

 - 1. ***NO Feeding or Watering the Ducks***- I have photos and videos of Resident feeding and watering the ducks-Now I realize that everyone loves the wildlife but it is unfair to your neighbors and the ducks- the food you give them is not what they get in nature and is not healthy for them- They are not healthy for you, your neighbors or their pets. (Note-Residents have been fined and/or evicted for this behavior)
 - 2. ***NO DUMPING***- in rear of the park-For months now we have been noticing large items being thrown in the back of the park, in front of the Maintenance Dumpster, in front of the *No Dumping Sign* This is becoming a very ugly and costly problem and we cannot have this- We have Paid for a dumpster to clean this up AGAIN- We have also added the expense of CAMERAS AND DVR to try to put a stop to this. If caught Dumping —Fines and Charges will be applied-THIS MUST BE STOPPED.
 - 3. ***PARKING near clubhouse and/or Office *Reminder***-Fri-Sun Parking in ONP Spots without parking permit is ok. Mon-Thurs *A PARKING PERMIT* is required *or you will be TOWED.
 - 4. ***Mowing, Yards, and House Cleanliness***-Even though this time of year we don't get a whole lot of rain-THE GRASS STILL NEEDS TO BE MOWED- Some yards are out of control and we must keep all debris, building materials and storage containers out of yard and off of the carport and/or porches.
 - 5. ***CLUBHOUSE***-When booking the clubhouse for a private event, Please make sure you and your guest clean up their mess. The Clubhouse is there for you, it is one of your amenities (Free of Charge) to use at any time as long as you check with GAO to make sure there are no Scheduling conflicts. All we ask is that you clean up your mess and put things back the way you found it so the next Resident can use it as well. Cleaning Fees can be added if needed we would prefer not to, we are all adults here.
 - 6. ***REAR LOT***-If you have a Vehicle, Boat, Trailer or and other Item in overflow storage lot in the rear of the park. Please Remember those Items must be CLEAN, TIRES AIRED UP, and GRASS & WEEDS must be taken care of. You also must have CURRENT LICENSE & REGISTRATION. We are doing our best to make sure it is more accessible to everyone so you must do your part as well. THE OFFICE MUST KNOW WHICH VEHICLE BELONGS TO WHICH RESIDENT.
