COFFEE HOUR



LHRO BOARD MEETING

(Ed note: These notes are just a short recap of the meeting, not official minutes.)

The LHRO Board met on November 10 at 10:00 a.m. Two people talked during open forum about November events. New resident John of #267 asked for info on how to get rid of appliances, as he is remodeling the home he recently purchased.

The Manager's Report, by Beth, reminded us that if we ask the Office to turn the water on/ off at our homes, to please let them do it. If you do it yourself, you are responsible if anything breaks. The Office has been a little lenient on residents that aren't taking care of their homes. Please make sure that you look at all 4 sides of your home when you're checking to see if it needs washing or weeds need pulling. If you need help, let the Office know. Also, NO bird baths or bird feeders are allowed as they draw rates and other vermin. If you have one, please remove it.

The blinds in the Clubhouse are being removed and replaced as needed.

On-line voting – we are continuing to work on this project. It is very convoluted from the Office side, although from the residents side it is pretty simple. 1st notices of the upcoming Annual Meeting and Voting will be going out by email and regular mail by November 15th, then 2nd notices in December. We would like to thank Loch Kline for organizing voting on election night in the past, and Mary Lou Fraher is taking over that responsibility for the 2022 vote. Thank you both for your help.

Mold in the office has been a continuing problem. We had it remediated, then it came back. Looks like we are going to have to cut into the ceiling to figure it out (there is no roof leak). We were rated at 3,000 spores, and 1,500 is bad. We were down to 100, but the mold came back. They are to come on November 16 and get into it again. Approximately \$1700 for remediation, and \$700 to repair and paint the ceiling. Beth also said she is going to have the Clubhouse, Library and Card Room checked for mold.

Storm drains by the High School – Beth has two quotes, not getting results on finding a contractor for a third one. Board voted to allow just the two, and subsequently voted to go with Tampa Bay Plumbing. They will replace the intakes and the pipes at a cost of \$29,000 (not to exceed \$35,000). The park will take responsibility for repairing any damage to yards that occurs during this process.




