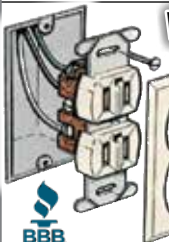

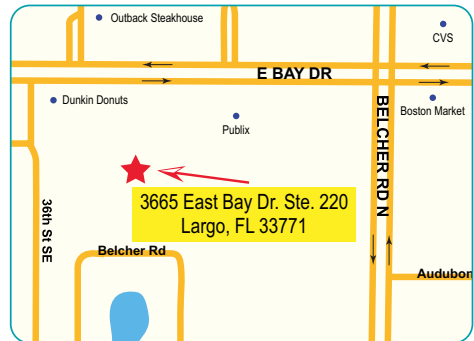

and spent the next few years working hard on our fixer-upper. LeRoy served 4 years on the ROC board and architectural committee. It was 2014 when we purchased our home in WW II, enticed by more living space in the unit.

Looking back on our childhood: Eileen grew up on a farm in North Dakota, went to a country school, and graduated from the University of North Dakota in Home Economics. Soon after marriage, suburban Minneapolis became the Putman's home for 30 years. During this time two sons were born. Eileen became a "stay at home Mom" while managing a "Cottage Industry." She was later hired as a sales rep. In the window covering industry until retirement in 2000. A home was soon built on Lakefront property on Lake Latoka just outside Alexandria, Mn. LeRoy and Eileen shared the dream of living on this property they purchased back in 1977 just outside a resort town and close to the freeway. Their two sons and wives, along with 4 grands live in the Twin Cities within easy driving distance.

LeRoy grew up in a small town, Gwinner, North Dakota, where he at 11 years of age, began working at the local Cities Service gas station for 35 cents per hour! After high school, he attended Valley City State University in North Dakota, where he graduated with a BS degree, majoring in Math and Phys. Eileen spends her spare time creating ART, mostly watercolor painting. She enjoys her art groups in Dunedin and back home in Mn. Much inspiration comes to her Plein Air painting out and about with friends. Playing a little social bridge in WW I on Wed. evenings is usually on her schedule.



LeRoy enjoys reading, especially history, working puzzles (a byproduct of covid), and most of all playing duplicate bridge two or three times a week. In Minnesota he is THE yard man, sweeping, raking, picking up sticks, gardening and heckling the neighbors. He is out and about every day on his 4-wheeler checking out the neighborhood. Watching birds and feeding them is on the "favorites list" of the Putmans.

Travel highlights of the retirement years include a 21 day trip/cruise of Australia and New Zealand. A few years back, the two of them traveled on a European River Cruise from Budapest to Amsterdam, then Paris, Normandy and London.

Summers for the Putmans are spent at the lake home. Always anticipating those special days when the kids and grandkids spend week-ends with them enjoying the lake, bonfires at night, playing beanbag, and whatever suits the day. Sometimes it is board or card games at night or on rainy days. We treasure these moments with the 4 teenage grands and their parents. We so appreciate our project days with them when we need their "muscle" to get our maintenance done...nothing better!! So many memories to make, so many sunsets to enjoy and so many S'mores to create!!
