-6730 and also alert the park office.

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

### **DOG WALKING**

If a solicitor tells you they have received permission from the office to be in the park, do not believe it. Management **NEVER** gives permission for solicitation.

DO NOT allow any strangers in your home.

### POOL RULES

All the rules for the pool apply to all people at all times. The Corral Pool has extended hours, from 6:00am - 11:00pm. The children's hours are now 10:00am - 11:00pm. The rules posted as well as those which we highlight in this Bulletin are to be followed at all hours and conditions. Just



because no one else is at the pool when you are, does not mean the rules can be altered for your convenience. For example: If no one else is at the pool you must still abide by the No Smoking Rule and only smoke in the designated area. This is just an example, but you get the idea.

Pool tags are being checked randomly, so please be sure to always have your pool tag and guest pool tags with you. You can get a guest pool tag at the office for \$2.00.

We have a lot of new people, and this is a way to make sure only Ranchero residents are using the facilities. Please be courteous and welcoming to your new neighbors.

Let's all keep the rules and keep Ranchero a pleasant place to live and enjoy. Remember to put umbrellas down before you leave.

### HOT TUB USE is for adults only.

No one under 18. \*\*<u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub</u>\*\*. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, <u>no longer than 15 minutes</u>. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed, and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never</u> swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.



<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes vapor and e-cigarettes. **PUT IT IN WRITING!** 

All requests and complaints should be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience.

The office does not monitor Next Door.
