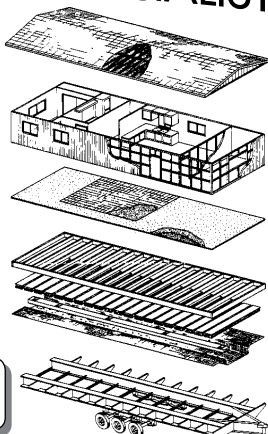

Manager's Message

Terrific and exciting to see our northern Residents returning for another season. Should be an active season as we've dodged and are pretty much past the COVID crisis. All of us are looking forward to a full schedule of events in the coming months. In fact, "active" should be added to our slogan . . .

a premier 'active' 55+ Resident owned community.

As in previous months, let's cover the sixth covenant of the New Resident Orientation. This was a focus of the Spring Cleaning review, and should be accomplished since that check:

Carports should be kept neat, clean and free of clutter at all times. Only bicycles, barbecues, golf carts, vehicles and outdoor patio furniture will be permitted in the carport area. Clothes hanging outside must be taken in prior to dusk. There are clothes lines behind both laundry facilities. If you are allowing a neighbor to park their car in your carport, please provide written documentation to the office as soon as possible so we will know not to issue a violation.

Initiative Updates:

1. Our Maintenance Team will install electric and the lighting in the Founders' Park gazebos this month (and two other locations). That undertaking completes the Founders' Park renovation.
2. Tom Wichmann, Flooring Committee, continues to develop proposals for the floors in the Fitness, Billiard, Game Rooms, and Main Clubhouse. Please, volunteer for this committee as your effort will determine the floor covering materials.
3. ARO Engineering is completing the Engineer Survey for the North and South Boat Ramp Renovation Project with the final document sure to meet expectations. Mike Arkanoff continues to chair this effort.
4. The Audio-Visual Renovation of the Clubhouse was completed in September. Mark Andrews (chair), Gary Griffith, and Ron Miller hooked up the monitors, and judging from the many positive comments during Live Music shows, Community Forums, and Board Meetings – quite a success.
5. The Landscaping Committee continues to improve the quality of our gardens, and we look forward in the months ahead as they improve the southeast outside garden, the Mt Saxon dog park, and the entrance gardens.
6. J. Foster Consulting provided comments on the state of the seawall during the October Community Forum. Those HOTWASH items will be shared in a full report published

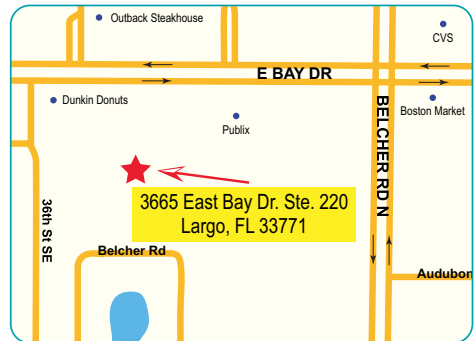

in two months. As mentioned previously, this project will prioritize necessary repair and overhaul for funding in future budgets.

- 7. The Land Survey, WEBSITE, and North Canal Committees had their first meetings in late October. We look forward to the next meetings, more volunteers, and the final results of their efforts.
- 8. The Tiki Hut Roof committee was established in October, and we look forward to their success in deciding the type and design of the Tiki Hut roof.

A short note on Volunteer:

While dictionaries generally define ‘volunteer’ as *a person who offers a service or action willingly, without pay, and – in many cases – with some expertise*; these individuals are extremely valuable to the success of Americana Cove.

How valuable? The ACA Leadership and the Clubs wouldn’t exist without volunteers as the leaders and members are the driving force behind these organizations. The MAROA Directors of the Board are all volunteers. In each case, these Residents give up their free time to setup, participate, cleanup, discuss, and even study requirements for their organization. They give their energy to better our community. In a host of cases, many are the same Residents who raise their hands time and time again. Without thinking twice, these Residents are willing to do what is needed to make the Cove a premier ‘active’ community.

Who Can Sell My Home?

We receive questions from residents who want to know is it legal for a friend or neighbor to show and sell their home while they are away. The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) has strict rules about unlicensed real estate activity. Here's a quick review:

- Any person in the community can sell their own home, no matter if the home has a share and is real property or if the home is located on a lot that they rent.
- If a homeowner does not want to sell their home themselves and the home is real property, then the person selling the home must be a licensed Florida real estate agent. Simple acts such as asking a neighbor to unlock the door and let in a possible buyer or a neighbor describing the features about the home is unlawful activity and is a third-degree felony as that person is acting as a real estate agent without a real estate license.
- There are still a few homes where the owner rents the lot within the community. If those homeowners don't want to sell the homes themselves, then the person selling the home must be a licensed Florida mobile home dealer. According to the Florida Department of Motor Vehicles which regulates mobile home dealers, if a person who isn't the owner shows a home and doesn't have a dealer's license, it is a second degree misdemeanor that can result in jail time and fines.

The DBPR has an unlicensed activity program and a hotline to report unlicensed activity. To learn more, call 866-532-1440.

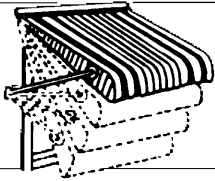
