RULES AND SAFETY REMINDERS

- Glass is NOT permitted in the pool areas in any capacity to prevent injuries from broken glass on bare feet. Any allowed food or drink that is brought into the pool area must stay at least 4 feet away from the pools/hot tubs.
- For the health and safety of our maintenance staff do NOT dispose of "sharps" in the garbage. There are free programs available in Pinellas County to safely dispose of these items.
- ➤ Please remember that Thursday and Friday are for recycling collection, not trash. If you have trash to dispose of on a non-trash day, please hold it or take it down to the sanitation field. For recycling, use clear plastic bags. Separate cans from other recycling. Do not put out any garbage or perishables on these days. Items in bins or trash cans will not be collected during recycling or trash pickup days.

UPDATED PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE FRIDAY 8-13-2021

ue to the large increase in the number of covid-19 cases & deaths, (in particular the Delta variant, which is highly transmit able). The following protocols are effective immediately.

Masks will be required at any indoor function regardless of vaccination status. This includes clubhouses, billiard room, libraries, shuffleboard, and laundry facilities.

Social distancing of 6 feet is also required at all indoor functions.

Symptoms are similar to the flu: chills, muscle aches, vomiting, diarrhea, and fever

Residents should monitor their symptoms and get tested if experiencing any of these symptoms.

If you are tested positive, you are required to self quarantine for 10 days.



Why are we doing online voting?

It saves Palm Hill money, every time we must do a mass mailing, we must buy paper, print, fold, stuff in stamped envelopes all the paper notices. With the ability to vote electronically we also can go paperless for the notices.

It also saves time. The post office is getting less reliable in a timely manner. When a mailing goes out, it would take a week or more to receive it. Electronically would be received the same day. This last year we were forced to use overnight express, and we delayed the voters meeting to try to collect as many paper ballots as we could.

With online voting you could cast your vote before the ballot gets to the post office to be mailed out.

More info pertaining to online voting.

Some do not want to vote online; they would rather cast a paper ballot. This is fine but to get timely notices, sign in and opt into online voting and paperless communication. When it comes time for a Board election, the office can issue you a paper ballot. When the voting is closed the HOAst software can print a list of all the addresses that has cast an electronic vote. The committee counting the ballots will compare the unopened envelopes that has the address on them, to the HOAst address list. If the address has not voted electronically the paper ballot is allowed to be counted manually.

If you are a snowbird, it is necessary to advise the office of your coming and going, that is if you want mail delivered to where you are residing. If you opt in for online voting, it also lets you opt into email communication, then all you must do is make sure your email address is up to date to get your correspondence.

This software is new to all of us, and we are learning all the ins and outs of it. Bear with ...continued on page 14

BE AWARE OF A NEW TELEPHONE SCAM CIRCULATING IN **LARGO**

Largo Police Department Detectives have noticed an uptick in a new scam - sort of a social engineering type of scam.

People are calling and posing as bank security investigators. They have just enough information to convince the victim that they are who they say they are. The victim then confirms or volunteers additional information, allowing the suspect to then gain access to the victim's bank accounts.

It's unknown where the suspects are obtaining the information they need in order to target people. Possibly purchasing from the dark web.

The safest way to avoid this scam is to get the caller's name and extension. Then hang up, obtain a confirmed valid number for your financial institution (Google, back of Debit/Credit Card, etc.) Then call that institution directly and verify the identity of the person calling you.

What will be changing is the process.

Starting in 2022 you will be buying a three-year membership equaling \$3.00

This means in 2022, "2024" stickers will be sold, and you won't need to buy another membership (sticker) until 2025.
